Robert S. Womack rejects Marvin Sapp's investment in WJNZ-AM radio station

Robert S. WomackGRAND RAPIDS -- Radio personality Robert S. Womack has given back \$150,000 to gospel recording artist Marvin Sapp, who committed the money last week to help save the city's only urban station WJNZ-AM (1140). Womack said he and three other investors dug deeper into their pockets to make up the difference.Last week, Marvin Sapp and his wife, MaLinda, announced their investment and outlined their vision to give the radio station a more family friendly format. Womack said Sapp also wanted to move the station to the grounds of Lighthouse Full Life Center Church in Grand Rapids, where he is a pastor.

"We don't believe that we should be talking about the format unless we win in court," said Womack, adding that other investors felt Sapp's comments could hurt their court case. Womack said another sticking point is that the Sapps wanted a 75 percent stake in the radio for their 50 percent investment. Womack said his attorneys recommended against the deal.The Sapps couldn't be reached for comment Wednesday afternoon. Womack said he and the Sapps remain on good terms. The financial split between Womack and Sapp is the latest twist in a legal saga to preserve the 31-year-old urban station, which went into receivership after the previous owner defaulted on a bank loan. Womack contends there were irregularities in the bidding process that resulted in the station's pending sale to Holy Family Radio, of Lowell. A hearing on that issue before Kent County Circuit Judge Christopher Yates has been pushed back to Oct. 19. Yates required Womack to place in escrow \$315,000 -- \$5,000 more than Catholic group's winning bid -- in the event the court hearing resulted in Holy Family backing out of the deal. The court delay was at the request of all parties' attorneys and had nothing with his investor issues, Womack said. He said he remains optimistic the issues can be resolved outside court."We want to help Holy Family Radio and the Sapps find their own signals on the radio," Womack said.Holy Family Radio broadcasts Catholic programs on three stations: WMJH-AM (810), WPRR-AM (1680) and WTKG-AM (1230). Womack said his group also would consider acquiring another AM station -- or a more expensive FM station that has a stronger broadcast signal. But the latter would require him to raise three to four times what he has in hand to purchase WJNZ, he said, "We can only afford half of the \$1.2 million but could make some payment arrangement," Womack said. 48,000 watts with an effective height of the antenna above average terrain of 93.7metres). The applicant proposes a Classic Hits format. The applicant is requesting permission to simulcast the programming of the new FM station on CFOK for a period of three months from the date of implementation of the new station. The applicant is also requesting, pursuant to sections 9(1)(e) and 24(1) of the Broadcasting Act, the revocation of the licence of CFOK effective at the end of the simulcast period. (PM-OR)

KVTT Christian radio switches from FM to AM by Andy Sennitt

After 33 years as a Christian station in Dallas-Fort Worth, KVTT radio will sign off from its 91.7 frequency at 6 pm on Monday. But General Manager Doug Price said the station has entered into a lease agreement with North Texas-based M&M Broadcasters that will allow KVTT to broadcast on 1110 AM.

Mr Price said that the station could take over the frequency, which now broadcasts a Spanish-language format, as early as Thursday but that the change will more likely happen by mid-October. He says 1110 AM is also a lower-powered station than 91.7 and is licensed as a "daytimer," which operates sunrise to sunset under FCC regulations. "There are some months of the year when you don't sign on till a quarter till 8 in the morning," Price said. "[But] we're going to have KVTT.com, which will carry everything the station does carry, and overnight it will continue with programming." Mr Price added that the FCC has approved a power increase to 50,000 watts and that the station will encourage listeners to follow the Internet stream after signoff.KVTT has to vacate the 91.7 FM frequency after selling it in June for \$18 million to North Texas Public Broadcasting, owner of KERA/90.1 FM and Channel 13. North Texas Public Broadcasting has announced plans to launch an eclectic music station, KKXT, on 9 Novemberat 91.7 FM. The frequency will be silent for several weeks before then. Mr Price said the \$18 million went toward the debt load that forced KVTT to sell. He said the station will be less expensive to operate under the lease agreement. And the noncommercial station has been conducting a telethon, which Price said had raised \$100,000 by midday on Friday. "It's been a family affair among our core demographics and supporters, who really were sorrowful at the loss of the station," Price said. "We're a 100,000 watt FM with 33 years' experience. Controversial Kalispell radio station goes silent as bankruptcy officers seize property By MICHAEL JAMISON of the Missoulian

KALISPELL - A controversial talk radio station was silenced to static on Thursday, when bankruptcy officials seized and closed Kalispell's KGEZ, owned by John Stokes. Stokes has been a center of conflict for years, with supporters praising his anti-environmental message and critics decrying what they said were extreme and uncivil rants. He was unavailable for comment Thursday. Initially, Stokes made headlines by referring to environmentalists as Nazis, and burning green swastikas outside his station, but in recent years he became more well known for his legal wranglings. The most dramatic of those was a \$3.8 million defamation judgment against him, when jurors decided last year that Stokes had knowingly made false on-air comments about his neighbors. Dayar and Todd Gardner, and that he had done so with malicious intent. That judgment tipped Stokes deeply into debt (he already had previous difficulties with mortgage creditors and tax collectors) and he eventually filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy. Questions quickly arose, however, regarding his financial filings, and trustees asked that his bankruptcy be converted to Chapter 7, under which he would lose control of his assets. Charlie Harball, Kalispell city attorney, testified at an Aug. 14 bankruptcy hearing that Stokes' plan for solvency - which included getting the city to pay him millions for his land in order to expand the municipal airport - was "completely untenable." "He had this plan, to get the \$3.8 million judgment thrown out and to receive millions from the city," Harball said. "That wasn't going to happen. "He just didn't come across as being terribly credible with the bankruptcy judge." Judge Ralph B. Kirscher eventually ruled that Stokes should be placed in Chapter 7 bankruptcy, saying in his decision that Stokes had failed to accurately disclose his assets to the court, had failed to meet financial reporting requirements, had failed to pay filing fees and had not filed state or federal income taxes for several years. "Literally millions of dollars of purported assets were omitted," Kirscher wrote, including lawsuits, vehicles and at least one boat. Stokes initially listed personal property assets of \$148,000, for instance, but later amended that to more than \$15 million. "His declarations," the judge determined, "are not truthful." Missoula attorney Dick Samson was appointed to take control of Stokes' assets, including the radio station. Some had speculated that Samson would allow the station to continue operating while the bankruptcy case proceeded, but Harball was not surprised when the seizure order was issued. Stokes, he said, had established during the hearing that the station was not making money, and that he was losing money at a rate of nearly \$40,000 per month."When you're falling behind at that rate, and you don't have a plan with some reasonable chance of success, then the options become limited," Harball said. Flathead County Undersheriff Pete Wingert said Thursday's station seizure "went just fine. John was nothing but professional." According to Wingert, Stokes was on the air when officers arrived at about 2 p.m., and told listeners that authorities had arrived as expected. "He just signed off, and that was it." Wingert said. It took about an hour for Stokes and six others at KGEZ to vacate the station, and for bankruptcy officials to secure the property. With Z-600 now off the air, Harball said the trustee will decide how best to liquidate the assets and repay those with a claim on Stokes. Generally, he said, tax collectors are first in line, followed by mortgage holders and then judgement creditors, such as the Gardners. KKAT changes format from oldies music to 'Utah's Big Talker' By Lynn Arave Deseret News

Oldies music is now gone on "The Wolf," and a "Big Talker" format has arrived in its place.KKAT (AM-860) made the switch to a syndicated talk-ABC news station Monday. The station is now billed as "Utah's Big Talker." The Don Imus show is aired in the early morning, along with "America's Morning News" (7-10 a.m.) Imus is connected to Citadel Broadcasting, and since KKAT is a Salt Lake Citadel station, he landed there. (The Imus show was on the air in Salt Lake City years ago, but it didn't last long. We'll see how it goes this time.) KKAT also has other syndicated talk shows — Mark Levin, Joe Scarborough and Curtis Sliwa. In essence, KKAT has landed many of the talk shows that weren't already in the Salt Lake market. Whatever the new KACP talk radio format on AM-570 didn't land last month has been taken by this new station. The surprising thing is that there seems to be no local talk show host on "Utah's Big Talker." How can it truly be the state's "big talker" without that? Tom Barberi was surely available, but national talk shows must be cheaper and easier to use. AM-860 still carries "The Wolf" nickname. However, the station's Web site hasn't been updated to reflect the changes at the station. Will the new "Wolf" succeed? With all the national issues of medical care, foreign wars and the lagging economy, there's certainly plenty to fuel this station. (DP-HI)
