October 2 1943

Little DX here, tho weather good & I have been setting the alarm and turning it off, forgetting what I set it for. (Thats bad Don) Tried for WCBI and slept thru WJBO and did report to WGIL. Cheated on Lookout (AWS) yesterday morn and listened to car radio but nothing that was unusual. Copied WKPA this AM 9/26 on the barn set, conditions seemed very fine but had to do chores or might have done more. Thought I would write this last night but the feet hurt but went to a local shid-dig.

FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N.Y. Was up for the special from WJBO in Baton Rouge, but they were apparently on from 2:10 to 3:10 instead of from 3:10 to 4:10 as I had copied from the bulletin. (No Fred there was a mistake in the bulletin as it said from 3:10 to 3:10. It should have been from 3:00 to 3:10 AM only 10 minutes-Ray) So I only got the last three minutes. Also heard the same morning were WQAM on a regular program, WJPF filtering thru WEKL also on test, and WTJS, Jackson testing at 3:17 with band music. Only other time I was up was for WGIL program, and although I reported the entire 20 minutes, I failed to hear the National Radio Club mentioned once. So far this is all of my DXing.
