NOTICE OF UPCOMING ELECTIONS

From December 1, 2004 through January 15, 2005 nominations are open for President, Secretary-Treasurer, and the seven members of the Board of Directors. Only one nomination each for President, Secretary-Treasurer, and only seven nominations for the Board shall be allowed each IRCA member. An eligible member may nominate him/herself. All nominations must be submitted in written form (letter, fax or e-mail) to the Election Committee Chairman (ECC) by January 15, 2005.

The ECC will notify all nominees of their nomination by February 1, 2005. Each nominee (unless it is a self-nomination) must reply in writing (letter, fax, e-mail) if they accept their nomination, and each acceptance letter may include a campaign statement, not to exceed 20 bulletin lines in a March issue of DX Monitor. Campaign statements are not required. If a member is nominated for more than one office, he/she must decide which office, or offices, they choose to run for and may include a campaign statement for each office selected. All letters of acceptance and campaign statements must reach the ECC by February 20, 2005.

Modes of Operation: 00:01 - 00:30 50KW Daytime Directional Pattern. 00:31 - 01:00 5KW Non-Directional. 01:00 - 01:30 Off Air to allow DXers in our region of the country to DX other stations on 990 kHz. Programming: Morse IDs, Voice IDs, Tones, Marching Band Music - Stars and Stripes Forever, Washington Post March, Liberty Bell March (the old Monty Python Theme.)

WFIL 560khz Philadelphia, PA TEST. Date: January 9, 2005. Time: 02:00-03:30 EST (**NOTE TIME CHANGE.**) Modes of Operation: 02:01 - 02:30 7.1KW Daytime Directional Pattern. 02:31 - 03:00 2.5KW Non-Directional. 03:00 - 03:30 Off Air to allow DXers in our region of the country to DX other stations on 560 kHz. Mr. Tetro will be sending out newly designed QSL Cards for each station with a special label/stamp on the reverse side noting the special DX Test to those who respond.

KTNS 1060khz Oakhurst, CA TEST. Date: December 22, 2004. Time: 0200-0400 EST (2 Hour Test.) Modes of Operation: 5KW Daytime Non-Directional. Programming: Morse IDs, Voice IDs, Sweep Tones, Old Television Theme songs. Morse Code ID's are at both 10WPM and 5WPM, 1000hz.

Test is being conducted by Mr. Larry Gamble, station owner/operator who will be retiring soon. He has done several DX Tests over the years. Mr. Gamble would prefer to verify reception reports via e-mail only. Written reports or short MP3 clips are sufficient for verification.

Tests Notes: Oakhurst is located in Central California near the Yosemite National Park. Past DX tests have resulted in reports from most of the Western US. Note too the use of television theme songs as program material. Hopefully these will be easier to pull out of the noise. An example might be the theme from the Addams Family, etc.

WXCT 990khz Southington, CT TEST. Date: January 9, 2005 (Late Sunday night into Monday morning.) Time: 00:00AM EST to 02:00AM EST (2 Hour Test.) Modes of Operation: 00:00-00:30 Full day power 2.5kw and pattern. 00:30-01:00 1kw Non-Directional. 01:00-01:30 80 Watts Directional Night Pattern 01:30-02:00 Off air to allow locals to DX 990khz. Programming: Mixture of Morse Code ID's, unique test tones, voice announcements and "most notably, you will hear music never heard before and probably never again on the radio!"

This special test is being conducted Mr. Ron Barnes, the Chief Engineer. The test schedule makes it obvious that Mr. Barnes is very interested in seeing how the station performs over the entire test. If you can, try to observe how the signal changes strength as the power is reduced and include that information in your reports.

Information about this test comes from a posting by Mr. Barnes to the "Radio-Info DX Web Board" and several e-mails exchanged with Mr. Barnes and noted DX'ers. So far, I have been unable to confirm this test directly with Mr. Barnes. If I am able to do so, I will send out a follow up e-mail message.

KFBK 1530khz Sacramento, CA TEST. Date: January 24, 2005. Time: 0200-0600 EST (4 Hours ID's ONLY Test.) Modes of Operation: 50KW Night Time Directional Pattern. Programming: :60 and :30 Morse Code and Phonetic Voice ID's Only during program breaks.

This special test is being conducted by Ross du Clair, Ph.D.,- WA6VWY, who is the Chief Engineer for "News Talk 1530" and other Clear Channel stations. Due to programming commitments, test will be limited to commercial breaks only during regular programming. ID's will consist of both Morse Code at 10WPM, 1000hz and phonetic voice announcements... such as:

"This is Kilo Foxtrot Bravo Kilo".

heard list -- 710 when I heard WEKC-710 KY and WTPR-710 TN and 780 when I heard WWOL-780 NC. For WWOL, I thought I was going to stand on my head holding the loop before I could finally ID the station. I finally figured out who it was when they ran a spot for a place in a neighboring town and told which town. Conditions seemed weird Sat. morning as I was hearing WOR-710 NYC as late as 1030 AM EST. Along with them was Radio Disney on 640 which had to be WWJZ in Mount Holly, NJ. I was in Paoli, Ind on 11/26 at sunset. I pulled into the Wally Mart lot listening to local WSEZ-1560 but when I came out about 15 minutes later, it was Radio Disney (WQEW-1560 NYC) on the radio. So, I made it a hot target here in Indy. On 12/2, at 0857, I had the WSEZ ID I wanted but at 0900, it was a WRIN-1560 ID off the backside of the loop for another much-wanted. Now up to 53 Ind. Stations heard here.
