

Gary de Bock writes, "Thank you very much for publishing the recent 2009 Ultralight Radio AM-DX Shootout article, and many other of my articles (which is greatly appreciated). As luck would have it, immediately after completion of the 2009 Shootout article, the leading Chinese radio manufacturer released their most innovative DSP pocket radio, which would have been a strong contender for top honors in the Shootout. The radio has multiple DSP selectivity options (1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 kHz), and has already been used by many North American DXers to log TA's and TP's in stock form. Because of the great interest in this new Tecsun PL-310 AM-LW-FM-SW model, I quickly prepared a full review article detailing its capabilities for interested DXers, including a comparison with the top-rated Shootout model, the Kchibo D96L. Shootout Day Arrives The gallant contestants assembled at noon on September 7, 2009 to decide their fate. They were joined by all surviving contestants of previous Ultralight radio Shootouts, who would join in the competition for ultimate Ultralight performance honors. The R911 and R9012 models were tested with the whip antenna in a vertical position. The D92L and D96L models were tested in the 1 kHz selectivity setting. Comments follow the grade in specific categories.

SENSITIVITY SUMMARY: The new Kchibo D96L has unsurpassed sensitivity on all AM frequencies, with a slight low and mid band advantage over all current contestants. It also has a slight edge over the DT-400W for top ULR sensitivity. The C.Crane SWP and R9012 are very competitive in sensitivity overall, with a slight high-band edge over the G8, which tends to perform better on the lower frequencies. The R911 tested here has a shade less sensitivity than its R9012 sibling on the low band, and both the D92L and DE1123 models are hopelessly outclassed in weak-signal performance-primarily because of weakly designed loopsticks.

SELECTIVITY SUMMARY: Once again, the D96L has superior performance with its 1 kHz DSP selectivity setting, an advantage that has practical DXing applications because of the model's class-leading sensitivity. The G8 is a close second, but lacks the D96L's 1 kHz filter choice option, and lags in sensitivity to dig out weak adjacent-channel DX. The DE1123 and D92L both have decent DSP selectivity designs, but suffer greatly from relatively deaf loopsticks in practical performance. The two analog models (R911 and R9012) have good selectivity for their price range, and the C.Crane SWP has fairly average selectivity in the general Ultralight category.

2009 Shootout Verdicts and Summary

The new Kchibo D96L model's impressive combination of high AM sensitivity and superb DSP



selectivity truly pushes the envelope Ultralight in radio performance, providing a new standard in overall DXing potential. winners of the previous Shootouts (SRF-T615, E100 and DT-400W) are all very competent AM receivers, but lacking in DSPenhanced selectivity, they cannot really compare with the D96L in adjacent-channel DXing capability. The D96L's unsurpassed AMsensitivity is the perfect complement for its 1 kHz DSP selectivity, which together provide a clear AM-DXing advantage over Ultralight every other radio. Although it does have engineering quirks that make it less than perfect, for overall value, this Chinese market radio is a superb bargain—especially for those 9 kHz-split **DXers** looking for maximum fun at minimum cost.

The Tecsun PL-300WT (a.k.a. Grundig G8) models benefit greatly from their 4734 DSP chips, which provide class-leading FM sensitivity and selectivity. Unfortunately the Tecsun designers failed to ensure optimum AM sensitivity in their loopstick production process, leading to variable results in DXing performance. With the optimum 1 kHz DSP selectivity potential of the 4734 chip not available, the PL-300WT/ G8 models will never perform at the high level of the D96L, either in AM sensitivity or selectivity.

These models will certainly have high appeal for FM-DXers, however, and for urban AM-DXers troubled by multiple local pests. It has high resistance to overload, and can minimize the irritation of mixing products and spurious signals. The G8's overall appeal as an AM-FM DXing radio makes it a good choice as a travel portable, along with its D96L competitor.

The C.Crane SWP model provides decent sensitivity in combination with versatile digital features, and has earned a place of respect in the Ultralight DXing group despite its 2-year old design. It has a low-noise RF front-end and a 455 kHz IF, providing the essential ingredients to quickly become the modified Ultralight radio of choice among the somewhat fanatical ULR transoceanic DXers (of whom the author is a dedicated member). Although its stock capabilities are quite impressive, the radio becomes an overachieving DXing wonder when modified with a 7.5" sliding coil ("Slider") loopstick and a Murata CFJ455K5 IF filter. With capabilities similar to the Eton E100, it has low-band AM sensitivity superior to the E100, and generally provides very capable overall performance, whether in stock or modified form.

The Degen DE1123 model was inspired by some superb design ideas, but for practical application in AM-DXing, the radio's poor loopstick design is really a deal-breaker. The DE1123 is practically deaf to weak-signal DX, making its superior DSP selectivity and included digital signal recorder irrelevant. For an FM-DXer looking for maximum versatility in a compact travel portable the DE1123 would merit attention, and the option to record FM stereo music in an Ultralight radio is unique. For AM enthusiasts, however, the DE1123 is a classic example of how a poor loopstick design can ruin an otherwise innovative radio.

The Kchibo D92L is another classic example of great design objectives being nullified by poor manufacturing execution. The D92L has all the design ingredients for success, but the loopstick receives severe digital hash from adjacent circuitry, degrading the AM sensitivity to an unacceptable level. Apparently Kchibo learned many lessons from the D92L issues, however, in designing the superb new D96L model. The puzzle is why the Chinese market prices for the two models are so similar, with such a drastic difference in AM-DXing performance.

The two analog models, the Tecsun R911 and R9012, both prove an exceptional AM-DXing value for a rock-bottom price. In comparison with their SRF-59 competition, both models have a higher general level of quality and life expectancy, with similar sensitivity, selectivity and nulling ability. They also include an effective speaker, with multi-band SW coverage as a bonus. DXers preferring a round tuning knob should choose the R9012—but make sure that the Chinese seller is going to provide you with a new model (see the warning), and the color of your choice. In the author's opinion, there has never been such a \$9.90 bargain in the history of AM-DXing!

Conclusion The new DSP-enhanced Ultralight radios have added even more DXing potential to the pocket radio class, and even more excitement to a niche hobby that was already a major enthusiasm center among the AM-DXing community. It is the author's sincere hope that this exhaustive purchasing guide will introduce you to the amazing new capabilities of these innovative receivers, and motivate you to join our fast-growing group of Ultralight radio enthusiasts. We welcome you to join in the legendary fun, and enjoy the thrilling AM-DXing future along with all of us.

Ecuador

Ecuador to nationalize radio and TV stations

Ecuadorian President Rafael Correa is seeking to take control of the country's radio and television stations in a bid to stave off "irregularities." The president announced his decision on Monday 3.8.2009 due to the "corruption and mediocrity" of "many" Ecuadorian news outlets. However, the leftwing president has not indicated the nature of the "irregularities" within Ecuador's broadcasting community. Correa's decision comes two days after a similar measure was introduced in Venezuela, where the government ordered the closure of 34 radio stations, in the latest bid to rein in the country's media. The Ecuadorian President has twice penalized opposition media since taking office in 2007.

They say that it took them quite some time to find an environmental-wise suitable location. So this is apparently indeed a new location, not the old one that had been closed down at some point in the past, probably towards the end of the nineties. http://www.northernstar.no/afrs.htm says that this old transmitter was infamous for poor groundwave coverage, hardly exceeding three kilometres. For the new transmitter the engineer says that he hopes it will reach "to the autobahn", which would be about ten kilometres. The video footage reveals a quite simple antenna, just a long whip with some wires as top load. Noteworth in the audio rack is an old analogue Optimod, almost dwarfing all the other equipment. Concerning the soldier (actually I was surprised about an AFN presenter only ranking as Private) announcing new FM coverage for Grafenwöhr, Vilseck and Bamberg, complementing but presumably not replacing 1107/1143 kHz: A few days ago a new transmitter in Grafenwöhr already went on air, on 98.5 MHz. Pakistan

The Voice of America (VOA) is expanding its reach across Pakistan. A new arrangement with Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation (PBC) now allows VOA to broadcast Pashto language programs on medium-wave (AM) radio and Urdu broadcasts on FM stations for the first time.

"We're delighted Pakistan's Cabinet has ratified our agreement with PBC," said VOA Director Danforth W. Austin. "This arrangement will allow millions of people in all parts of Pakistan to listen to the VOA's popular news and information programs."

VOA's Deewa Radio, a Pashto language service for people in the Afghanistan-Pakistan border region, is now available on medium wave (AM) at 540 kHz from a transmitter in Peshawar, the capital of Pakistan's North West Frontier Province. From 1800 to 2200 daily, Deewa Radio's AM signal will broadcast news and current affairs programming plus call-in shows on politics, literature and poetry. Deewa, which began in 2006, continues to broadcast nine hours of radio programming daily on shortwave, FM (transmitters located in Afghanistan) and Internet (www.VOANews.com/Deewa/).

For the first time, VOA's Urdu language program Radio Aap Ki Dunyaa (Your World) (www.VOANews.com/Urdu) will be heard on the FM band. A 30-minute morning program at 0900

and a 30-minute evening program at 1800 will air on 11 FM stations across Pakistan, including Islamabad and Lahore. VOA's audience is strong in Pakistan, with almost 12 percent of the population listening to or watching Urdu programs. Beyond the Headlines is a 30-minute television program that airs on Geo News, Pakistan's leading cable and satellite TV news channel. Portugal

783 R. Club, Avanca, is (finally!) expected to be on the air very soon, possibly mid / end Oct'09. This site was made ready back in 2007 (!), and comprises a 100 kW, DRM compatible, THALES tx and a Spanish made 60 m folded monopole. The DRM compatibility just means either tx (see below) would need some extra [expensive] modifications the owner is simply not willing to meet. Also acc. to the stn, the continued break downs of the "twin brother" tx used on 1035 kHz (Belmonte, near Lisbon), lead to an agreement with the manufacturer whereby it will be their own pepole who'll be activating the Avanca unit, which will take place after the THOMSON team checks the Belmonte site.

It is almost obvious that MCR - the group owning RCP as well as other [VHF-FM only] stns like R.Comercial - may not feel that happy with the quality of those Thales (now Thomson) txs which, nevertheless, are simply not expected to be run at full power either; I was told the power level will almost surely be just a bit above the level of the active, albeit irregular, unit for 1035, i.e. something in the 30 kW range in order to step down the electricity bill. (*Carlos Gonçalves via Mediumwave.info*)

Switzerland

I have noticed by a pure coincidence that today Sep 28 a testing signal was hearable on 558Khz, as a continuous beep. I heard it in Switzerland at 10:00 UTC (ground wave, medium power) as well as Swiss evening time at 19:00 UTC. I heard it at home as well as in my car while driving in the Zurich area. The signal direction seems to come from Monte-Ceneri (formerly transmitting on 558Khz), South of Switzerland, close to the Italian border. Is this Monte-Ceneri doing a coverage test for somebody else? The Swiss-Italian broadcast was phased out in summer 2008. (*Philippe Aeby*)

I confirm the presence of 800 Hz test tone on 558 kHz. In all probability the transmitter and aerial the same used before July 1st 2008, at Alpe del Tiglio (Isone) know as MonteCeneri. The signal 25 km from the transmitter is rather strong. This test should be associated to the investigation of the Communication's Federal Bureau upon real interest in the use of Medium Wave. Mike Ahern Former Caroline DJ Dies

Born in Liverpool, he was a barman and a clerk before getting his big break on Radio Caroline, at first joining the station's North ship off the Isle Of Man. He moved to

Caroline's South ship in 1965 to help aid the network's flagging figures.

He departed Caroline in 1967 for Radio One, though it was a short lived affair with Ahern departing for Australia to work for a slew of stations there including 4BC and 6PM.He returned to the UK in 1988 and worked for Essex Radio, Piccadilly Radio and Country-1035 among others. UTV Head Ridicules Switchover

Scott Taunton, head of TalkSport's parent UTV Radio GB, has told the Guardian newspaper that he considers the government's target for planned digital switchover and the removal of the AM and FM frequencies from the radio spectrum by 2015 as "farcical". This comes after UTV quit membership of the RadioCentre trade body earlier this month.

I may be mistaken, but I believe this is a first contribution to DX Loggings by **Valter** and **Chris**, so a warm welcome to you both. I hope to receive many more logs from you in the future!

Unfortunately, I've had to leave out a number of logs on this occasion – the large log this month has taken a long time to compile and edit, and I've had no time left for the very time-consuming task of re-typing electronically submitted logs which aren't in the DX Loggings format, or which have been submitted in manuscript. Also, **Tim Bucknall** has been having some fun listening to Perseus recordings made by Bjarne Mjelde at Kongsfjord using various beverages – unfortunately due to the large DX Log I have no space to include them here either this month.

Now for some feedback from our contributors:

Barry says: "I guess a B I G job this month (compiling the log) hi! I am sending mine today (22 October). This morning's "K" 3s says it all for me. Last month I commented about October being a key DX month. It lived up to its reputation. I can't wait to see the full log and start reminiscing over all the ones I missed but heard elsewhere south of the border. November tends to be a bit quieter but I do need the rest! If anything else comes through overnight I'll send them along unless you tell me not to". Yes, compiling the log has been a big job this month, so my thanks to you and all those contributors who used the pro-forma and used the correct format, which helps enormously! – mah.

John F comments: "I have just taken a look back through my loggings over the last month and cannot believe how many rare C calls are included and how many K calls there are in there too! Although conditions were good throughout most of the period, the period leading up to the 21st of October was impressive. Many personal firsts were heard and the signal levels from several stations usually considered rarities were booming through on a nightly basis! Can it get any better than this? October 2009 may well go down in my books as the best night of MW DX I have ever had".

Paul adds: "Outstanding conditions from around 19-21 October with rare West Coasters like KJR heard along with San Diego 1700 and several stations from North and South Dakota. The first day of the good conditions coincided with the first use of my RPA-1 preamp and I though it had worked miracles until I saw other people's logs!"

Jack: "It's been a good month for DX here. I was particularly pleased to catch 1270 KNWC and 1590 KVGB, giving me two new states. The prairies and west coast openings that made it as far south as the Midlands on the 20th and 21st didn't extend down to Hertfordshire unfortunately. But it's still early days for this season, so I'm hopeful that propagation will keep improving. Am I correct in thinking that my logging of KNWC is a UK First? It doesn't appear in the all-time list you published in 2005 nor, as far as I can see, in any MWN since then. It's not in Ken Baird's all-time list either.

I've recently added a Wellbrook FLG100 preamplifier to my KAZ. This does seem to have improved the front-to-back ratio, though I probably now need to tweak the termination resistor because it was originally adjusted when I was using just a passive matching transformer on the feeder end". Yes, KNWC is indeed a UK First, so congratulations! This should be an inspiration to all our members in the southern counties of the UK – it's not just those of us living in the north that gets the good DX. Indeed, many of the stations reported this month by our contributors in England have yet to be heard in Clashmore! - mah

John W: "With the good conditions have heard a few stations - pleased to hear the MI and IL States. Unusually 1290 CFRW was a frequent visitor. As always probably heard the same number of stations which I could not identify (particularly 1330)!"

Steve notes: "With Germany silent on 1593kHz the absence of continuous DRM noise meant I could get some signals on 1590kHz for the first time in ages, including a nice personal first from Kansas. Oddly this season some stations are notably missing (e.g. CJYQ 930) whilst others missing for years are seemingly common (e.g. CHUM 1050 and CFTR 680)".

Charles tells us: "Just got back to Amersham Bucks after spending a few days in Cornwall. Luckily this co-incided with some good dx from NA. Attached is a log of the stations I identified. I'm pleased to get in particular KMOX, WHO, WFTL & WSCR. I was only using my Sony ICF-SW7600GR with its internal ferrite rod. I also used an Olympus digital voice recorder which I held up to the loudspeaker to record some good IDs for WFTL, WFED, WHO, KMOX, CHUM, CFRB and WSCR".

Guido: "Recently, we made a weekend DX-pedition to Walsoorden in the Netherlands. We had some nice antennas to different parts of the world. Beverages of 200 metres to 40, 300, 350 and one reversible beverage of 300 metres that was 60/240 degrees. Conditions towards the Far East were note as good as last year but I managed to hear HLKN, Mokpo, Korea which was a personal first. TA-conditions were good. I received several first-timers, but from the west coast, I only had a tentative log of CJVB Vancouver. It looks like the following weekend had better conditions. There are also loggings made at home included. And there are even there made a few first timers, like WHO, Des Moines. I'm glad with this one received in a noisy suburb surrounding".

As can be seen from the log, stations from the western coast of North America, prairies and plains have been widely heard throughout the UK. Daytimers were also widely heard at the end of September, and as this is being typed, the final days of October are also providing some good catches of daytimers. I was away from home between 13 and 17 October, so can't provide a complete report on conditions in **Clashmore**.

However, they were particularly good for morning reception from the western half of North America from 5-7 October, and in the period leading up to the blow-out on 21 October. Unfortunately a fault in the 338 degree beverage meant I wasn't able to take full advantage of the fine conditions, with the higher frequencies being badly attenuated. The problem seems to have been cause by damage inside the house to a coaxial cable that runs behind a wall, so possibly due to mice – as an interim measure an alternative feed has been used that seems to have cured the problem.

The **deadline** for the December 2009 DX Loggings is **Monday 23rd November**. I look forward to receiving your logs by then, preferably electronically/via e-mail using the Word pro-forma, which I can supply on request; all contributions should follow the format used in DX Loggings as closely as possible. I'd like to repeat the request made last month, since I'm still receiving logs that don't use the pro-forma, and these take about 80% of the time needed to compile DX Loggings. I will include such logs whenever I can, but if the log becomes very large during the winter months, and I run out of time, I will have to leave them out. Handwritten or typed logs sent to me by snail mail or fax should be restricted to a maximum of 20 logs, since typing them up is also very time consuming. Please ensure that logs are marked "tentative" or "presumed" if you do not hear a positive identification announcement or material that is unique to the station – and please include such announcements in the detail of your log.

Would newer members please note that DX Loggings is a consolidated permanent record summarising of stations heard, also available to those members not subscribed to the e-List; postings to the e-List are intended as hot tips and subject to correction where required. If you would like any tips sent to the e-List to be published in DX Loggings, please send them to me separately. All logs of stations transmitting from outside Europe are welcome. In common with the other sections of MWN, DX Loggings aims to include as many members as possible, and I'd like to ask those of you who listen to MW DX, but who haven't yet shared your catches, to make a special effort and send me a contribution for the next issue. Good DX!






