Also, there's 2 FM stations at the Missouri Science and Technology University campus (KMST 88.5 and KMNR 89.7), plenty of eating places within one half mile of motel. Ash Wednesday 2012 will be a memorable one. That's because at 0154 ELT on February 22, I pulled in my 1,300th AM station when I logged WSP0 1390 Charleston, SC with a promo for the upcoming Daytona 500, quick ID into Fox Sports Radio, a few seconds behind local affiliate KSLG 1380. That also makes it an even dozen from the Palmetto State, and ten on 1390. Some of the new ones I've logged in recent days: WMTM 1300 Moultrie, GA came through 2/11 at 0300 ELT with a legal ID mentioning W288BO 105.1 in nearby New Elm, GA, into CBS News. The signal pretty much took out WOAD at this location. I had never logged this station while I was living in Georgia in the late '80s and early '90s; I only logged the FM in metro Atlanta, even next to WSTR 94.1. That makes it 52 AM stations from the Empire State of the South. KTBB 600 Tyler, TX noted 2/13 at 0149 with Texas Overnight (originating from KRLD 1080 Dallas), promo, legal ID into ABC news at 0200, taking out WREC. I added to my Mexican log at 0220 on 2/15 when XEKV 740 Villahermosa poked through CFZM with pop music, "Exa" mention and ID mentioning XHKV 88.5 in Spanish. This log also added a new Mexican state: Tabasco. XEVX 570 (also in Villahermosa) heard 2/16 at 0340 with light vocal music, "La Grande" mentions and calls at 0400, mixing with Cuba, WNAX and WVNC. WSBI 1210 Static, TN noted at 1805 2/16 with Christian teaching and Contemporary Christian music in Spanish, mixing with WILY and WPHNT. KZNG 1340 Hot Springs, AR noted 2/18 at 0300 with an ID through several others. WJZM 1400 Clarksville, TN noted with legal ID 2/18 at 2051 through several others, including the usual WGIL. WRRD

1510 Waukesha, WI noted 2/19 1829 with mention of local and national sponsors. "ESPN Deportes" mention and soccer highlights in Spanish until the carrier was cut at 1831. A good signal was noted, taking out WLAC and WWHN. WTLS 1300 Tallassee, AL noted 2/19 at 2147 with '80s hits and an ID mentioning an FM relay; a fair to poor signal was noted over WOAD. WTLS is the 62nd AM station noted from the Heart of Dixie. KFMZ 1470 Brookfield, MO noted 2/20 at 0158 with a Hot Adult Contemporary format and legal ID mentioning sister station KZBK 96.9, sometimes taking out WMBD. KFMZ is the 92nd AM station from my state of residence heard. I logged the FM at my present location on June 29, 1996. The conditions this DX season has favored more Mexicans and Southerners than usual this season, enabling me to add two new Mexican states (Tabasco and Aguascalientes); however, several new stations and call letter changes have been added from north of the Mason-Dixon Line. In my log, which I've kept since returning to the St. Louis area in 1992, the five most DX-productive U.S. states have been Illinois (105 stations), Missouri (92), Texas (87), Tennessee (84) and Alabama (62). The five most DX-productive Canadian provinces have been Ontario (35 stations), Manitoba (14), Quebec (8), and a tie between Alberta and Saskatchewan (7 apiece). As for Mexican states, the five most productive have been Nuevo Leon and Tamaulipas (7 each), Coahuila (5), Chihuahua (4) and a tie between San Luis Potosi, Tabasco and Veracruz (2 apiece), along with eight from Mexico City (Distrito Federal, or the Federal District). In the U.S., apart from Alaska and Hawaii, I have not heard a single AM from Delaware, Idaho, Maine, New Hampshire, New Mexico and Vermont. With WEW 770 staying on until two hours after sunset and WBBM 780 operating in digital around the clock, I'm not counting on hearing KKOB unless the FCC puts the final nail in the coffin of digital operation on AM. In addition to their digital operation, KFJ 850 has been spluttering badly in recent days, totally obliterating 820 to 870 and interfering with WJLR 880. I've also noted a video-style buzz on WSDZ 1260 at night in recent months too; I would guess a glitch with the digital operation on their 5 kW night power. Fortunately, the digital sidebands of KATZ 1600 can be nulled down enough to pull in DX on 1590 around the clock, as well as CHHA 1610 at night; the same with KMOX 1120 to hear KWKH 1130 on some nights. 73.
