Who checks with Marches 2nd THBB 3:15-3:30? Very weak here on a very good nite. KGER hrd here after 3AM, also KDYL-R9 and another station very weak behind them after they s-off, who could it be? It was not KXYZ. Finally caught WCBI on 11/12 for the Club, tried all last year but failed, also got WFIG, thanks to you Fulton, 1340 kcs pretty busy on 2nd FRI. Veries rec here past week are WSPD letter & card, I mean EKKO stamp, not Card; WDRC-WEBR-W800. I told them I was using Bed springs for an aerial as they pushed WITH right off the dial. They replied back, looks like you have some pretty good Bed springs. WLAV a folder-WENJ-WKNE. WALB hrd on reg evening programs, WAAC on monthly check and WSNY surprised by coming in Q5 R7 one morning just before 7 o'clock. On the club specials had same results on KWAL as Ege, poor DX date anyway, everything way below normal strength here.
