A poor to very poor signal was noted, mixing with WAEB and other stations, confirmed via Tune-In Web stream. Web site address is now WQSV 790 AM-dot-com. Apparent call change, ex-WJNA. (PS-ON)  
850 KOA **CO**, Denver – 1/19 2236 noted with a mention of Denver, *The Dave Ramsey Show*, ad cluster including one for a law firm mentioning Area Code 303, "KOA News Radio" ID at 2249. A fair at times to very poor signal was noted, mostly under WKNR. (PS-ON)  
1000 WRTG **NC**, Garner – 1/19 0702 noted with "WRTG Raleigh/Durham... La Grande" quasi-legal ID by a heavily accented male announcer in English; a new station in the logbook. The signal was noted mixing with WMVP and unidentified stations with talk, Classic Hits and Country formats. (KK-VA)  
1040 WZSK **PA**, Everett – 1/19 0731 noted with a mention of "Brought to you by the Pennsylvania School Board Association" by one male announcer and "News/Talk 1040 Accu-Weather forecast" by another male announcer. 1340 WMID **NJ**, Atlantic City – 1/19 1030 noted with an Oldies format, ID with mention of Web streaming, into local and regional sports talk. A fair signal was noted, but weaker than WCMC 1230. (RL-NC)  
1380 WHEW **TN**, Franklin – 1/22 1839 noted with upbeat Adult Contemporary music and talk between songs in Spanish, "Bonita" mention at 1842 before another music set. A fair to very poor signal, mixing with an unidentified station with a talk format in Spanish. (PS-ON)

603 **REP KOREA** HLSA, Seoul, KBS2. Very good level pop music at 1525 1/30; the only TP seeming to get any kind of sunrise enhancement boost <https://app.box.com/s/tir1d2gnh486wj7w5ktzkd5wqyg3n0v1>. (GDB-WA)  
612 **AUSTRALIA** 4QR, Brisbane. Had been heard fairly well earlier, but this shone at 1504 12/23 with a perfectly readable sports report, capital area weather for various capitals (warm... that was 30-35 degrees C, not the 30-35 F this listener was experiencing), then ABC News and ABC local radio promo. #### Long Beach Island-15 DXpedition via Russ Edmunds

The 15<sup>th</sup> annual Long Beach Island DXpedition took place in Ship Bottom NJ November 3-5 2016. Conditions were moderately auroral, although a few TAs did sneak through. The result was many new loggings from México, Colombia, Venezuela and Nicaragua as well as numerous new domestics. These conditions also enabled us to add Ecuador to our list of countries heard. We also welcomed a new member of the crew, Doug Maset of Newburgh NY.

For this year, owing to the prior year's experiences with the final reconfiguration of the beach in the aftermath of Superstorm Sandy, we moved our headquarters from the middle of the building on the beach to the South end. This provided us with corner rooms which in turn had less electrical noise and easier access to the areas where we could place our antennas.

As a result of greater use of SDRs, we had a larger number of loggings than we have had in any prior year, but that comes with the side effect of taking longer to compile a group log.

As always, regardless of the conditions, the act of getting together to DX and talk about DX remains the highlight of the weekend.
