From Your Courtesy Programs Committee Chairman

It was noted recently that there was some question as to the dates we have picked for various DX catches. What is a "Real DX Catch" For us on the East coast, it is a 250 watt west coast station-but for those on the West Coast it is a 250 watt East Coast station. If we arranged programs from either coast only around the full moon, there would be scant time for DXes. Thke 1230 for instance. Only two hours are open there, from 3 to 5AM Tuesdays, when WITH is off (KGFJ is NEVER off) The second Tuesday I believe was closest to that date of full moon, so what would we had if KVCV had DXed then? We would have had WMFR's frequency check, WISE's and maybe others-WLVA was on in fact after 4:30. The third week would find WHBC and WLOF checking then to QRM KVCV. So I go not by moons, but by the clearest hours on the respective channels. We can have only 1 DX on 1490 a week, if we confine them all to the Sunday nearest full moon, we could contact only 6 stations on the 1490 channel a season. It must also be recalled that we contact many stations which do not condescend to DX-and we have no way of telling in advance which ones will, and which ones wont. So if we allotted only 7 or 10 days a month to trying, we'd have to cancel writing to a great many stations, unless you'd want, say 4 DXes on one week-day morning-say one on a channel which is open at 2, like 1370 or 1220 or the like, and then (if a Tuesday) one from 3-4 on 1230, and another from 4-5, and then one on, say 1400 from 5-6. We'd all be in the hospital losing that much need sleep often. I'll bet that the stations would get a lot less reports, ganging up on one morning. It worked that way Oct 12 when we had 3DXes scheduled. WHBL got only 15 reports, KSJB got 17 and KGCU of course, didnt show up that morning, we having erred on the date. But when one and only one is on of a given date, they get much better results as did KVGB with 32. Since the objection seemed to center around the date for KVCV. I am dwelling on a discussion of 1230 kcs. There are lots of checks on that channel during those two short hours a week and the 4th is the clearest, of if there is a 5th, that is clearest. As to the date chosen for KTW, this is the story. The point was missed, evidently-that program was to be a religious DX the week before Christmas, featuring Christmas music in thoughts of our members in uniform. We couldnt do anything about the moon, you see. (Continued on BCB Page 4)

GORDON STEARNS-CHESTER DEPOT VT I tried for KR0S and did not have any luck, heard two others instead. They were WINX and WEXL. WINX came thru from 2:20 when I tuned in and at 3:00 WINX and WEXL were both mixed up WEXL was good from 3:30-4:30. Couldn't even hear a heterodyne from KR0S. Was going to listen to CJCA this AM but the clock stopped and did not wake up until 6. Thats swell isnt it. Have reported WINK-WEXL-XEF-WITH. hope they will answer. FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N Y Since the last report, reports have been sent to WJBO-WAWZ-WJPF-KUOA-WALL-WQXR-KFUN-WAJR-WFNC-WKWK-CHPS. Veries received from KALB-KGCU-WFOR-WCBI-WPEN-WFCI-WMRF-KNET-WRRF-KICD-WBNX-WFPG-WAWZ-WQXR-WASK. Odd item was that my WAWZ verie came from KPOF envelope and was mailed in Denver, Colo. Disgusting, because I had hoped it was a long overdue verie from KPOF. (Ditto here Fred, altho I do have KPOF verified-Ray) Nice programs from WJBO-WAWZ-KUOA-CHPS. No go on KTW at all here, although I hrd the Mexican too. I positively identified him as XEL in Mexico City. Who has his QRA? No sign of KR0S here. A pretty slow week here. 12/28 KFPY was fine about 2:30 but the noise was better, but managed to copy them between bursts of noise. Heard a total of 5 minutes of KFUN test. On 1050 is a station using French that sometimes gives XEG a real work out. It sounds like a BBC. Have hrd KVOD on that freq and wondered if KOH could be hrd often thru them or would it be impossible, or what is the score.

PETE CLARIUS-STATEN ISLAND N Y Well its a pleasure to be back in the NRC again as I faded out of the DX world for some time but hope to stay back now with you old timers and start fishing again for those rare DX catches. Well I have added the following to my BCB log-WTTM-WJHP-WTOP-WISH-XEB-WAAC-WALL-WMRF-KICD-WRRF-CHPS-KVAK. On S-W I logged Leopoldville, Belgian Congo. I would like to know the calls and address of the Mexicans on 1380 or 1390 kcs, that is on most every morning till about 3AM. They are Q5 R9 with very little fading but all announcements in Spanish however I am able to make out Mex City. Also the exact call of station in Rio de Janeiro on 12,110 kc. Also Sked of ZNS. Do my DXing on a new Motorola in addition to a 9 tube Lafayette. Special hello to Voorhees & 2 Coopers

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TOM MORRISON-CLEVELAND O My DX season has surprised me. On a little 5 tube Firestone I've heard 1YA and London on 11.47, also HJCU-HJCR-HJAN-YV5RQ over WABC. Hrd KTW on their special, also WJBO who had a bad signal here but KTW much worse. KYA hrd R5 12/20 and WARM-WAOV testing same day WDEL hrd here 8:37-8:45 AM EWT. Reports out this season are to CMBF-WTIC-KANS-WKAT-WKPT-WAWZ-WSFA-WDEL-CKY-WHBL-KFXM-WATN-KRKO-XEQ. Lots of luck on Cubans this year. CMBF one of the best, R7 at 7:30 kcs nearly every evening. Nice verie, they sent a swell letter in English informing me that mine is the first report from this part of the US, also sent photo of their auditorium studio. KANS logged on freq check 11/20 from 5:10-5:25 AMEWT. Verified promptly. WKAT hrd R8 at 6:30AM in clear also on 11/20. Nice card. ~~XXXX~~ WDEL hrd 12/2 at 8:40-8:45AM EWT R4-6. CKY sent a plain card with verie stamp, also nice booklet called "Manitowa Calling" WHBL hrd R7 in clear at 5:30 PM on 12/11. DXed last Wed. 12/29 from 1-3:30 and here are results. WRBL-WBML s-off at 1; KOMO R4 under KFEL at 1:30; WCPO R7 over WITH; KRKO s-off about R5 at 2:10 on 1400; WATN R4-8 on freq check 2:10-2:15; KOL hrd at 3:12 Q3 R4; KFXM hrd at odd moments Q3 R5 on 1240 kcs. WKPT at 3:20 with test R9 plus. Signal just as good as WTAM. KRSC at 2:30; WEMP R7 over WEXL at 2:15; Got swell report to XEQ on 1/1/44 from 1:53-2:05. American dance music with New Year greeting in English for the US at 2:02AM. Is XEQ on 940 kcs? Last time I hrd em they were on 730 kcs. Trying to get in at WHK-WCLE. (Good luck Tom)

BUD KOPP-ROCKFORD ILL Well since Oct I have verified 32 states and about 100 new stations. I believe KINY ought to pull htru. See all the fellows griping about QRM from WJBK on WMRP program, I pulled them thru 100% here. Say is there such a station as CJHL? How can I get KOH or KENO and how many of you caught CKX on modulation test a couple weeks back?

MEL OLIVER-BELLAIRE TEXAS Here's the dope on my recent activities since rejoining the club. Recent veries on NRC Specials from KGCU-KNET-WRRF, the latter a personal letter from Roy Phelps saying my report was second in distance only to Norm Maguire, with reports to WAWZ-KVCV on other NRC DXes. (Yes you are our oldest member and lots of good luck to you-Ray)

OREB WILSON-READING PA Was sick with bad cold. DX for KROS but hrd strong hum under WEXL; KGBS-WBIR testing in clear. DX good, KNX in strong. WIP had fire hdest. KRGV at 1AM; WTMA at 11:30PM Veries WASK-WTPA-WMRP-834.

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NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N MEX DXing has been poor but reports have brought in many fine veries of late. Here are some of them--all new--KID-KPLT-KTBC-WAGA and on specials KIT-KNET-KICD-WCBI-WMRF. Just about broke my radio and ruining my ears on that last one but it was well worth it. Texas and Calif are now tied for second in my veries with 54 each. Are behind NY with 56. Cant seem to get Canadians down here at all. Have missed the specials from those stations, due to not hearing a sound. Too much WDBO and KMJ on CJFX, while KLX completely took care of CFJC. Not a sound, tho notice where most of the gang received them. Guess thats my boner for the season. KFMB was scarcely hrd here. Too much KSAN. As Jim Walker said they failed to mention NRC but said program was for all DXers. Between KSAN and KHJ I'm going nuts. However KSAN signs off at 2AM 4AM EWT. KTW was hrd and KVCV was copied solid except when WAJR was on. Could not have found 2 more perfect AMs than these DXes.
