From Mydesert.com. Listen up, KDES and KWXY radio fans. Their programs won't change, but you'll soon need to adjust your radio dial to get them following a \$17.5 million deal. R&R Radio Corp. of Palm Springs has cleared the last Federal Communications Commission hoop to sell the 104.7 FM channel that KDES now uses to LC Media LP, a Santa Monica investment group led by former Clear Channel Los Angeles executive Roy Laughlin. The \$10.5 million sale to LC Media, set for Monday, will change the city of license for 104.7 FM to Redlands. Once the ink is put to paper, it will consummate the \$7.5 million transfer of the KWXY-FM license long controlled by Glen Barnett Inc., to R&R of Palm Springs, said FCC spokesman Peter Doyle. The transactions will trigger a series of events for Coachella Valley radio listeners beginning Tuesday. KDES-FM moves its "Greatest Hits" of the 1960s and 1970s station to 98.5 FM, the 50,000-watt frequency that KWXY-FM had been operating on \* KWXY-FM reverts back to 1340 AM, its original radio frequency. \* KPTR-AM, the progressive talk radio show carried on 1340 AM, moves to 1450 AM, the new home for the Los Angeles Angels. \* KGAM-AM, the talk station on 1450 AM, will be disbanded. \* KPSI, operating on both radio bands, stays the same. Ric Supple, chief operating officer of R&R, said all the changes are predicated on the sale Monday of the 104.7 FM Channel license to LC Media. (DP-HI)

#### 690 CINF 940 CINW QE MONTREAL

FROM THE NATIONAL POST 01-29-10 Canada's first radio station fell silent Friday night, as Canadian media and entertainment empire Corus Entertainment Inc., pulled the plug on two Montreal AM stations. AM Info690 Montreal and AM940 Montreal's Greatest Hits went off the air at 7 p.m. local time. Both were deemed unprofitable. AM940 is a direct descendent of Canada's first radio station, CFCF originally at the 600 dial on the AM band. In 1919, the Canadian Marconi Co., launched XWA (Experimental Wireless Apparatus) in Montreal and it became the first commercial broadcast radio station in Canada. The name was switched to CFCF in November 1920. Before the station signals were killed, recordings ran most of the day. They were made by general managers of the respective stations, thanking listeners and advertisers, and explaining it was a difficult decision to close the stations. "We put tremendous effort into trying to find the right format and content to grow our audience base and operate profitably, but after years of effort, it is clear these AM stations are not viable," Mario Cecchini, vice-president of subsidiary Corus Quebec, said in a prepared statement. Brian Kenemy, a former vice-president of Corus Quebec's English radio holdings, said in an interview that he thinks Corus "did its best to hang on as long as they could, looking for affordable formats." But with most money directed toward FM programming, Mr. Kenemy suggested that the public company found it too difficult to continue supporting the struggling stations. Bourget MNA Maka Kotto, Parti Quebecois culture and communications critic, argued the closing of Info690 "is not good news because it sounds the death knell of another francophone newsroom in Montreal and further undermines the media in Quebec." The decision to cease operations affects eight jobs at Info690 - three journalists, two traffic reporters and three operations positions - but five of those positions are to be retained. The Info690 Montreal newsroom, known as CorusNouvelles, will continue its activities as part of 98.5 FM Montreal. Two jobs, an on-air host and a technician, are affected at AM940, which switched from all news to all music in 2008. (DP-HI)

## 1180 VOA FL, Marathon: From Andy Sennitt's blog on the Radio Netherlands Media Network site:

The Voice of America (VOA) has expanded its Creole service from 1.5 hours to 5 hours on weekdays following the earthquake in Haiti. The service is now on the air at 1230-1330, 1730-1930, 2200-2300 UTC and 0100-0200 UTC. The evening programs are being carried on 1180 AM from the transmitter in Marathon, Florida, which normally carries Radio Martí in Spanish to Cuba. VOA says this is because most of its satellite affiliates in Haiti are off the air. (EB-MO)

#### 1480 KLMS NE Lincoln FROM JOURNALSTAR.COM

Three Eagles Communications has dropped sports talk in favor of Oldies Music at Lincoln Radio Station KLMS 1480 AM less than two weeks before the Super Bowl. The Lincoln-based radio company issued a press release Tuesday, exclaiming "Lincoln's Music Station, 1480 KLMS is back!" The new format, which will include music by such artists as the Beatles, Rolling Stones, Elton John, The Eagles and more, went on the air Tuesday, but officially kicks off at 10 a.m. Wednesday. The new format will target adults 35 and older. KLMS has been a sports talk station – Lincoln's only one – since 1997 and an ESPN affiliate since 2000. Before 1997, the AM station featured music and was extremely popular in Lincoln in the 1960s and '70s, turning such folks as Lee Thomas, Jay Marshall Stewart and the morning duo Gary and Judy into household

names. "Those great days of the past are back on the radio again with KLMS," general manager Joy Patten said in a press release. "We are so excited to be bringing back a radio station that so many folks in Lincoln grew up with. (DP-HI)
