(NOV 14 1:00 to 1:15 AM EASTERN WAR TIME) This will be a weekly program which may be extended to a half hour later if the response warrants it. we are going to use on the first program a script submitted by Mr Ernest R Cooper of 438 East 21st St., Brooklyn N.Y. with whom I have been corresponding regarding this for some little time.

The phenomenal coverage reports we have had on our 1540 frequency with 50,000 watts of power since we went on the air July 14 have kept us constantly amazed. It would seem to me that our frequency is perhaps the most ideal frequency on the dial for DXers. HERB CAMPBELL-ATHENS PA WNBH was logged on regular xmission. Verie was on hand 72 hours later, in form of a friendly letter, very correctly verifying the same. Address is 588 Pleasant St., New Bedford, Mass and the signer was Chief Engineer, Irving Vermilya. Always pleased to mention such satisfactory relations especially as it is always seemed to me that WNBH is a station which is little heard of in DX circles. (Very glad to have heard from you Herb. The house and examination have kinda kept me busy the past couple months, but getting back to normal-Ray)

ED WYMAN-HORWELL N Y well heres a report after a couple weeks absent. Not much being heard because of the worst static than there has been all summer. I got enough for a report on CKNB and that was about all. KROS came in swell, I dont think WMAN was on, I listened the whole hour but never heard a squeel. (No I guess not Ed as they didnt come on until NOV 1st-evidently the date got mixed-Ray) Since last report I received letter veries from WCGS-WRNL-WEAN-WCMI-KTTS-KSL-KGVO and cards from CKNB-WQBC-WCCO. Reports went out to WCAE on 17th; 10/19-WJHL; 10/21 CKNB. 10/26 KGNC on test; 10/27 KH<sub>4</sub>, they were putting in a swell signal although KFI wasnt heard. 10/30 KROS, missed WHAZ because I forgot about them until too late. I did get WTRY. TO-TED BAMBERGER-KMO is signed by J.D. Kolesor and verie dates Feb 4 1942, received it in about a week.

BOB BOTZOW-1132 North 11th St-Reading Penn. Reception conditions here at my new QRA are poor, no doubt due to our Electric Stoker going on and off and causing QR<sub>M</sub>. Havent had time to install my antenna and have been using a 20 ft copper wire just thrown out my window for the aerial. At that I managed to log and verify WAYS back of WIP on 610 kcs. They sign on at 6:30 AM and broadcast a musical program to 6:55AM followed by late news etc. Verie signed by W.L. Smith Jr. Asst General Manager and their QRA is City Industrial Bank Bldg., Charlotte, North Carolina. Also heard WPD<sub>4</sub> on 1270 kcs for a new one on Oct 31st 5:50 to 7:15 PM with an excellent signal. They announce they use 5kw day and night. Strange thing was that WABC and WFAF were much weaker than WPD<sub>4</sub> during that time. I finally received letter veries from WJWC-WSNY. The QRA of WSNY is the Plaza Theater Bldg-Schenectady, N.Y. and signed by Irving P. Beck, c.e. I cant hear KXEL because my dial just runs to 1530 kc and WCKY puts in a strong signal here and just cant reach further up than 1530 while WCKY is on the air. Am enjoying my new home a lot.

JOE BECKER-HAMILTON O well I finally heard WPD<sub>4</sub> on Sunday Am 4-4:30. I tired for WMAN for 3/4 hour but nothing hrd. Will try for WTRY in the morn ing. Wrote KTTS about exact date but no answer as yet. On the WTRY program KFWD messed them up here. Another son of mine leaves for the Army on the 3rd. Joe Jr is still doing fine and we hear from him regularly but dont know where he is. Meet George Jacobs Sunday and he took me up in a plane. What a thrill, first time up for me. (Good Boy Joe) (OK \$2)

LEN KRUSE-DOBUDQUE IA On Oct 28th I logged CJRM as a new one for me, it was signing off at 2AM. when I was waiting the special from KROS. I fell asleep and slept through and awoke 20 minutes after completion of the program, was I mad at myself (shame on you Len) Tried for special from WMAN on 10/31 but no go, were they on? (Not on 31st Len but they came on the 1st of Nov. evidently the c e was figuring the night of Oct 31st and never thought that would be Nov 1st instead.) I sent thank you cards to both of them though. Received a swell verie letter from WCBS.

TED BAMBERGER-SHAKER HGTS O Despite a lot of static around here I've gotten reports to WSYB and WLAP on tests, WCAW-KFI-WTOC-KLYL-WMAN. WMAN heard on 11/1 special. KROS not good enough for a report here, too much static and WEXL. Veries during the last week are WAGA-KFRE-KLRA-KRRV-WFMJ-WHBL. I bet a lot of fellows missed WMAN account of the dates. WHbK and KLRA with EKKO stamps. (Guess they did miss WMAN-Ray)

If any member needs VK he is as easy to get as KFI on Sunday mornings 1:30-7:15 AM EWT. WHAZ and WTRY put on nice NRC DX. Both 4 R8 here, sent them reports tho have both already verified. On election board today and those TROY DX's sure made me sleepy when counting out. (Dave what is meant by VK.?)

STANWOOD R MORSS-AMHERST MASS had fairly good luck this week, veries in from WPAT-CBJ-CKNB on NRC special- Reports out to KWK-WIOD-WKST-WMBD-WAGA-WTMA-WCSC-WKWK. All heard on their regular schedules around 7 AM. WORD an R9 here for about 5 minutes after s-on then another station comes on and blots them out.

TOM MORRISON-CLEVELAND O Here I am with the seasons first report. No veries lately except VLG-2 a SW verie. Have been using my little Firestone recently with very satisfactory results. Logged KVOD for first time on 10/15 from 7:35-7:45AM with R7-8 signals over WwVA. WPRR heard at 9PM on 10/29 with volume only slightly lower than WNOX, couldnt report them as the 2 messed each other up. WRUF with very good signals 9:15-9:45 PM 10/17 broadcasting Florida-Villanova football game. ZNS hrd 10/31 R5 from 9:50-10:02 PM when they sign off. They were broadcasting dance music. XEB R9 at 9:30 PM every evening. CmBL signs at 12:10 AM in the clear. Thought I had CmCJ last night 10/31 but after 15 minutes of copying it turned out to be XEAW in Spanish. CmK R6 at 9PM over WCCO. WBAL R9 at 2AM on 11/1/ KOA signs on at 7:30 AM in the clear. DX quite good from 6:45-7:30AM here. KMA usually R7 over WDBJ at 7:30AM. XEMC logged on 11/1 at 2:10AM. XEW very good all evening. WBYN logged sign-off at 2AM. Sigs as good as WIRE. WMBD hrd 1:30-1:48 AM with football game. WBBF hrd under WXYZ at 9PM. KLRA booming in at 11PM on 1010 kcs. See that WJW still on 1240; QRA of XEG is Radio Station XEG-Suite 609-moore Bldg-Broadway & Houston Sts-San Antonio Texas. (Tom the only trouble the boys are having is trying to find what freq they are on now that XEAW is on 1050-Ray) Latest reports to KXEL-K30-KYW-KVOO-WKST-ZNS-WRUF-WWSW (If you know the freq send it along-Ray)

JIM WEDGWER-DYKERSVILLE IA DX not too good lately due to weather conditions. missed out on wMAN special by oversleeping and hrd KROS special well as its only 50 miles from here, I doubt if it were heard in the East latest veries being a peachy yellow and green card WHO which is really fb and a folder. KDKA followed by a nice letter and nice card KALB and airmail letter with booklet WJLB and letter and 2 verie stamps and book let KFI and KECA cards CBO-KWOC after 2 rpts and letters WHN-WTAD-WAGA XETT some being in after 3 rpts. Latest catches are KFKU daytime and KOVO at 1:30AM on 10/28 and WGIL daytime on 29th. CBO hrd at 11:33PM on s-off good sigs. KLCN often hrd but too weak to copy good-s-off at 7PM. Biggest surprise of my DX career was on Nov 1st to hear CBK R8 at noon (sun time) and others like CHAB-KUSD-KOA-CBL-KmmJ-KDKA-WNOX-CKY at same time-this is amazing as CbK is at least 1700 miles or more from here. They were hrd almost all afternoon and in the evening they were weaker. Latest reports are out to KADA test 11/2-1:30AM; KFOR 1AM and to KRGV-WDOI WDD-KROS-WHAZ-WTRY. WHAZ hrd R8 at times with QRM-static, poor conditions, about 1/4 of program hrd. KFAC bad QRM and another testing its carrier best here 1:10-1:20AM. 3-4 hrd WTRY R2-3 at times, poor beyond expectations. KFWS on R9plus with political rally. why this AM of all times. heard very little of WTRY. Received a card very from XET.

PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN NY Not much time to DX but spend my spare time at it. New veries from WFCI-WGBG and reports to WBYN-XEM-XEAD-WFNC. Verie log now 1241; wMAN had their DX on Nov 1st instead of Oct 31st. They had a nice program for us. Still working long hours for the Navy.

Dahlbach c.e. 10/28 KPOW was frisked out from behind WITH and while listening WBOC checked in with a very brief test at 4:22 AM. Even with WBOC and WITH on I could still hear KPOW. 10/29 WTTM in late afternoon, weak due to directional antenna to protect WJAR, Brooklyn just between Trenton and Providence. 10/30 KROS nicely over WEAL, listened only until 2:40AM as I had to take my Army physical that AM which incidently I flunked and was rejected. 10/31 WMAN didnt show up ?? (They did on Nov 1st though) 11/3 WHAZ R9 but noisy on comedy DX program very cleverly done. I hope you all heard them. KWON R7 on monthly check 2:30-3AM over WMBR most of the time. WLVA check 3-3:15 a poor R6. WTRY had a really swell DX program for us, again with comedy the main feature. Both Troy stations really out did them-selves and they certainly gave us and our future programs plenty of good publicity. They were swell.

J WARREN ROUTZAHN-YORK PENN Not much time to DX since last report, only logged WAGA-WTRY. Veries in from WNBW-WQXR-KBSF.
