This final midcoast Maine DXpedition before the camparound closed for the season was different. The adventure began rather unusually with a traffic jam on Route 17 in the middle of nowhere Washington, Maine, en route to the coast. An escaped cow was being rounded up by a rancher on his ATV in the middle of the highway. Canadian high pressure protected downeast Maine from the persistent week-long flooding rains in southern New England. The fair weather wasn't going to last, of course. Flood warnings were announced on NOAA radio while setting up camp, "especially over south and east facing slopes." I thought I was prepared as the old tent had been given a complete waterproofing. Two new rolls of wire were used for the north and east antennas after wire was lost during the deluge of the previous DXpedition. Once everything was tested and ready for DXing, I went into the woods searching for the lost wire, and sure enough a section was still drooping from the tree limbs a couple hundred meters away. The lost wire was retrieved and redeployed for a third antenna. The rain held off until Friday night when it poured cats and dogs. After DX had settled down for the night, I decided to catch some zzz's until around European transmitter site dawn. When I awoke the tent floor was under an inch of water. There were no leaks in the roof or sides. A peak outside revealed the problem; the campsite was underwater. A nearby babbling brook was rushing over its banks. What else could I do other than turn on the radio? All times are UTC.
