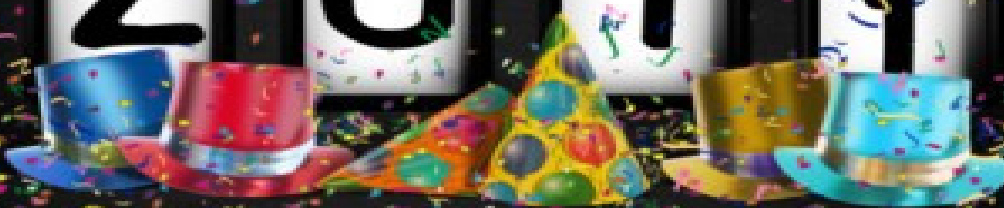

Radio 4 airs interview with 'fake' MP

BBC Radio 4, which faced embarrassment in December over presenter's Jim Naughtie's "Jeremy Hunt" slip up, committed another faux pas by interviewing a fake MP.

Presenter James Robbins interviewed Mike Crockart, who claimed to be a Liberal Democrat MP, on World at One programme. Crockart, who said in the show that he would be prepared to resign over the increase in tuition fees, turned out to be an impostor. He was identified as the parliamentary private secretary to Scottish secretary Michael Moore

The BBC said that the phone number in the corporation's directory of MPs' contact details corresponding to the Liberal Democrat MP for Edinburgh West was incorrect. The corporation added that Crockart sounded credible during its "usual pre-broadcast questions" over the phone.

A BBC spokeswoman said that the station realised the error and took immediate steps to rectify it and to ensure that it was not repeated. Monday's London Evening Standard and the Press Association picked up quotes from Crockart's interview and later issued a correction saying that the quotes attributed to the MP were from an impersonator. *New Statesman: 07 December 2010*

The Two Bobs Return

For 24 years, Bob Thomann (HB9GX) and Bob Zanotti (HB9ASQ) shared a microphone and became an international broadcasting icon, winning awards for their popularity and the consistently large audience share of their show, The Swiss Shortwave Merry-Go-Round.

"The Two Bobs", as they came to be known, were both radio hams, so they had firsthand knowledge and experience of the technical problems inherent in shortwave – also called High Frequency or "HF" – transmission. It's logical, then, that their mainstay was providing off-the-cuff answers to listeners' technical questions about radio and how to improve reception.

But The Two Bobs were also philosophers, and had strong personal feelings about the major political and policy issues that faced HF broadcasting, and what they believed was the shortsightedness of curtailing shortwave services in the post Cold War era. The Two Bobs were

sometimes even controversial, especially when it came to their outspokenness in getting shortwave listeners to pay more attention to “program content” – the term they coined to discourage the perception of HF broadcasting as merely a technical hobby.

The Swiss Shortwave Merry-Go-Round ended in June 1994, despite heavy listener protest. Over the years, Bob Thomann and Bob Zanotti have remained good friends, and still get together, both on ham radio and in person to “chew the rag”, as hams say, and continue to discuss the medium they loved and promoted so much.

The Two Bobs left their mark on international broadcasting and became a household word among millions of shortwave listeners around the world. After a 10-year absence, they’re back in this hour-long special. Also see: <http://www.switzerlandinsound.com/audiotext32/2bobs.mp3>

Online Sound Archive

The UK's commercial radio history has been brought to life in the form of online sound archives which will enable lecturers, researchers and students to gain an insight into key moments throughout British and international history.

The LBC / Independent Radio News (IRI) Archive has been created by the Centre for Broadcasting History, based at Bournemouth University, which has spent the last three years digitising 4,000 hours of material from 1973 to the mid-1990s.

Among the 5,400 searchable recordings are a number of historic events, such as the live reporting of five general elections, the Falklands war, the miners' strike and the turbulent period of government under former Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher.

"This is the most important commercial radio archive in the UK and provides a unique audio history of the period," commented Professor Sean Street, Project Director of the University's Centre for Broadcasting History. The revolutionary archive also holds invaluable historical worth on an international scale, as it includes significant material relating to the end of apartheid in South Africa in 1994.

Paola Marchionni, JISC Digitisation Programme Manager, predicted the newly adapted material would be "relevant to the study of society, history, politics and popular culture." The archive will lend a strong hand to the study of the history of broadcasting, bringing to life the beginnings of commercial broadcasting, which was founded when IRN and the LBC were granted their licences in October 1973.

Importantly, the Archive will encompass material from a time before the Broadcasting Act of 1990, which is vital to the study of the history of British broadcasting. "The change in commercial radio since this period is extraordinary," recalled Professor Street.

"It is impossible for the young students of radio, born since this time, to imagine that such independently funded radio could have existed. "As a result, it is vitally important that these programmes are preserved as part of the evolving history of post-war British broadcasting."

Hello again.

Here is what's been happening on the North American AM dial. May I express my gratitude to the organisations which make this summary possible? Thanks this month to: - IRCA, ABDX, NRC DX News, FCC, CRTC, DXLD, DX Mid-America.

December was quite a quiet month with most of the significant changes affecting Canadian stations.



- 600 WBOB** Jacksonville FL; The WBOB callsign has re-emerged on 640 (used to be on 1320). WBOB was on 1360, then 1160, then 1320 until March 2010, and now it has appeared on 600kHz where it used to be WBWL
- 610/ CHNC/**
1150 CHGM New Carlisle / Gaspé; These simulcasting French language stations left the medium waveband at for 107.1/99.3FM respectively.
- 1000 KTOK** Oklahoma City; a power increase to 5.8kW day/night from 5kW, but with lobes remaining the same at 350° and 135°. With these directions the increase power means that it is still unlikely to be heard in Europe, but who knows?
- 1550 CBE** Windsor, ON; FM simulcasting has begun indicating that 1550 is likely to go silent by March 2011.
- 1570 CJEU** Gatineau, QC; The station has adopted the moniker of "Oxygène Radio", but by all accounts continues to use its Radio Enfant and enfant-ado identities.
- 1570 WNSH** Beverly, MA; Format change from talk to Spanish tropical, re-broadcasting 800 WNNW.

Hello mediumwave friends,

Winter is hitting Europe. Last weekend there was no public transport here in most parts of the Netherlands. I had the choice to sleep in the office at Schiphol where I am working or to walk home to Haarlem, which is 17 km's away from Schiphol. I choose the last solution....

Afghanistan

Afghan Air Force delivers radios to Balkh province. Members of the Afghan Air Force, Afghan National Army and NATO Air Training Command-Afghanistan advisors distributed solar powered, hand-cranked radios, provided by Radio Azadi, to the surrounding villages of Meymaneh, in Balkh province yesterday. The villagers are without TV or radio contact with the rest of Afghanistan. Bringing the news to these villages will provide the local populace with the efforts their government and coalition is providing them.

Lt. Col. Nhat-Thomas D Tran, NATO Air Training Command-Afghanistan/438th Air Expeditionary Advisory Group Deputy Commander and ANA Gen. Weza worked together to set up the mission to Meymaneh. Col. Tran said that Gen. Weza's demeanour was very positive throughout their time together, which lead to a successful mission. Col. Tran is scheduling for the remaining 1,000 Radio Azadi radios to be delivered within the next two weeks with support of AAF, ANA, and NATC-A personnel. He is planning to distribute more radios to Feyzabad, Fakhar, Taloqan and the surrounding area in the near future.>

Radio Azadi provides broadcasts 12 hours a day in both Pashtun and Dari, with distribution being on FM, AM and the internet. More than 7.9 million Afghans listen to Radio Azadi weekly. The purpose of the radio distribution is to help the Afghan population, especially in rural and isolated > villages, become more informed. Another objective is to show Afghan citizens that the Afghan authorities and the international community care about their welfare. (*438th Air Expeditionary Wing via Medianetwork*)

Azores

I have just received my copy of the WRTH 2011, and unfortunately found some incorrect items: RDP Antena 1 Açores, Pico da Barrosa 837 10 kW, São Miguel island, is no more. The file with the RDP stns I have recently received from www.rtp.pt is the same RTP sends to the WRTH, and I'm sure the latter forwarded it to the Country Contributor, and 837 is no longer listed there. I take it WRTH Country Contributors should perhaps keep in touch with their colleagues handling the MW sections so as to avoid such discrepancies.

History: One of the reasons why this outlet was terminated is the collapse of the tower during a storm.

Commercial Stations: R. Club de Angra (909 kHz, inactive, tower collapsed years ago) and Estação Emissora do Club Asas do Atlântico (1566 kHz, inactive) are being listed separately instead of appearing under the "Other Stations" (VHF-FM only) list, but those two fqs are omitted. The fact is that they're both licenced MW stns that are simply not active [on MW] for certain reasons, but both remain active on VHF-FM. It is up to www.erc.pt ultimately to decide towards the removal of their MW licences, but then again this hasn't happened so far. On the other hand, ERC is usually swift in doing so regarding VHF-FM licences.

History: As a matter of fact, RCA 909 vanished when their monopole collapsed a number of years ago, and increasing competition from the VHF-FM-only local stns and revenue decrease paved the way for halting MW operation, and it is almost they will remain silent on MW for the years to come. 1566 is silent not due to technical reasons, but for the same financial motive that caused RCA to suspend MW.

Military Stations: Rádio Lajes - Voz da FAP. No mention of the [continuously postponed] planned reactivation on MW 1530[formerly thought was 1584] (ex-648), no VHF-FM [93.5 MHz 150 watt] fq listed, stn director's name [currently, Lt.Colonel Carlos Mendes] also omitted. As a matter of fact, Lt.Col. Carlos Mendes' name should have been mentioned in the WRTH 2009 & 2010 editions. (*Carlos Goncalves via Mediumwave.info*)

Burma/Myanmar

Amnesty International is sending radios into Burma. This video shows them being distributed by activists carrying them on foot through a war zone to impoverished rural communities in Eastern Burma. The radios shown on the video are Chinese made Tecsun R 808's covering medium wave, FM and shortwave. The organisations distribute different makes of radios to communities to avoid possible detection of beneficiaries by the the military. The radios give access to information from broadcasts by the BBC, VOA, Radio Free Asia and the Democratic Voice of Burma.

On November 13, the day of the release of opposition leader Aung San Suu Kyi, who spent up to six hours a day listening to shortwave during the long years of her detention, Amnesty launched a new appeal with a target of 10,000 more radios. <http://vimeo.com/16762206> . Germany

Sudwestrundfunk will be closing all mediumwave transmitters by the end of next year.

Greenland

On February 11 2011 at 8 AM local time all medium wave stations carrying KNR (Radio Greenland) - Upernavik (810 kHz), Uummannaq (900 kHz), Qeqertarsuaq (650 kHz), Nuuk (570 kHz) og Simiutaq (720 kHz) - will be switched off for good, and the transmitters will be dismantled. On the same day the relays of KNR newscasts twice daily via Tasiilaq 3815 kHz will also cease. The decision has been taken by the Ministry of Housing, Infrastructure and Transport in the Government of Greenland.

After February 11 2011 KNR will only be available via Low Power FM-radio in inhabited areas of Greenland. Thus no coverage of the waste country outside the towns and villages - and KNR will no longer be available for the fishermen at sea nor the Inuit population in Canada. The decision was made because the transmitters were getting old and too costly to maintain. Besides - very few people are using the MW transmissions.

Weather forecasts will be available for fishermen and others via VHF coastal radio.

At a point it was considered replacing the aging MW transmitters with one or two new SW AM-transmitters near Nuuk, but it was estimated that it would cost 4 million DKK (535.000 euro) to establish such a new SW operation. It was also felt that few listeners would invest in a SW receiver and the quality would be 'doubtful' - suffering from 'atmospheric phenomena'. So these plans were given up. Jamming

Several solutions were dropped in various for the jammer like noise on 1377 kHz. Here is a comment from Germany:

That's REAL JAMMING BY IRANIAN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY AGAINST CHRISTIAN PROGRAM BROADCAST OF TWR EUROPE from Vienna, Austria. According to their B-10 winter schedule TWR rents Armenian MW powerhouse Gavar mediumwave on 1377 kHz between 1800 and 2107 UT, in Arabic, Persian, Iraqi Arabic, Assyrian, Qashqai, and Uzbek language.

The Armenian engineers at Gavar site are much clever too, that oscillating signals of a faulty MW tx would not to outlast a single hour ... so stated at 99%, that oscillating signal is an Iranian jammer action against Trans World Radio broadcast, against language broadcast, spoken in that Middle East area. Two MW directional antennas erected on Gavar Armenia bc center during USSR era:

1377 kHz. MW Srednyaya Zarya antenna, 26 masts 2.2 km long at 180 degrees, towards Iran, Iraq, and Kuwait target. 40 24 54.62 N 45 12 40.12 E

1350 kHz. MW SV4+4 - 8mast directional, 232degr towards Israel, at 232 degrees. 40 24 07.65 N 45 11 54.26 E. (Wolfgang Bueschel via BC-DX TopNews)

Luxembourg

Other than the DRM Signal on 1440, I have Recently noticed RTL Radio on 1440 MW starts an hour earlier than before (17.00 hrs CET instead of 18.00 hrs). I remember some years before listening to RTL radio in the winter daytime. I would like if Radio Netherlands could be put on 1440 as a change, instead of China Radio Int. (*Adam Birchenall via Mediumwave.info*)

Madeira

PEF Funchal 1530 kHz is no longer 10 kW, but 1 kW.

History: Increasing QRM on nearby homes, postponed repair of their 10 kW tx which will move to Poiso, Chão dos Balcões, when ready.

PEF Santana 1017 kHz 1 kW was terminated back in July'10.

History: The Santana fq was dropped, this tx will be the backup unit at the new site at Poiso (see above). (*Carlos Goncalves via Mediumwave.info*)

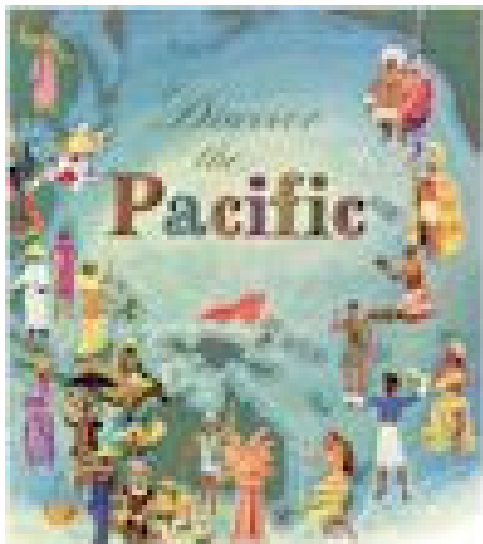
More news just before Christmas: I finally managed to find someone at PEF who was able to provide more information and correct some earlier data which is isn't entirely accurate, viz.: The 1530 kHz outlet, from the Encruzilhadas site (32° 40' 19.63" N 16° 56' 53.96" W, check http://www.mwlist.org/mwlist_quick_and_easy.php?area=1&kHz=1530 - the data I provided has already been inserted in this page, St.º António, a parish that belongs to the Funchal municipality, is using not just 1 kW but 2 kW as I had been informed. The old antenna consists of a simple monopole which has seen better days, and no more refurbishing will be carried out until the new site is inaugurated... unless perhaps conditions urgently demand it and PEF wants to keep MW running. As soon as the final preparations at the new 1530 kHz site of Poise are ready, the rather old 10 kW GATES tx will then most certainly be kept at just half its power level due to costs.

In terms of use, the Poiso site is brand new, it never worked except for some brief antenna tests using the defunct Santana 1017 kHz 1 kW tx silenced back in early July last, but works actually started some 6-7 years ago (!) after the Funchal municipality granted the station the use of the land for a stipulated period of time. The antenna was erected, say, some 4 years ago or more, and consists of a 50 Ohm fed, folded monopole like the one used by Antena 1 Madeira at Pico das Eiras (defunct) 531 kHz 10 kW, Porto Santo island. In terms of MW, Poiso is bad, and so is neighbouring Pico do Areeiro 603 kHz 10 kW (Antena 1 Madeira) for they're both too high for covering a region which is at a lower level. That may be good for VHF-FM while certainly not for MW. On top of that, it seems certain places, particularly on high ground, have been stormed by extremely strong winds, occasional floods, and snow also plagues those areas. In the case of Poiso, access is carried out by 4x4, not normal vehicles.

Funchal in particular, where most of the population live, but also the southern coast of Madeira is best served by MW antennae that are located at a lower latitude, like the old PEF site and the Antena 1 Madeira 1332 kHz 1 kW (Sr.ª do Monte), and also where the defunct Estação Rádio da Madeira 1485 kHz 1 kW was installed.

To conclude this, a final word on PEF Santana 1017. It seems after all, that this unlisted fq, I mean absent in official lists like the one at www.anacom.pt, was experimental during its entire life, with ANACOM's blessing of course. The antenna used there till early this past Summer consisted of a T or inv. L type so I was also told, so pretty much like ordinary NDB rigs. It was nevertheless putting a fair signal in the continent during daytime despite QRM from Spanish stations on adjacent channels; during the evening, one ought better forget about trying to get their signal. Well, I hope to be able to visit all that some day. (*Carlos Goncalves via Steve Whitt*)

Switzerland

Sottens 765 kHz will finally shut down transmission by Dec 31, 2010, midnight Central European Time. The loop will last till then. I have recorded the Dec 5 farewell party with my camcorder on my venerable Panasonic DR28 and am planning to upload it on Youtube someday between Xmas and New Year. The station should not be dismantled, at least as far I understood from the last 4 hours of broadcast on MW. It is likely to be classified as Swiss national patrimony, similarly to the late Beromünster MW transmitter (formerly on 531 Khz, shut down in Dec 2008). (Philippe)

BBC Radio News

BBC working on '3D radio'

16 December, 2010

The BBC is working on a radio that can give the impression of a total immersion in sound. The BBC Corporation is “investigating the potential” of sound systems called ambisonics and periphony, which use speakers in front, behind and above the listener and give the impression of a total immersion in sound.

At a demonstration, the BBC used eight speakers to show what could be done, and played atmospheric clips of aeroplanes taking off at the Duxford Air Show, choral performances and radio drama, The Daily Telegraph reports.

Although any mainstream testing of a service on a wider scale would be years away, internet broadcasts could allow listeners with the right equipment to hear 3D transmissions relatively easily. Few people will have enough speakers in their living rooms, but the technology could have potential for in-car audio where speakers are positioned around the interior of a vehicle.

Commercial Radio News

Radio Maldwyn set to close?

14 December, 2010

Shareholders of **Radio Maldwyn** have approved to wind up the company and to appoint liquidators at an extraordinary general meeting. The meeting, which took place on Monday at Newtown's Regent Centre, heard a number of companies and a community group have declared an interest in buying the station. The BBC reports that the station's presenters stopped broadcasting last month and back-to-back music has been aired ever since.



UPDATE 27 DECEMBER: **Radio Hafren**, the station that has filled the void left by the liquidation of Radio Maldwyn, officially went on air on Christmas Day. Its new owners have been quick to reassure the community that they mean business by reconnecting the transmission and have already got presenters on air during certain times of the day.

“It was important that we got something on air as soon as it was confirmed we had taken over the station,” said Tom Pain who is one of the new partners. “It has been a challenge because there has been so much to sort out, not made easy by the Christmas holidays, but at least we have it back on air 24 hours a day and we hope to be somewhere close to a normal service as early as next week.”

The station has also reconnected a number – 01686 623555 – which will direct callers through to a presenter, office staff or an answering service.

Radio Maldwyn went out of business earlier this month after 17 years covering Mid Wales. The area looked set to lose the service until the last ditch bid from the local group to save it. Radio Hafren will continue to broadcast on the 756kHz MW frequency.(*via Dave Porter*)

However it has been denied an opportunity to secure a MW frequency so that listeners can enjoy the station in transit, rather than via the internet or through Sky TV.

John kicks off with some comments about propagation: “On the occasions I have listened, conditions have been disappointing, but did manage to hear 2 Chicago stations on 18 December”. **Max** had a similar view: “Nothing special this month. Only a few days with above average conditions”.

Doing a little better was **Steve**, who writes: “December 7th was a good DX day with strong signals but it was very difficult to get many IDs. After 0800 UTC Coast to Coast AM audible on many channels: e.g. 1150, 930, 1180, 1100, 1390, 1200 kHz. But DX faded out around 0900. I clearly could not take advantage of the conditions that Martin experienced. Sadly only a few signals from West of the Mississippi and no west coast North America.

Anyone know for sure if Spanish has been dropped by WWZN?” – *the latest report we have of SS from WWZN is Rha’s log on 29th November – mah.*

Barry adds: “Less common stuff coming through after Christmas south of the border but no West coast yet. May be early January will have some surprises for us hi!”

Paul experienced some better reception: “Conditions have been up and down - best around 7-12 December with an opening at 1100 UTC on the 7th. Now and again some of the Prairie stations have been making it through but with no great consistency. KSL and KLO have been heard a few times and CFRW seems to be much more regular since it switched to ESPN (perhaps it's easier to ID it now)”

Here in **Clashmore** some excellent conditions were also experienced from 7-12 December, with the 7th being one of the best days ever. Propagation on that day brought some amazing catches of Californian stations from 1000-1200 UTC, Alaskans and Japanese stations around 1300, and Hawaiians from 1300-1400. Wow! I’m still analysing the Perseus recordings for this period. This month I’ve not reported many of the “more common” mid-west, prairies, and west coast stations, nor any common east coasts stations, heard in Clashmore.

The **deadline** for the February DX Loggings is **Tuesday 25th January**. I look forward to receiving your logs by then, preferably electronically/via e-mail using the Word pro-forma, which is available from the “Files” section of our Yahoo Group; **very many thanks** to all those members making the effort to submit contributions following the format used in DX Loggings.
