Here are a few skeds from a Corpus Christi paper. KRIS-7AM-1AM on 1360 kc; KTRH from 6:30AM-1AM on 740 kcs; KEYS from 7:30AM-1AM on 1490 kcs. No mention of KWBU so guess they are not on the air yet. WARW in Clarksdale, Miss ~~was~~ a new station on 1450 kc 250w. What happened to WKNY and WEGO, never did get any answer from them. WEGO is good here at 7:50 AM on Sundays.

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BOB SPENCER-BUFFALO N Y I have been a DXer on and off for years, having got my start on an old 10 tube Atwater Kent BCB set which we still keep as it cost \$150. I never sent out reports for verifications until just recently except for a couple of short wave stations. Because of working an average of 14 hours a day Mon to FRI and 10 hours on Sat with Sunday off I don't get to do much DXing. Lately I have managed to squeeze in a bit. On Oct 5 1943 I started to keep a log which I expect to make permanent (for BCB only) Receiver here is a Hallicrafter Sky Champion S20R without the "S" meter. Know where I can get one these days? (Sorry Bob I don't) Antenna is pretty well blocked off by a tree to the east, and taller houses to the north and south. It is made of several pieces—Hi. Is 45 ft inverted "L" running East-West. Late DX was WJBO in Dec-CJRL who haven't verified as yet and KVGB-WCBI. Going for KGNO this AM.

NEWTON MC LEOD-DIXFIELD ME First off skip the dope on KOH as to s-off. I got them this AM 1/7. 1/3 No sign of CJCA by 4:55 so I quit; CJFX on top of 580 kc at 5PM just like there wasn't any other station on; CHML covering XEW solid from 11:45-NDT; 1/4 CKWS on top 960 kc 12-12:10AM s-off. A Bay Emmee Co s-off at 1:15AM on 920; "o sign of KWON as WSLB was on with equipment test. WCAU messing up 1190 to 12:30 ~~AM~~ kc so if CFAR was on I didn't get them. Went to sleep before CFBR. BBC on 670 kc with sitting up exercises. Hows your figure boys? Will some one please take out that Frog on 1190 so I can get KEX? 1/6 Spicks on 1000 kc which seemed to be testing. Repeated records, signal distorted at times. 1/7 Snowed like blazes alrite, ZZ this AM. Temp 24 above but at last I got a special. WKIP testing 1:05-1:15; WOKO test at 1:15; KVOH s-off at 1:30 on top of 1300 kc. German station on 990 with English news at 1:35-1:45; I think it's a German as I got one word Reichfunk and it sounded like this is Germany calling, Open to correction. Punk signal, scarcely readable. KGO 1:50-2; KENO from 2:13-2:28, awful howl from French station I think. KOH 2:35-3AM. BBC right beside WJR about 765kc, maybe 763. WJZ off, how Come? WBIR special test at 3AM. Last is a plum to me, KGMB from 3:22-4:36. I was kind of disappointed though, it sounded just like any other American station and I thought I'd get some hot steel guitar, instead I got commercials from VIMMS and Bayer Aspirin. KGO-KOH-KGNO-KGMB all plenty good for reports and you can bet your shirt tail I did just that. At 4:08 I think I got one announcement of KYUM but they faded completely, were they on? At 4:20 was a weak station on 770 kc with American records. All in all it was a swell morning with stations easily copied between pops of static. Has anybody else experienced good reception during a heavy snow storm? On Prince Edward Island, where I used to live, there was an early DX fan who used to pray for heavy snowstorms as it was then that he got his best reception.. All the discussion about best reception time is very interesting to me but up here it seems one has to take what he gets There doesn't seem to be any definite period of good reception.

LARRY YARNES-WASCO CALIF Late DXings is, HJCZ hrd on 1040 at 6:13AM Jan 1st with what sounded like a special New Years broadcast; KFAR in Fairbanks, Alaska on 660 kc, hrd 3:15-3:30 AM 1/6 with news broadcast; KFQD Anchorage on 790 kc, hrd 4-4:30 AM Dec 29th, signs off with Pledge of Allegiance and the Star Spangled Banner; KINY, Juneau on 1460 kc hrd 3:15-3:30 AM Dec 23rd, signs with Star Spangled Banner at 3:30AM; WTMA on 1250 at 6:08 AM on Jan 1st; WDAE Tampa hrd on 1250 kc at 6:15 AM Jan 2nd. OAX4A at 8:10 PM Jan 4th. Veries in recently from WOSH-KICD-WMRF-WAWZ. WOSH said my report was the most distant received.

CFBR heard weakly behind all this. No CFAR. A station on 1400 at 2:53 with Bing Crosby. Was it KWON? WWVA at 4:15. 1/7 Slept so sent card to KGNO. 1/8 No noise or static, OBOY WSAU at 3:35; KMA at 3:44; WSUN at 4; WQBC at 4:05; WOMT at 4:15; WCRC at 4:18; KYSM at 4:40; KXEL at 4:45; WIOD at 5 with WHBQ; KPAC at 5:20; A station on 1240 at 5:05 with "Pistol Packin Mama, wassit KROY? 1/10 KFVD at 2:35; WJBW at 2:33; WABY at 3; WHAM at 3:20; KDKA at 3:25; WSNY at 3:55 fine DX strong volume but Irving Beck played "Street Draggin Blues" and said he felt that way; WMBO at 4:15; No noise or static. R-9 signal here too. 1/7 Feeling sort of sick, tuned for KGNO, heard shrill hetrodyne and quickly turned off the radio and rushed back to bed (I'm getting old) 1/10 WSNY a chinch here R-9 all the way. Carroll Seth gave me call and freq KVGB's broadcast pick-up station which will participate in the KVGB DX but I cant find his card for the life of me, hence, the more or less indefinite write-up for which I apologize. Received the following new veries-WKK-WIZE-WEOA-WHBC-WGCM-WFOR-KGCU-WEMP-WTAL-WMRF-KTSP-WCCO-KNET-WRRF-WPAY-WAIR-WSB-WISE-WAWZ-WBAB and these duplicates, WIOD-WGBR-CKNX-WTSP-WALL-KGHF-WCBI-WMFD-WFHR-KGO-KICD-WJBO-KPO-KUOA-KERN, I've sent reports out to KONO-WHIT-WAML-KABC-KELO-WJMC-WMFR-KGNO-KTW-KPI-KSKY-CHPS-WING-WFEM-WJBK-CFBR-KYUM-KOCA-KPAC-WTAX-KANS-WSNY who havent as yet verified. These from Dec 7th on. Of the club specials I couldnt get KROS, too much interference, nor CJCA, no interference but he just wasnt there, too much interference to get CFAR, CFBR came in OK. KGNO came in R-9 as did WSNY. To date I have sent out 115 reports from Oct 1 1943, of these I have received 73 veries and since Oct 1 I reported 25 NRC specials. You boys are slipping lately. I have asked that you list your FREQUENCY FROLIC ITEMS SEPERATE FROM YOUR REGULER REPORT. Many of you are not doing this. PLEASE DO SO AS TO REALLY HELP US TO GET THE BEST OUT OF OUR CLUB.

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JOE LIPPINCOTT-CELO N CAR. It seems that some people do not agree with me about the moon-Hi. Well here is the reason I have believed I was right. When I lived in New England I DXed a good deal with Reichardt and Roberts. I may be wrong but I believe they just about top DXers in this country. Neither one is active now, or very much so. Reichardt sold me his 23 tube Scott and had no good DX receiver for a time. Now he has the 23 tube Scott that belonged to Roberts. Both chaps liv in Mass. Reichardt now works for the company that makes the National Receivers. Well in any case when I started to DX, I soon became interested in stations outside the US-Canada Mexico and Cuba. This was due to R & R's influence. They did not verify such stations. They did not bother even with 50 watt west coasters although they heard them. They did try to verify all TAs and TPs and some SAs. Reichardt showed me a verie from a 50 watt station in So Australia. It was a letter stating that R's was the only report from North America. They also hrd and verified low powered stations in Europe but never hrd South Africa. One or both of them were the only chaps to hear Jerusalem on the IDA Special of some time ago. I mention the above only to indicate that I think I have reason to trust in the experience of these fellows. I think they hrd something like 160 TAs. They verified nearly 20 Japs each. It is possible that Dave Thomas has hrd as much. I do not know as I have not seen his list. These fellows just about confined their listening to about 10 days before the full moon and until a week or less after. Stations across the Atlantic seemed to peak 3 days before the full moon and I believe the TPs were better just after. I have not had much opportunity to tune TAs since coming here, since I now have only a 6 tube set but I will submit a little data on my most recent listening. This will not be conclusive evidence but it points in the direction of my belief. I might say in advance that I do not believe the moon is the only factor determining reception. I know that there are others and that sometimes these others spoil the good effect of the moon and at other times are so good that even though the moon is not at the right stage real DX comes in. I list below the stations hrd, they are listed by date with volumn at best.
