WMRO 1560kHz Gallatin, TN DX Test. Date(s): Midnight to Five AM Central Time October 30th thru ???. Time: Midnight until 5:00AM Central Time. Modes of Operation: "Inventory Insert" 60 Second Long Test. 0.003kw Non-Directional. (One night may include a brief full daytime power test). Programming: Morse Code ID's, Sweep Tones, 60 Second Long "Inventory Insert" during local breaks. Notes: Transmitter audio chain testing. Exact times of the inserted spots will be given closer to the test time period. In general, look for the test to run near the Top of the Hour (TOH). The extreme low power of this station at night should make this one a nice challenge!

This test will likely continue nightly for months to come, so please try for it.

Please note the following change in QSL information: The station now desires to receive reports directly and only via regular Postal Mail. No telephone calls or e-mails, please! Scott Bailey is dealing with a family medical situation, so responses may take several weeks. Be patient and do not make this too much of a chore for him.

SPECIAL "WEST COAST VERSION" WNTP/WFIL DX TEST. Rene Tetro has agreed to another test of stations WNTP/WFIL, this time with West Coast DX'ers in mind. Instead of the usual Midnight to 2AM tests of the past, this one will take place much later at night (0500AM local, making it 2:00AM on the West Coast). Having a 50KW test this late at night should really give some folks out West the chance to put this one in the log book. Ditto for the lower powered WFIL. Details below, and our sincere thanks to Rene Tetro!

WNTP 990kHz Philadelphia, PA DX Test, WFIL 560 Philadelphia, PA DX Test. Date: Sunday Morning December 10th, 2006. Time: 0500-0600 Eastern Time. One hour test. Modes of Operation: Transmitter Testing to check on improvements to the new audio chain. Programming: Morse Code ID's, Sweep Tones, Voice ID. Notes: Transmitter audio chain testing. With WNTP running daytime power for 1/2 hour (50KW) this should present a real opportunity for DX'ers on the West Coast to log this station/state.

0530-0600 5kw Non-Directional 0530-0600 2.5kw Non-Directional

I think I have a 50/50 chance of logging it, as I often hear WPHT-1210 also in Philly, and I used to hear KYW before my powerful local KHBC-1060, which never breaks down, went NSP. It would be easier if the WNTP test were at my SSS, say 2200-2400 EST, when KHBZ is often skipped out, but I can't have everything. WFIL-560 is unlikely, as I have only heard one mainlander there, KSFO, and noise level is higher, my quite short antennas not very directional. Thanks to Nancy Johnson for her appreciation of my logging of WBAL-1090. Others in this category I'm working on are tentative on WTIC-1080 CT and WOWO-1090 IN. DXers beware when you hear Hindi/Punjabi on 1200. Now it might be CJRC BC, already heard as far inland as MT, or KYAA CA which often outstrips WOAI here. I can confirm Gary Larson's observation in DXF 11/4 that XESURF-540 BCN has gone country //KKGO-1260 CA. It seems to ID more as KKGO than as the XE. Both good here. I'm enjoying the Lucky 7 contest but still lagging, as I'm so busy DXing the rare DX which is superb this year, and haven't had time to the West Coast. Busy with my Kona coffee business took and I may be opening a fruit and coffee stand at a potential Beverage location soon (both kinds of beverage, come to think of it-the java and the antenna). Rce, thanks for explaining that WWLV-1620 only 136 miles north of you blocks much-wanted WDHP-VI.
