I got KSJB on the 12th in fine shape. Couldnt hear KGCU. On WRBL I could just barely hear several of their announcements. Dont know what was wrong as they should have come in good. Other reports out on the 12th were to-WPAY-KTOK-WGGA-KLUF-WMER. On the 12th I also heard WJMC as they signed off and KELD at their s-off. Only verie received lately is one from WPAY, just received. None yet from 1st WJBO special.

FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N.Y. Up 10/11 but did myself no good; WMBO testing at 4:15; XEJP about R-3 at 4:20; WWVA s-on at 4:30; WJJD at 5 & WHIS also at 5 and KABR testing at 5:08 but too much QRM to get a report. Did report WBYN on day sked. 10/12 for grand program from WRBL, best I've heard in long time, no sign of KSJB or KGCU. (No WKPA either) Reported WLVA over riding WRBL 3:30-4; WPAY tested (thought) they were supposed to have changed call to WAVB. Plenty of good music-pep and respect for the clun. Speaking of WLVA, remember they QRM'ed WCBT'S DX last year? Has anyone heard from them? As I am writing this I am tuned to WWVW's MDT Jamboree, those of you who have not heard this should tune in, it is really swell, they send a picture of the family for 25¢. A few days ago as I was DXing about 6:00 AM when most of the stations began their operations for the day I shifted the dial from one end to the other to see if I couldnt catch a new station but about all I could hear was the Star Spangled Banner and now and then America as the stations came on. I like that idea, I think it is great but from one end to the other I only found 1 station that said the Lords Prayer. A broadcasting station is similar to a school, one would never start school without the Lords Prayer, why then a broadcasting station. I am writing this letter asking the CPCers to help me try to put this thru, either by asking the stations themselves or to the FCC. The Star Spangled Banner first or America, then the Lords Prayer at the sign on and the sign off. 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TIPS and Lpo reports

October 23 1943

JOE LIPPINCOTT-CELO NO CAROLINA I had an 8 day vacation not far from here and did quite a bit of listening. I had expected to listen more at night but confined my listening to such times as 6-10 AM and from 8-9 or 10 in the evening. Only verie for contest, so far is WJBO hrd last month. I decided that since there is not much chance of getting veries outside the country and further since I have verified about all of the easier to hear distant US stations I might as well try for some of the nearby stations. There are plenty of these that I ought to be able to verify this year. Most of these will be 500 miles or less distant and of course did not count in the contest last year. Stations heard for the 1st time here include WRRF hrd at s-on 8AM and WEGO hrd about noon. I might add that I used my 12 tube 1938 export model G.E. for most of the listening. Antenna used was about 100 feet of solid copper wire spread out just above the ground and pointing to the west. The oddest thing about the listening I did with this set up is that I could hardly hear a NY station at all. Even Chicago was hard to hear. I think some of the Cubans have shifted freq. I have hrd about 20 of them this fall. Some came in with very fine sigs and were 100% loggable but I did not get reports on them all. I have lost interest in sending reports to Cubans as I almost never seem to get a verie. I do not know if this is due to lack of cooperation on the part of the stations or the sensor but I suspect the latter. So I listen to the classical music as they carry it more than our US stations. Since I do not like jazz or cowboy or mountain music I often cant get titles of tunes used on DX or other programs. I got nice reports on some Cubans with music I knew and I may see about sending some reports in spite of conditions. Relative to Cubans I am never ~~quite~~ quite sure of calls since some stations ar on networks and announce only the key station.

STAN MORSS-BRADFORD MASS Here is my first report of the season. Station announcing as XEQR-XERQ Radio Continental on 790 R9 every morning until s-off at 3:20 AM. XEQR is listed as being on 1030 kc. What is the info on this? I sent them a report but havent a reply as yet. WRBL R9 to R4 by 3:30 when WLVA came on and drowned em out. WRAL testing R6 on Oct 12 hrd from 3-3:10AM. WJBO R4-6 on special 10/18; KFVB R6 on 980 kc. KFBK was R4. WINS testing with announcements on quarter hour on 1010 kc. WTJS was R8 on test at 3:10 AM s-on. WVJK in Fort Knox, Ky on 2442 kcs on air 4:45AM-10:45AM and 10:45PM for about a minute each day according to a verification from them. Veries in from KTXA-WOPP-WWTK-WSPA-WPAY-VYR-WLVA-WQFI-WRAL-XEGA-WPFA-WJBK-KROJ-CKLW-WCAE-WHLN-WTJS-XEG-WQFE-WQFW-WPWV-WAWZ-WRIG-WDBW. Reports went out to KLRA-WSUN-WGSP-WRBL-WQPC-WQPP-WPHF-WBII-WNTK the Bullion depository at Ft Knox-WMSR-WPHP-WRJI-KHPF-WEGO-WRAL-WFTC-WRRF-WPHC-WPAY-WWSW-WRSA-WSPA-WKVT-WNOX-KTXA-WLVA-WPTN-WSWV-ZEQR-XELO-VYR-WWL. @looks as if you will have to explain some of those calls to the boys Stan. Some of the are very familiar especially WPWV (Ray) I heard these testing WAIR-4-4:05 s-off 10/12th and also these on the 12th WPAY-3:45-4AM; WMFR-4:05-4:10 R8; WFTC-4:10-4:25 R5; KELD at 4:25 R5-8; KGKL at 4:30 R5; WRRF at 4:45 R9 plus; KTOK at 4:54 R4 and WBTM at 5:20 R7. Here are the Tennessee Highway Partol Stations;- WBVM-Nashville-1618kc WJBV-Chattanooga on 1618 kc; WDBW-Memphis on 1618kc and WKVT-Knoxville on 1618 kcs. Some of these I've received veries from before but on account of the contest I reported again. I've received veries from WGIL-WOL-WSAU-WEXL-WLAK-WCBI-WHBO, all these are to be used in contest. I the verie from WSAU they said "Your report is the first received for several months. They are going to be on again Nov 6 at 4 AM EWT.

I am in the DXing mood again after several years of just having to get at it once in a while. So if any one has some dope please drop me a line to above QRA.

NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N. MEX Hrd the announcement over WJBO this AM of the coming WHAZ special. Am afraid that I'll be unable to drag it thru the stations out this way. Come to think of it you must have the same trouble on 1490 kcs that I experience on 1230-1340 and 1450 kcs here. Those 3 channels are blocked every morning. It is only luck when I manage to separate some station on those freqs. Even WNOE is a difficult catch thru KSAN. Have been doing a bit of DX but unable to hear Eastern stations and did not hear anything other than KGFJ on 1230, so no WRBL and I sure needed the Georgian. Slept on the KGCU special after receiving the KSJB program earlier. Usually work until 3AM and then get about 5 hours sleep. Every so often the lack of sleep catches up with me as it did that morning. It may dissappoint some of the NRC members to learn that KINY is still using 1000 watts on 1460 kcs. They came thru 2 days in a row. KGME is a regular since I got mad a while ago and re-aligned the set. Listened for an hour and a half to them this morning while I was working.
