FULTON B CREECH JR E ST LOUIS ILL I am a new member of the NRC and I hail from Sumter, S.C. Am 17 years old and am just starting in on logging and verifying. I wish to thank you for all the info sent. I am sur it will help me in getting started. I started using a 7 tube RCA superhet but had a chance to get hold of a 7 tube Doerle regenerative and did so. It has been working OK so far but it is not quite as selective as I would like it. I expect to remedy that as soon as possible. It would work swell in any other section than where I am. I am situated about 3 miles from E St Louis and about 5 miles from St Louis. In other workd St Louis is just across the river from me. St Louis has 7 stations and E St Louis 1. so you see why my set isnt very selevtime. I would appreciate any dope about how I can improve this situation. I am using a 30 ft inverted "L" antenna running E-W with leadin off E end. It is located atop the dormitory which is about 50 ft high. I have received veries from KOA-WGN and have written to WSB-WJR and WBAP. I listened in to hear WFIG my home town on their freq check but had too much interference from alnighters. I hrd them s-on but they faded out and I couldn't pick them up again. I am taking an Aviation Operations course here and am busy studying pretty late so most of my veries will come from Night Owling.
