- 600 KCOL **CO**, Wellington heard 2/3 at 0833 with "600 KCOL." (BB-AZ)
- 650 WSM **TN**, Nashville 1/30 good in KMTI null 2340 with country music, numerous "WSM" mentions, Nashville weather, mentioned it was "Hall of Fame Monday" on WSM. First time heard. State #24 heard from Mesa. (JCJ-AZ)
- 740 KVOR **CO**, Colorado Springs heard 2/3 at 0843 with "KVOR" then news. (BB-AZ)
- 1010 KXPS **CA**, Thousand Palms heard 2/2 at 0900 with "KXPS Thousand Palms." (BB-AZ)

- 650 WSRO **MA**, Ashland – 1/29 2135 turned the loop to note music in assumed Portuguese, quasi-legal ID at 2200..."FM, 650 AM WSRO Boston" into assumed newscast in Portuguese. A poor to very poor signal was noted under WSM with WNMT and HJKH (RCN Antena Dos) nulled; confirmed via Tune-In Web stream. (PS-ON)
- 660 WLOY **VA**, Rural Retreat – 1/26 2326 on after sunset with AC/Oldies format featuring selections by Arlo Guthrie, Kenny Loggins, Bobby Darin and Whitney Houston, "WLOY, 660 on Your Dial" ID at 2352. A poor to very poor signal was noted, mostly under WFAN; pretty good for 550 watts! (PS-ON)
- 810 CKJS **MB**, Winnipeg – 1/26 2250 noted with upbeat music (assumed Middle Eastern), ad in English mentioning Area Code 204, "In Winnipeg, this is CKJS" ID into possible programming in German, including news and Polka-style music. A very poor signal was noted under WGY, confirmed via Tune-In Web stream. (PS-ON)
- 960 WHYL **PA**, Carlisle – 1/31 2213 noted with Classic Hits format featuring a tune by Earth, Wind and Fire, DJ named the tune, talked about a coffee survey, "Good Time Oldies 960 WHYL" ID at 2215, ad cluster including Geico, Go to Meeting-dot-Com, Jergens Lotion and MD Hearing Aids, "Here's another Classic Hit... 960 WHYL" ID into a selection by The Guess Who. A fair at times to very poor signal was noted, mixing with WFIR and several other stations. (PS-ON)
- 1070 WGOS **NC**, High Point – 1/27 0701 noted with this legal ID by a female announcer in English: "This is WGOS 1070 AM High Point". The signal was noted mixing with WINA, WNCT and unidentified stations with Christian teaching and ESPN Radio; a new station in the logbook. (KK-VA) (Kraig, your Christian teaching station may be WFLI Lookout Mountain TN; your ESPN station is WFNI Indianapolis IN – eb)
- 1080 WWDR **NC**, Murfreesboro – 1/27 0724 noted with "WWDR" ID by a male announcer into an Urban Gospel song. The signal was noted mixing with WKBY, WTIC, WWNL and unidentified stations with talk, vocal music and Spanish language formats. (KK-VA) (Your Spanish station may be one of my ex-employers, WFTD Marietta GA – eb)
- WKBY **VA**, Chatham – 1/27 0713 noted with "Good morning, this is WKBY in Chatham, Virginia" sign-on by a male announcer. The signal was noted mixing with WTIC, WWDR, WWNL and unidentified stations with talk, vocal music and Spanish language formats. (KK-VA)
- 1090 KAAV **AR**, Little Rock – 1/27 0627 noted with a "1090 KAAV" ID by a male announcer into Christian music. The signal was noted mixing with WBAL, WKTE, WTSB and an unidentified Oldies station. (KK-VA)
- 1380 WHEW **TN**, Franklin – 1/22 1839 noted with Adult Contemporary format, brief talk and "Bonita ID" in Spanish at 1842 into another music set. A fair to very poor signal was noted, mixing with an unidentified Talk station in Spanish. (PS-ON)

UNIDENTIFIED

- 1060 1/27 0700 noted with this presumed ID by a male announcer in Spanish-accented English: "WBAO 780 AM Summerfield, W295BD Winston-Salem". Maybe "Summerfield" was "Summerville". I listened several times and have no idea what I was hearing. (KK-VA) (There are two stations on 780 in North Carolina; both feature Christian formats in English. Two of the three stations in NC on 1060 feature Spanish format; one was reported silent. The 106.9 in Winston-Salem is W295CE according to Doug Smith's list. W295BD is in Mount Sterling KY – eb)

So it's obviously XEMU Piedras Negras, Coahuila on the border. Fortunately, no wasteful wall will prevent signals penetrating from our good neighbor to the south. Also hearing many of the other usual pre-sunrise N/W Mexicans up to 870 XETAR. [Hauser-OK]
- 770 **MÉXICO** XEACH, Monterrey, NL. JAN 23 0438 – "desde todo el equipo de Luces de la Ciudad" birthday greetings; on to actividades "en el sector chino de nuestra ciudad" for Chinese New Year imminent, also mentions Zona Rosa (which I suppose exist elsewhere than the DF), boletos disponibles. Typically this would be XEACH with KKOBB/KKOBB easily nulled. This is during the local-content cutaway from 'La Hora Nacional' aprovechado by many stations, but they seem to think "nuestra ciudad" is sufficient identification. There might be same programming on 570, 630, 900, 990, 1050, 1140, but no exact matches. [Hauser-OK]

- 3 new countries (Japan, Rep Korea, Colombia)
- First log from Nayarit
- First TPs
- 155 high school football games from 18 states
- Some nice low-power catches (like KDDD-800 and KCHE-1440)
- A ton of Cubans (VERY auroral conditions must have helped)
- Dozens of frustrating near-misses on Mexican stations (still trying to find the optimal antenna angles, I guess)

This year's recordings took forever to review, especially the Mexican and Cuban loggings.

Corrections and UNID help are always welcome....

Receiver: Perseus SDR-IQ v4.1/Lenovo W540 laptop with eSSD drive (a very small drive, but also very fast and quiet).

Antennas: Beverages on ground, as follows:

1. **NNNW** (350°) 1350 ft terminated (first 3 nights only). Tried to go for 340°, but there were too many obstacles, including a fence at the Nevada border). Despite being somewhat crooked, this wire performed great, bringing in lots of WA/OR stations, some TPs, and my first and only Alaskan.
2. **ENNE** (31°) 2340 ft terminated (2nd night only). The aurora was wiping out signals in this direction, so I moved it after one night to become antenna #8.
3. **ENE** (66°) 1540 ft terminated (first 3 nights only). The aurora hurt this one on the second night, and a sudden new source of noise arose suddenly around 7:30pm on the 3rd night (seemed to be some old power lines pressed back into service after a recent major transformer blowout; all my northern wires which crossed the highway were affected by this) so I moved it to become antenna #7.
4. **E** (85°) 2065 ft terminated (all 4 nights). Nice reception of KS and OK, and quite good to Cuba despite being aimed a bit N.
5. **SE** (131°) 3500 ft terminated (2nd night, broke at 935 ft; repaired for 3rd night as 1135 ft terminated).
6. **SE/NW** (140°) 1000 ft unterminated (1st 3 nights).
7. **SSE** (152°) 1540 ft terminated (4th night only).
8. **SSSE** (168°) 2340 ft unterminated (3rd and 4th night only; broke after the termination point on the last night).

This was my sixth visit to this location. This time I had 240 new catches, raising my totals from 1050 stations heard to 1290, just 61 shy of the 1351 stations I've accumulated in over 40 years DXing from San Diego. Once again this year's visit was timed to combine the end-of-September sunset/sunrise conditions with the so-called "high school football STA." That worked nicely! But I still need to be more careful planning my pre-sunset and post-sunrise recordings.

On the way to the beverage site we stopped in St George and had dinner with veteran GY DXer Ron Schiller who brought some more classic veries for show-and-tell (as did I, but his are far more impressive).

Once again I used an unterminated 1000 ft wire to aim in two directions at once (SE and NW), and it worked as planned, nabbing a few more TPs in the early morning hours.

I was initially rather discouraged this year. Perseus bugs had caused several recordings to terminate, ruining one top-of-hour recording and cutting off several others prematurely. A huge aurora began Friday and lasted through Sunday; this rendered antennas #2 and #3 ineffective and significantly reduced my opportunities on high school football night. SK, MB, MN and ND were essentially gone for the whole weekend (even CBK, CBW, WCCO, KSTP, etc.), and several other states and provinces were affected to some degree (SD, IA, NE, MT, AB and even WY). Antenna #1 was not impacted by the aurora; it brought in a lot of new catches from WA, OR and a few from BC. During the high school football hours on Friday night, when I change wires every 5 minutes or so, the lead on my coax cable began to fray down to nothing. Mistakenly thinking I had dropped my wire cutters in the field, I was unable to repair the lead until the next afternoon, and had to be extremely careful to avoid intermittent connections. Despite this problem, my more balanced monitoring and more frequent antenna-switching paid off, and I heard 155 HS FB games this year compared to 139 last year. Around 7:30 on Saturday night, a huge noise source suddenly appeared across the entire middle 50% of the dial, on all my northern wires (ie, antennas, 1, 2 and 3, the ones that crossed the highway). The owner of the motel told me there was a massive power surge just before our arrival which took a lot of local equipment out of service. I suspect some long-dormant power lines and a small electrical substation on the north side of the road were pressed back into service. I hope this is not a permanent condition! By Monday morning, the aurora was gone. I had already pulled up my northern wires by this point, but several stations from MN and ND were even coming in on the E wire (#4).

My Mexican antennas were aimed a bit too far to the S this time. Antenna #8 made some nice catches from BCS, JAL and NAY, and antenna #7 made a few good catches from JAL, PUEB and GJTO, but I dozens of Mexican anthems where I could not pull out the subsequent IDs. Next year I'll probably try something like 145 and 160 degrees. Reception of Cuba off E wire #4 was the best ever (despite being aimed well to the N of Cuba), and I got my first Colombians this year. Antennas #6 and #8 also picked up my first TP signals and first Alaskan off the back-end. I was probably too quick to give up on antenna #5.

By the time I got through all of the recordings, I realized conditions weren't quite as bad as I had thought.

CUBA: Although the clock-ticking and top-of-minute pip on the Reloj feed appear to be automated, the "RR" seemingly is not! On a typical minute it can appear anywhere between 2 and 3 seconds after the pip. But on each of my last 2 or 3 DXpeditions, I have recorded at least one case where somebody messed up, and didn't give the "RR" until 25 or 30 seconds into the minute. The next minute everything was fine again. Furthermore, on one particular minute on 950 kHz I heard 2 sets of "RR"s about 2 seconds apart. I was about to count a second Reloj station when I tuned around and realized that EVERY Reloj station gave 2 RR's that minute. On the one channel where I really did have 2 Reloj outlets coming in (790 kHz, with the 2nd station running about 1 second behind the first) I actually had 4 RR's that minute (strong, weak, strong, weak, each about 1 second apart, making it obvious what was going on). Without the multi-channel recording capability of the Perseus I'd have no way of detecting this (unless I happened to be listening to 790), and would have mistakenly added a station to my totals.

MEXICO: The FM migration which apparently began in 2011 is very hard to follow. Online searches and station web sites provide contradictory or ambiguous information about which stations are still simulcasting and which have fully migrated to FM. I've reviewed most of this year's Mexico catches two or three times to make sure I'm really hearing what I'm thinking I'm hearing.

UnID 10/3 0155 – Denver Broncos football network. No affiliates on 1600 kHz listed on official web site. (The official site is badly out-of-date; it still includes KEVA in Evanston, which has been off the air for a year or two, and wasn’t paying any bills for some time before that).
- 1610 WXK790 **AZ**, Phoenix. 10/3 0338 – “Welcome to Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport.” Relog.
 HARp **NV**, Elko. 9/30 0204 – Usual short message for NV DoT stations. “You’re listening to the Nevada Department of Transportation highway advisory radio, broadcasting on AM 16-10 and AM 5-30. For current road conditions go to **nroads.com** or dial 511.” Elko is by far the most likely location. Another station farther west near Emigrant Pass is still active as well. Relog.
 HAR **TX**, Unknown location. 10/1 0159 – SE wire (#6): “You’re listening to the Texas Department of Transportation highway construction radio broadcasting current road conditions.” At 0202 he appeared to say “...broadcasting from Central Peak.” I can’t find a peak with that name in Texas. Did not sound like the El Paso station(s) I have logged previously. This was probably a temporary mobile unit. I could probably count this as a new station, but I’d like to nail down the location first. Sent an inquiry to Texas DoT. Not too optimistic about a response but we’ll see what happens....
- KOP795 **UT**, Arches NP. 10/1 0210 – Fairly long tape loop with both male and female voices. Usual reminders about not stopping in the roadway, driving early and late to avoid road work delays, etc. Mentioned park web site **www.nps.gov/arch** and a different web site for campground reservations. New.
- CHHat **ON**, Toronto. 10/1 0255 – Asian chanting noted here. Initially hoped I had the Montreal station, but later learned that unneeded CHHA airs some South Asian programming, so I strongly suspect that’s what I was hearing.
UnID 9/30 1029 – NOAA weather (or equivalent) on NNNW wire. MAY have mentioned Helena and/or Missoula which would make this the station in Great Falls MT which gets out well. Not sure.
 +9/30 1259 – NNNW wire. Seemed to be a WA DoT HAR station with construction information. Couldn’t catch any details.
 +10/3 1105 – HAR station noted on SSE wire with information about a road closure on “road 1571” into Lubbock? Loveland? Levelland? Four-digit road numbers are common in TX and OK, and west TX would be possible on this wire, but I see no obvious matches in my Google map searches.
- 1620 KOZN **NE**, Bellevue. 9/30 0400 – Fighting through KSMH with Fox Sports. Relog.
 WTAW **TX**, College Station. 10/1 0245 – High school football: Temple Wildcats @A&M Consolidated Tigers. Relog.
 KYIZ **WA**, Renton. 9/30 1259 – Ad for catering company, promo “weekdays 1-3 on 16-20 AM KYIZ and the tunein radio app.” Relog.
- 1630 KKGm **TX**, Fort Worth. 10/1 0156 – Promo for **kkgmam.com**. Very rare for this station (or KCJJ) to poke through huge pest KRND-WY. Relog.
- 1640 KZLS **OK**, Enid. 10/1 0120 – High school football: Bethany Bronchos vs Harrah Panthers., sponsored by Golden Corral on Northwest Expressway. According to online sources, this team name is apparently “Bronchos,” not “Broncos.” The fighting windpipes?!
 +10/3 1159 – “KZLS Enid Oklahoma, the eagle” into SRN Town Hall news. Relog.
 KDZR **OR**, Lake Oswego. 10/1 0159 – “KDZR Lake Oswego-Portland, talk 16-40.”
 +10/3 0300 – Over KBJA-UT’s bilingual top-of-hour ID with “a service of Salem Media Group.” Relog.
- KBJA **UT**, Sandy. 10/1 0143 – “La super 16-40 KBJA.” Noted ESPN Deportes, at least at times. Relog.
- 1650 KBJD **CO**, Denver. 10/1 0052 – Spanish religion. “Radio luz, iluminando mente y corazón.” Relog.
 KSVE **TX**, El Paso. 10/1 0309 – ESPN Deportes programming including (Spanish) ads for Quaker State motor oil, which the announcer pronounced as “Quocker.” Relog.
- 1660 KQWB **ND**, West Fargo. 9/3 0400 – “KQWB West Fargo-Moorhead.” Relog.
 KRZI **TX**, Waco. 10/1 0120 – High school football: Midway Panthers vs Harker Heights Knights //KTON-1330, sponsored by Pinnacle Fence Company in Hulett. Game summary presented by Mexican restaurant. “ESPN Central Texas.” Relog.
- 1680 WPRR **MI**, Ada. 9/30 1100 – Call letter ID into public radio news. New.
- KNTS **WA**, Seattle. 10/1 0259 – Spanish contemporary Christian music, ID “KNTS 16-80, Salem Media Group.” Relog.
- 1690 KDMT **CO**, Denver. 9/30 1058 – Larry Elder show, “Denver’s money talk 16-90 AM, serving Denver’s financial community and the everyday investor.” Relog.
- 1700 KBGG **IA**, Des Moines. 9/30 0400 – Way underneath XEPE with ID. CBS Sports radio. Relog.
 KVNS **TX**, Brownsville. 10/2 1159 – “Fox Sports Rio Grande Valley” way under XEPE. Relog.
