Daily thru April 0255-0305 1220 WRIB Providence RI (Healy)

Daily, from 2:55am-3:05am EST - WRIB-1220 - Providence, RI - This test is scheduled to run "through at least April (2004)".

We've arranged for WRIB-1220 in Providence, RI (tough state to hear!) to raise power to 1kw non-D every night at 2:55 to 3:05am. This will run through at least April, and will have a recorded ID at 3am. Hopefully a special ID with morse code can be added in the near future. There ought to be good propagation for a fair number of these nights, and it's late enough for the west coast folks to have a shot. Fire up those recorders and let us know if you hear them!

Here's the results of the most recent DX tests that have been received here:

Sunday, March 28, 2004 - KEVA-1240, Evanston, WY tested 1:00-2:00am MST:

As was the case when this station tested on 3/14/04, most of those that heard the test were in the West. Don Kaskey of San Francisco, CA and Pat Martin of Seaside, OR mentioned that the code seemed much weaker this time. However, Tim Hall in Chula Vista, CA reported that he heard the code easily, as was the case with Steve McDonald in BC. Darwin Long in Thousand Oaks, CA heard the test, with several other stations on the frequency. Shawn Axelrod in Winnipeg, MB said he heard KEVA with a poor signal, but was able to hear and understand the code.

Bill Snyder in Omaha, NE, Gerry Bishop in Niceville, FL, and Neil Kazaross in Barrington, IL all reported that they tried for the test but were unable to hear it.

Monday, March 29, 2004 - WXHL-1550, Elkton, MD tested 12:00-1:00am EST:

There wasn't a clear dividing line on who heard this test and who didn't; for instance, Russ Edmunds in Blue Bell, PA, remarked that while his QTH is only 47 miles from WXHL and his loop was pointed right at them, he doesn't think he heard the code from the test due to QRM from CBE and WDZC. However, "rah1962" in IN says he heard the test, albeit the Morse only. Gordon Bell in Troy, NY heard the test well, but Scott Fybush in Rochester, NY reports hearing only a mixing product of some of his locals. Also not hearing the test were Ernest Jones in Greensboro, NC, Bruce Winkelman in Tulsa, OK, Gerry Bishop in Niceville, FL, Kevin Redding in Mesa, AZ, Mike Brooker in Toronto, ON, and Andersson Sigvard in Sweden. Also, John Hunter of Rossville, GA and Adam Myrow of Memphis, TN both heard a station with SS instead of the test.

However, the test was heard by Wade Smith in New Brunswick, Canada, Saul Chernos in Burnt River, ON, Phil Greenspan in Marshfield, MA, Bill Dvorak in Madison, WI, Mike Hardester in Jacksonville, NC, Jim Renfrew in Byron, NY, and Barry McLarnon in Ottawa, ON.

Thursday, April 1, 2004 - WTBQ-1110, Warwick, NY tested 5:15-6:00am EST:

The only reports I received about this test were from those that were unable to hear the test; these included Russ Edmunds of Blue Bell, PA and Mike Hardester of Jacksonville, NC, who both had too much interference from WBT in Boston. Wade Smith in New Brunswick also mentioned problems with WBT, but also had CBE to deal with, and Eric Berger in Detroit, MI had WBT and KFAB taking over the frequency.

Sunday, April 4, 2004 - KEVA-1240, Evanston, WY tested 12:00-1:00am MST:

For this test, the only reports I received were from those that HEARD the test. Darwin Long in Thousand Oaks, CA heard the test, as did Patrick Martin in Seaside, OR, Tim Hall in Chula Vista, CA, Bruce Portzer in Seattle, WA, and Steve Ratzlaff in Elgin, OR (NE Oregon), who sent a detailed description of the CW. Pete Taylor of Tacoma, WA wasn't sure if it was KEVA he heard, as he wasn't able to make out the CW he heard.

DXing by Bruce Portzer (bp) and Chuck Hutton (CH), using 800' E-W and 1100' SW Beverages. Receivers included Drake R8A (Bruce), and Drake R8 and AOR 7030 (Chuck).

Chuck writes: This was an unusual night. Signals were certainly not at record levels, but I think I heard more NZ stations in one night than ever. There were so many that I'm quite sure I was able to stop and listen to less than half.

A minor geomagnetic storm had knocked out all the Asian stations for me, although Bruce said he heard one of the Japanese big guns and S. Korea 1566.

Even Australia was partially gone. Only the big stations from the east were there, and in the place of Asia and a lot of Australia were the NZ stations. NZ is none too strong here due to the low powers; I think there are no 50 kw stations and almost everything I hear is 10 kw or less.

**Bruce writes:** This was an interesting DXpedition. I have to agree with Chuck – this was easily my most productive DXpedition for NZers, with 1017 1026 639 and 1287 being the most prized catches of the night. Oddly enough, Radio Sport in Auckland was absent from 1332, even though Radio Tarana on 1386 was in well from the same city.

The Aussies were OK, but not all that spectacular. Many of the regulars were in well, like 4BC-1116 and 5AN-891, while other like 4RN-792 and 4QD-1548 were below normal.

Pacific Islands were only so-so, with just Tahiti & two Fijians heard. Asians were likewise pretty scarce, 594 was in briefly and 1566 was good at times, but that was it.

I also heard brief audio on 20-30 other channels but never pulled anything worth noting.

It was announced June 12 that the **Digital Radio Mondiale** standard has been endorsed by the International Electrotechnical Committee. This comes in the wake of previous endorsements and certifications by the International Telecommunications Union in April 2001 and the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI). The DRM consortium is made up of 73 broadcasters, network operators, manufacturers and researchers. DRM is expected to be displayed at WARC (World Administrative Radio Conference) 2003 for use

below 30 MHz. Read the press release at http://www.drm.org/pdfs/newsevents/ iecrelease2.pdf.

In *Radio World Online*, Michael Hedges reports from WRC-03 in Geneva that DRM has arrived. **Digital Radio Mondiale** made their official debut during the radio conference on June 16. Digital shortwave, medium-wave/AM and long-wave broadcasts launched when DRM chairman Peter Senger cued engineers at nearby Mount Saleve in France.

Also in *Radio World Online*, There's a story that Leonard Kahn is working on something called **Compatible AM Digital Technology**, and 10 stations have signed up to test it out.
