- 610 KEAR 106.9 San Francisco CA requests new calls KIFR as speculation begins about its new format; the KEAR calls will replace KFRC on 610 San Francisco, which will retain the religious format when the FM flips.
- 860 KKAT-FM 107.5 Orem/Salt Lake City UT flips to classic country as "Country Legends," simulcasting with KKAT 860 Salt Lake City UT.
- 910 WSPA Spartanburg SC and WOLI 103.9 Easley SC flip to regional Mexican "Radio Lider," while WOLT 103.3 Greer SC flips to black gospel as "Praise 103.3."
- 1130 WQIS Camden SC changes calls to WEAF, in what we believe is the first use of those legendary calls since they were retired from NBC's New York flagship (later WNBC, now WFAN 660) in 1946.
- 1160 WBYN Lehighton PA flips from ESPN sports to a simulcast of religious WBYN-FM 107.5 Bovertown PA.
- 1200 Néw calls for new stations: CJRJ 1200 Vancouver BC, KABW 101.3 Westport WA, KANY 93.5 Ocean Shores WA, KEAL 106.5 Taft CA, KETT 99.3 Mitchell NE, KHYY 106.9 Minatare NE, KXTT 94.9 Maricopa CA.
- 1260 KTRC Santa Fe NM flips from news/talk to progressive talk, picking up the Air America feed that had been on KVSF 1400 Santa Fe NM, which flips to ESPN sports. The talk programming displaced from 1260 lands on KBOM 94.7 Santa Fe, which flips from smooth jazz.
- 1310 WDOD Chattanooga TN flips from standards to progressive talk "AM 1310 the Voice."
- 1330 WHAZ-FM 97.5 Hoosick Falls NY returns to the air with religion, simulcasting WHAZ 1330 Troy NY.
- 1340 WMDR Augusta ME goes silent, but will return with southern gospel.
- 1450 KHIT Reno NV flips from standards to ESPN Deportes Spanish sports talk. Also joining the ESPN Deportes network: KTKT 990 Tucson AZ, WCCM 1490 Haverhill MA (as a secondary affiliate)
- 1480 WEEÓ Shippensburg PA drops its ESPN sports format; it's being sold to the owners of WIOO 1000 Carlisle PA.
- 1480 WZFB Fair Bluff NC flips from ESPN to contemporary Christian as "Gospel Radio 1480."
- 1520 KSQB Sioux Falls SD will flip from standards to sports (Fox Sports and the KFAN network) on Monday 10/10.
- 1530 New Ágana GU takes calls: KVOG.
- 1540 WMCB Martinsville IN changes calls to WSKT.
- 1600 WKKX Wheeling WV flips from ESPN sports to talk.
- A new format: "Jose" is the Spanish-speaking version of "Jack," playing a wide variety of hits in Spanish, and it launches on KCVR-FM 98.9 Columbia CA, KCVR 1570 Lodi CA, KMXA 1090 Aurora CO, KRCX 99.9 Marysville CA, KRZY 1450 Albuquerque NM.
- New Orleans update: The United Radio Broadcasters of New Orleans simulcast sheds several FM stations, with Clear Channel returning WQUE 93.3 to top 40, WYLD-FM 98.5 to R&B, WRNO 99.5 to rock and WNOE 101.1 to country and Entercom returning WEZB 97.1 to top 40 and WLMG 101.9 to AC. The URBNO simulcast continues on WWL 870, WYLD 940, WODT 1280, WSMB

- 1350. KHEV 104.1 Houma LA and WKBU 105.3 Kenner LA. And the "Bayou" classic rock format that was on WKBU before Katrina has moved to WTKL 95.7 New Orleans, replacing oldies there.
- WGVC 106.3 Simpsonville/Spartanburg/Greenville SC flips from oldies to contemporary Christian/country "The Walk," picking up the format formerly used by WOLI 103.9 Easley SC/WOLT 103.3 Greer SC. Those stations, along with WSPA 910 Spartanburg SC, have been sold by Entercom and will get new formats soon.
- WZYQ 101.9 Mound Bayou MS, KZYQ 103.5 Lake Village AR and KZYP 99.3 Pine Bluff AR flip to "Jammin' Oldies" rhythmic oldies. (KZYQ and WZYQ had been blues "Star 103," while KZYP was adult R&B.) Sister station KPBQ 101.3 Pine Bluff AR flips from country to black gospel, with "Super Country" replacing sports on KOTN 1490 Pine Bluff AR, And KCLA 1400 Pine Bluff AR flips from Fox sports to adult R&B "Golden Oldies." - UNID, not sure Russia or England at 0216 10/25 with mx, then deep fade with deep voiced man talking, weak couldn't get the language, but didn't sound EE. EMWG gives Russia a sign on at 0200. (SR-OR)
- CROATIA, First audio 0202 10/25 with man talking, later with mx, poor from the start. All my TA loggings have deep fade cycles. (SR-OR)
- + Also fair with vocal and inst. ballads, news in and out 10/24 0254-0350. (PT-WA)
- ENGLAND, Virgin Radio at 0211 playing modern rock weak-medium level. (SR-OR)
- NORWAY, Kvitsoy, strong carrier with huge slop from local on 1310, looped the best I could, pretty hard to dig audio out though. New. (AWP-CA)

- 30 minute period with initially piano bar type mx. (WS-BC) SPAIN, RNE 1 Madrid 10/25 0205. Weak audio and I'm thinking Madrid with 600 kw, the most likely station here. (WS-BC)
- FRANCE, Lille, France Info 10/25 0206. Not much doubt about this one with FF audio, poor
- UNID, 10/25 0209, Wow! a real graveyard channel with no stations of any great strength. Weak audio only, so it is anyone's guess. (WS-BC)
