YV5RI-CARACAS VEN advise Jack Quintrell they DXed on Sept 29th-9ct 12 & 26 and Nov 1 and will again on Nov 15-29th and every second Saturday there after. We had wrong dates on this previously. Perhaps this will enable us all to hear YV5RI. (Quintrell)

KWIL-ALBANY ORE will present a DX program for the N R C on Nov 9th from 3-5:30 AM EST. Paul Spargo, C.E. (W7CMK) called Jack Quintrell by phone and notified him of this program. Information was received too late to relay it to our members but we hope some of you heard the program. They will again DX on Saturday Dec 13 from 3-5:30 AM but we suggest that you tune in before 4 AM because this will be during FCC checks and Pacific stations are permitted to operate until 4 AM only. We are not certain that KWIL might have overlooked this when arranging this program, but listen in anyhow. (Quintrell)

Tenative programs are being arranged with numerous other stations. Booker writes that KOAC will DX for us later and that's good news. KSWO tell Ernie Cooper they will DX when grant for unlimited time is given. Joe Brauner is attempting to arrange another program from KEVR, the one on Nov 1 being washed out due to poor conditions. Eldon Addy has a program or two coming up later in the year. Bob Brown tells us that KTBI is planning a DX program, details to be released soon. Numerous members and other clubs are inquiring about the WAGE program of Oct 4. I wish to advise all that WAGE cancelled this because of shortage of help.

KCS CALL REMARKS

11740 Cuban network station reported here, believed to be COCY, which is reported as being on 11735 by Wedewer. Reported here by (Mann)
