F.C.C. FINES

KBRZ Missouri City Tx – \$ 4,000 fine for failing to operate with in authorized power limits.

KVOZ (AM) Del Mar Hills, Texas - \$ 21,000 for failure to: (1) maintain a main studio in the community of license; (2) operate consistent with the terms of its station authorization; and (3) maintain and make available a complete public inspection file.

KSRA Salmon, Idaho \$13,000 failing to file a timely license renewal application for the Station, and apparently willfully and repeatedly violated Section 301 of the Act,4 by engaging in Unauthorized operation of the Station after its authorization had expired.

From Inside Radio dot com : Tower down in northern Michigan.

Way up on the northern shore of Michigan's Upper Peninsula, Great Lakes Radio's WQXO, Munising, MI (1400) lost its tower in a windstorm earlier this month. Owner Todd Noordyk tells the FCC the phone started ringing right away when the station went off the air, and he's now back on the air with 100 watts into a longwire antenna (instead of the usual 1-kw) while he works to rebuild the downed tower. Memphis AMs return to normal, half a year later.

From Inside Radio dot com : George Flinn's WGSF, Memphis, TN (1030) was one of several stations in the market knocked off the air in early May by the historic flooding on the Mississippi River and its tributaries. Those tributaries were especially hard-hit by water that backed up when it couldn't flow into the swollen Mississippi River. WGSF's site sat along one of those tributaries, Harrison Creek, which flows into the Wolf River and then into the Mississippi – and it took more than five months for the three-tower, 50-kw facility to once again get back on the air. When the flooding silenced WGSF, Flinn moved its leased-time Spanish-language programming up the dial to WMPFS, Bartlett, TN (1210), and it remained there until just last week when it returned to 1030. That allowed WMPFS to return to its former conservative talk format, which had continued on Flinn's "Franken-FM" in the market, WPGF-LP (Ch. 6), in the meantime.

From Inside Radio dot com : Another Phoenix AM move-in. It's about 40 miles from the dusty desert town of Miami, Arizona westward along US 60 to Apache Junction, at the edge of the sprawling Phoenix metro area – and soon, KIKO (1340) will be making that move. Owner 1TV.com is no stranger to Phoenix AM rimshot move-ins: it recently relocated KBSZ from 1250 in Wickenburg, 50 miles northwest of Phoenix, to 1260 in Apache Junction, and now it holds a CP to relocate KIKO to the same site now used by KBSZ. The new KIKO would use 1000 watts by day, 930 watts at night, with usable coverage of only the easternmost suburbs of Phoenix. 1TV.com already augments KBSZ's talk format on 1260 with an FM translator, and will likely do the same with the relocated 1340 signal.

FROM HUFFINGTON POST DOT COM Norman Corwin Dead: Radio Legend Dies At 101

During a career that spanned more than 70 years, Norman Corwin wrote, produced and directed for radio, television, film and the stage. His insightful writing earned Emmy and Golden Globe awards. He received an Academy Award nomination for his script for the 1956 film "Lust for Life," the biography of Vincent van Gogh starring Kirk Douglas. But radio was Corwin's true passion. Corwin, a creative giant of the Golden Age of Radio whose programs chronicling World War II are milestones in broadcasting, died Tuesday at his Los Angeles home of natural causes, according to the USC Annenberg School for Communication & Journalism where Corwin remained a writer in residence until his death. He was 101. Actor William Shatner, who narrated several of Corwin's later radio programs, called him a legend and his hero. He is "the poetic soul of discretion and a monument to artistry in America," Shatner once said. Throughout the 1940s, Corwin was well known to millions of Americans who depended on radio for their link to the world. His work during that

so-called Golden Age of Radio ran the gamut of creative offerings, from variety shows to dramas, comedies to documentaries.

FROM: RADIO INFO DOT COM - Clear Channel Gives News/Talk WVOC-AM Columbia, S.C. an FM Signal Today at 1 pm ET, Clear Channel flipped Urban WXBT "100.1 the Beat" Columbia, S.C., to a simulcast of co-owned News/Talk/Sports WVOC-AM. "The Beat" had been mainstream urban since 2003, and ran the syndicated Russ Parr Morning Show. It primarily competed with Inner City broadcasting's WHXT "Hot 103.9." According to the radio-Info.com boards, the entire staff of The Beat is out including PD Bo Money
