**DX ALERT - UPCOMING RADIO EVENT**

There will be a special five-hour "DX Program" from CKDO Oshawa Ontario on its new frequency of 1580, from 2100 EDT Thursday 5 October to 2 AM EDT Friday 6 October. This program is timed to coincide with the 60th anniversary of the station, to the exact date.

CKDO first signed on October 5, 1946 with 100 watts on 1240. (CKDO = Durham and Ontario counties). The calls became CKLB on Dec. 19, 1949, when ownership changed to Lakeland Broadcasting (ckLB). Calls later became CKAR, and a few years ago reverted to the original CKDO. The station moved to 1350 on Dec. 31, 1955. Thus with its recent official move on Aug. 14 to 1580, the station concluded more than 50 years service on 1350. For those who do not realize, 1580 was one of the clear channels allocated to Canada in the North American Regional Broadcasting Agreement of 1941, and CBJ Chicoutimi QC operated on that frequency from March 22, 1942 until it moved to 93.7 in 1999.

There will be a special toll-free number given out over the air, and phone calls from distant listeners will be encouraged. It is anticipated that some former DJs from over the years will be participating. The 1580 frequency uses the same directional pattern day and night favoring east and west, at 10,000 watts.

The programming has been organized by Wayne Plunkett (long-time DXer) and Douglas Kirk (owner of Durham Radio Inc.).

All written reception reports will be answered. Send reports to Attn: Special DX Program, CKDO, 1200 Airport Blvd., Ste 207, Oshawa Ontario L1J 8P5.

Let's hope for good conditions so this program can be heard coast-to-coast in North America, and maybe beyond!

Once every two years, IRCA's editors and committee chairs need to be reconfirmed. The following proposals were presented to the Board by the President, except for proposals 22.1.31 to 22.1.37, which were put forward by Phil Bytheway.

All were approved virtually unanimously. Phil Bytheway abstained on proposals 22.1.31 through 22.1.37, as well as proposals 22.1.12, 22.1.14 and 22.1.27. Robert Wien abstained on proposal 22.1.21, while John Johnson abstained on proposal 22.1.16. There were no negative votes.

Unfortunately, proposals 22.1.32 and 22.1.33 have become moot, as James Niven has resigned his positions due to the pressures of work.

This means that the editorship of the Mexican Log is again available, as is the editorship of the Slogans List. Our thanks to James for his very productive term as editor of both these publications, and we hope that he will be able to assist the club so ably again in the future.

Last week, I was looking for something in the Radio-Locator.com website when I accidentally clicked on the information on the station's tower location. The entry shows the latitude/longitude numbers but, to my surprise, it took me to the Google map and actually showed me the location on the map. I was checking to see what Indy's WSYW-810 station coverage map looked like, but wound up seeing where the tower is located. So, I tried it again with the WTLC-1310 listing and it pulled the map again, with the towers just a little bit south of the 810 tower. They are both along Harding St, not too far north of the south by-pass, perhaps two miles north of the Flying Fishhook truckstop. Now I know why 1310 is such a bad frequency to work around here. I don't know why I hadn't spotted the towers before when I had been up in that area. WSYW is about a stone's throw from the White River. After that, I checked out WBRI-1500 (northeast side of town near the I-465/I-69 junction) and WNX-1430 (north central part of town, near 45th st and Knollwood Road, just west of Michigan Road). We went up and looked at the WNX towers, and found their old studios sitting at the tower site with a for sale sign in front of it. Looked like a nice location to work in with all the trees around it. It's basically a residential area. From there, the next step was to pull the Google map up and plug in my location co-ordinates.
