**"TOWER SITE 2006 CALENDAR" GOES ON SALE
Fifth Year For One Of America's Most Unusual Calendars**

ROCHESTER, NY – One of North America's most unusual wall calendars is back for a fifth year, with the publication of the "Tower Site 2006 Calendar."

The calendar, which features a monthly photo of a well-known broadcast transmitter site, is photographed and written by Scott Fybush, the creator of "Tower Site of the Week" (www.fybush.com/featuredsite.html) and "NorthEast Radio Watch" (www.fybush.com/nerw.html).

The full-color monthly calendar has become a tradition for many radio engineers and a curiosity for those who think all radio towers look alike. "It's turned into a very popular gift for radio engineers," says Fybush. "I'm delighted by the response the calendar keeps getting each year." Like its predecessors, each month of the 2006 calendar features an 8"x11" color photograph of a broadcast

transmitter site taken by Fybush during his travels around the US, Canada and beyond. Some sites pictured on the 2006 calendar:

- WMCA, New York, featured in a dramatic nighttime view on the cover
- The rooftop tower at the Prudential Tower in Boston's Back Bay
- KTAR, Phoenix, whose towers sit in a shopping center parking lot
- WSB, Atlanta, another tower that's surrounded by a shopping center
- WKY, Oklahoma City, with a beautiful Art Deco building and one of the tallest AM towers in the U.S.
- Mount Wilson, above Los Angeles, home to most of that city's FM and TV stations
- KQRT, Las Vegas, in a dramatic desert view
- KCMO, Kansas City, with an historic transmitter building
- CBV, Quebec City, a now-defunct AM station
- KLIF, Dallas, in a scenic lakeside setting
- WKJV, Asheville, N.C., with its venerable hilltop site
- WGOW, Chattanooga, nestled in the river valley near the city
- WEJL, Scranton, with a rare rooftop AM tower

In addition to tower photos, the calendar's monthly pages include significant dates in radio and television history, as well as civil and religious holidays.

Like the 2005 edition, the 2006 calendars cost \$16 each, postpaid (\$17.28 including sales tax for New York State residents), and can be purchased by check (payable to "**Scott Fybush**") or money order to 92 Bonnie Brae Avenue, Rochester NY 14618. Orders can also be placed with major credit cards at www.fybush.com.

"It's been exciting to travel around the country and see the calendar hanging in radio stations from coast to coast," says Fybush, who also edits the radio directory site 10000watts.com and is a regular contributor to the trade publication *Radio World*.
