KWOS testing on 1240 at same time. 12/10 coundlt read KWYO thru WBTH with special Grr. CJFX gets a R3-7 Q1 report for its efforts to break thru WDBO. I think that is the toughest spot in the Americas to pull them from in the morning. Did anyone ever see a skip from there between 3AM and sunrise? Or a broadcast that didnt fade out badly in 30 minutes? WMRF was a job that just makes an old DXer feel 10 years younger-it had IT. To E COOPER-Guess I can just about ditto your reports. I seem to have given up just about 5 min too soon for KWRC. KICD well received this AM Delete-Only thing the matter of the announcer was that he didnt seem to know what to do with his feet. KICD was CHMed by strange station until 4:12 conducting equiptment test and giving call as I got it KODY-North Platte, Neb. Cant find any record in Whites or La Roc's list. KNET copied in part with extreem difficulty. Just wait. We will find out who the panty waists are when we get the gold bricks from KINY.

FRANK JOHNSON-PITTSFIELD N.H. Veries since last report are from WOOD-WHBC-WOSH-WMBC-WAGA-KORN-WAML, all DXers should have this one. Reports have been sent to WDLP-WAAC-KALB-WEOA-KGCU-XESM-WFOR-WCBI-WPEN-WFCI-WMRF-CJFX-WSPA. Pretty good for me. Swell programs from WDLP-KGCU-WCBI-WMRF-CJFX. CJFX was pretty poor, deep behind WDBO. Sent them a meger report. WCBI was as poor as usual but they got a meager one also. Nice card from CKNX. Hrd VAS Glace Bay N.S. sending code on 1320 kcs at 4AM Dec 7th; 12/8 WFOY-WAAC-WEBR-WPAR-WEOA-KALB were all good 12/9 Grand show from WGCM-WFOR-KGCD-WHIT-XESM. 12/10 0,1y WCBI. 12/11 CJFX poor. 12/12 Swell show from WMRF, also reports to WFCI in clear at 7 and to WSPA-WPEN fighting it out on 950 kc after 7 AM. Sure would like some 6-7 AM Sunday specials from WTMC-WSTP-WSAP-WRGA-WOMI-WOLF-WMRN-WMRCwmog-wmjm-wmis-wkro-wkbv-wkbb-wigm-wgtc-wgkv-wgal-werc-wdbc-wdan-wbta not to mention a number of K stations. Veries received, WOSH, they got 20 reports-WLIB WHUB-WSAP-WHIT to make it 831. heports out are WMRF-WJLB-WKPA-WEGO-WASK. Evenings this past week I hrd WSAP-WHIT-WINC-WHIZ-WJEJ-WJAC-WMRF-WRRN-WWSW. Reading is good DX location. Using a short indoor antenna too. A MERRY XMAS to all my fellow members.

LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N.Y. Verie rec from KVGB, nice card. Hardy says he got 26 reports and they are still coming in and he is tickled to death. Reports to WDLP-KGCU-KMAC-KICD-KNET-KRBC and tnx cards to CJFX-WMRF. On 12/7 WDLP had very nice signal starting with "Remember Pearl Harbor" which was thrilling in view of the date. We got nice publicity from them. WINS was testing at 3:30; KMOX seemed to be silent. 12/10 Hrd CMCM announce in English their SW Call, COCM and sign at 12:26; took log on KMAC easily had on top of 1240 from 1:05-2AM; WCBI had tough going, but they cut thru very well indeed. 2 minutes before they came on WGTM opened up with a test program/ WEXL sounded very poor and WEMP waskimperceptable. Heard our tips read by Mr Livingston right thru this mess. 12/11 Tried CJFX but it was no go-all WDBO with KMJ also in there. 12/12 I didnt hear the clock doggone it and slept until 10:30 in the morning, a bit too late for WMRF. But I heard them anyway that night on station break and local commercial over everything at 7:30PM, and sent tax card.
