NEWTON MC LEOD-DIXFIELD.ME I am only a biginner in the BCB DX and have logged about 260 stations in 37 states and 8 foreign countries. I use a 1940 Silvertone # 721 with 12 tubes and a 60 foot doublet strung NW-SE. I am bothered by the mountains around here but this last weeks the QRN has been the stumbling block. A terrific buzzing since Sunday has prevented me from hearing a 5KW (WCSH) in Portland-85 miles away. It seems to be worse in the daytime-easing up some by MDT and conditions are fair in the early morning. It is similar to Northern Lights but I never knew them to carry on for so long. I tried for KPOW and WASK but got exactly nothing. The 24th I couldn't even get WITH and the 25th I couldn't get to the 5KW signals in Ohio-Indiana. I hope it clears up soon as I'd like a shot at some of those DX Broadcasts. I like especially the list of Freq Frolics and checks and the DX Calendar as I have logged about all the regular broadcasts that could be heard here.

FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N.Y. Not so much to report this week. Veries in from CHPS-WShY-KGCU-WHIT-WBBE. keports out to WOOD-WEED-KICD-WHUB-WASK-WSUN. So sign of CJRL here. Were they on? (Yes Fred) No KPOW here either but that might have been the location. 11/22 WOOD logged on test 3:30-3:50 with music, then just a carrier till 4:30; 11/23 KICD on reg test; WBIR the same and ditto for WEED. KLRA hrd s-off at 3:04AM. 11/25 WASK with all night DX. Swell program but not good here. Poor sig with good bit of VMOE behind it when I listened at 2:30-3:15; Plenty of NRC publicity. WIBU on reg test at 3:35 and WHUB testing 3:30-4AM. Also finally logged WSON on reg program. By the way I found a WJZ harmonic on 1540 the other morning. Disgusting isnt it?

GENE ALLEN-BEKKELEY CALIF Had a very good luck Sunday AM and tuned in WEGO-heard them for 15 minutes till 1:30AM PWT. I sent them a report and am inquiring as to their power (LKW I believe) signal was R-6 here. Was a signal on 1220 kc this AM 11/22 but I do not believe it was CJRL altho I heard the number "Stardust" at 3:46 AM. Only other DX hrd here has been a Jap on 1000 kcs and 1YA on 650 kcs and 2YA on 720 kcs. The New Zealand stations are consistent most any morning after 5 AM EWI.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. Logged a couple new ones, thanks to the bulletin and the CPC, they are WEGO-CJRL-CMKV and CMJR, did not report to last 2. As expected WEGO came in first rate all the way, clearer then the locals usually are on reg programs. CJKL was so-so here, sometimes 100% readable, sometime 100% behind the noise level, fading badly at times, best at start and close of porgram. Both had nice porgram, specially WEGO. Mr. Nelson is an old hand at this and operated stations in the days when DXers were much more important to broadcasters then they are today. Missed out on KWRC by sleeping too soundly, wanted to hear them again (you didnt miss anything Joe as the noise was too much-Ray) as I never heard him in the clear before. WASK was hrd much of the time between 3 and 5:30AM, came in swell, no sign of WNOE or other QAM here at that time. "Iso sent reports to 3 who did not verify last season, WPDQ who bests WXYZ here sometimes, WSAP on freq check and WINC hrd last Sunday at 8:30AM. WSAP has already verified by nice letter, error in address caused my March verie to be returned to them, now I have that original letter and envelope, with its P.O. rubber stamps, and a PS from the C.E.. Three receptions verified on one letter. Another verie is a letter from WENY. For LEFTY COOPER-KFFA still tests at that time, hrd 3 call announcements here around 3:40-3:45 but it would been hard to verify them thru the QRM. KPOW no go here, not a sign, must have been poor DX for they have been L-6 here on some tests, on same date had WEIR test at SAM, first time ever had them in the clear, very good here.

CHRISTMAS is very close and it would be swell if all of us would send a XMAS GREETING to our Members who are in our Armed Services. Do it NOW. DICK COOPER-KITTANNING PA Recent veries include letters from WHAZ on NRC special-KELD-KFFA-XEOX. Cards from WMRC-WMRF-KEUB-KCKN-KFAM-WJHL-KBGV-

WAJR-CJBC. For LEFTY-KFFA was hrd as per sked on 3rd Thur 3:45-4. And you better throw your Scott away and get a good set. For NORM, WAJR sig-ned by R C Spence, c.e. For LAKRY YARNES, your station on 825 kc is undoubtedly a Costa Rican perhaps TIEP. Have hrd them often and notice they are always good when TIPG is good. Prize verie of the year for me is the letter from XEOX, Ciudad Obregon, Sonora who were hrd on 1340 kc over-riding WEXL and WEMP. Their verie says they were using 125 watts. Also have only inverted "L" antenna. Also want to arrange a DX Program and if the censor doesnt hold up the letters, I may be able to inform you guys when they'll next be on. WMRF has a new "Fritz Print" card which is nifty. KORN mentioned receiving reports from Pittsfield, N.H.-West Point, N.Y. and Louisville, Ky on their Oct freq check. Had swell reception of WEGO special and fair reception of CJRL who signed on at 3:25 and disappeared when WCAU came on at 4:38. Evidently their directional antenna had something to do with their signal being weak down east. (Thats what burns me u, up, you guys cant get CJRL and I had them the entire program, not too good but still hrd them and yet you all get KWRC and all I hear is a lot of noise, and here Lefty says after a half hour they come in, boy I am really mad-Ray) (Oh yes, on KWAL, I dont hear you guys talking about them but Edge get his verie, and still cant hear KWRC, Grrrrr) WASK hrd well on the Thanksgiving special and they read a list of our Officers at 4:40 and then some dope about Kittanning from my report on their test program of 11/18 on which they mentioned the coming DX show on 11/25. I have just received a List of Mexican stations from Mexico City which gives the QRA of each station.
