In this Forfeiture Order we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) to Barnesville Broadcasting, Inc. ("Barnesville Broadcasting"), former licensee of Station WBAF (AM), Barnesville, Georgia ("Station"), for its willful violation of Section 73.3539 of the Commission's Rules ("Rules"), by failing to timely file a license renewal application for the Station. On February 27, 2007, the Bureau issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture ("NAL"), in the amount of one thousand, five hundred dollars (\$1,500) to Barnesville Broadcasting for willfully violating Section 73.3539 of the Rules, based on the fact that it failed to timely file a renewal application for the Station. As noted in the NAL. Barnesville Broadcasting's renewal application for the Station's license term was due on December 1, 2003, four months prior to the April 1, 2004, expiration date. Barnesville Broadcasting did not file the application until March 23, 2004, and provided no explanation for the untimely filing of the renewal application. In response to the NAL, Barnesville Broadcasting submitted a letter on March 20, 2007. In its Letter, Barnesville Broadcasting asserts that the proposed forfeiture should be cancelled because: its failure to timely file its renewal application was an oversight, and paying the forfeiture would present a financial hardship.
