We've arranged for WRIB-1220 in Providence, RI (tough state to hear!) to raise power to 1kw non-D every night at 2:55 to 3:05am. This will run through at least April, and will have a

recorded ID at 3am. Hopefully a special ID with morse code can be added in the near future. There ought to be good propagation for a fair number of these nights, and it's late enough for the west coast folks to have a shot. Fire up those recorders and let us know if you hear them!

KPSI CA. Pal Springs 5/1 0615 with an interesting program called Cowboy Corner 920 with stories about the old west and western themes. (KR-AZ)
