April 8 1944

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD NY Only a small amount of DX past 2 weeks and a goodly return of veries. 3/26 WKNY DX not as well hrd as the Nov program. KGVO 3:04-3:16 some static but wekk hrd. CJVI 2:44-3:02 at s/off. 3/31 KTRB special 3-4 AM Q3-4 R 8, a strong signal but static rather bad. 4/2 WTCM program hrd well until 4:22, signal went haywire, either modulation bad or some other trouble. anyone else have dame trouble? 4/4 WSLB DX very enjoyable with live talent 2-2:30; Just my luck, slept by the radio thru WAYS program, so sent tax card. Veries WJDX-WSAP-WMRC-KWRC a nice card Dick-WRVA and from specials WMRF-WSLB-KRBC-CKGB-CHEX-WJBO a candy WKNY double. WSAP verie slogan We solve advertising problems, also complete radio program for whole week. CKGB stated, 47 reported and most distant report was from 2300 miles away.

FRED DURAN-MONTGOMERY ALA. DX seems to be about over here. Been having a lot of static lately. 3/12 Hrd KIDO s/off at 1:30 AM and KRBC at same time. KPOX and KTMK s.off 2AM. Hrd KRBC on special. Hrd KID test 2nd TUES. 2:55-3:10AM; 3/26 KGVO on test, also XEDF and KYCA s/off at 3:30; I slept thru the WKNY test though. I went to sleep after hearing XEDF and the alarm did not wake me up.
