FRED VAN VOGRHEES-WHITESTONE N Y Well, my DX season came to a close on the 18th of April in Whitestone, as I left then for a trip that lasted over a month. I reached my goal of 500 veries by April and just made it. Sent 1.56 reports this past season and all came in except CMBG-WGRM(twice)-WXYZ-KWSC-WIMA-WEEI-KABR-WMEX-WJPF-XEBZ-CJFX-XEX-XEMX-WDEC-WELI-WNAB-WORK. A few personal notes, Iam 24 years old, and am a Flight Radio Officer working with Pan-American Airways. My DXing is done on a 37 Midwest K-11, 11 tubes with an inverted L about 25 ft high and 40 ft long. Interesting to note WFTL filtering thru WOk at 6PM today June 11th. You might be interested in a few notes on reception made on my trip. WKAC-600 kcs in San Juan P.R. was hrd testing one morning from 4-4:35 but I dont believe this is regular. Hrd in the daytime were EAJ-5, Seville on 735 kc; an unknown Frenchman on 880 kc; Toulouse on 920; Algiers on 940; CS2ZA as noted in Freq Frolics; Bordeaux on 1077; EAJ-50, Las Palmas, Canary Islands on 1500; San Sebastian, Spain on 1286 and Algeriras, Ppain on 1520; Evening reception also included Rabat, morrocco on 601; Rennes Bretagne on 695; not 1040 kc as some lists show. BBC, Burghead on 770 kc; An unknown Speniard on 825; EAJ3, Valencia Spain on 850 kc; Tunis on 870; Limoges, France on 890; Brussels, Belgium on 930 and Nice, France on 11.85; There were others had but these were the only ones I can recall. \ill try to keep listening as time goes. By the way, the listing of Portugose stations in Freq Frolics is complete and UP TO DATE.

DR JOHN KIRK-POINT PLEASART W VA Summertime reception seems to be unusually good tols year. I am still hearing the 50kw west ocasters regularly and occasionally getting some others that are pretty good catches. For example on the 8th KOH was putting thru as strong a sig as I have ever hrd in the middle of winter. ZNS and TGW are still nightly comers, battling it out with WKRC (about 100) miles from here. Incidentally WHKC often gets the worst of the deal, particularly from ZNS. XEG seems to be gone for a while, and for some reason I am getting consistant night time reception from WHM for first time ever. A couple questions. Tho is the Cuban on 540 kc?? I havent been able to indentify anything about the station that QRM's WMAQ except that he announces in ppanish. Really wrecks WMAQ for me. Got up one of my new shy hooks. Is a Marconi,225 ft long. It is on the Church (top of) across the street from me. The lead in passes under a 2300 votl transformer feeder line, however so far no noise at all from this line. Hope to get 2 more wires up about Sept. Pont tak that they will do me such good before then and just font feel like putting them up in this hot weather. They will both be considerably longer than the one I do have up. Managed to get a new supply of wire and a complete set of new tubes for me sets. This should help. Think maybe got rid of my power line noise, havent had it for over 3 weeks. Finally found a metal pin holding up an insulator on a 55,00 volt feeded that was arking over and since this was fixed, no noise. Have a slight problem that maybe some one can definitely clear up. I received on May 13th a verification from station HJLABN on 1190 kc, verifying my reception of Mar 12. Have previously reported this in VRC and URDXC publications. They both say that this is an old verification issued before HJLABN changed call. toHJAN. Now the problem is this. The call is definitely mentioned, not only in the printed card but also in writing on the back of the card. The call is definitely given as HJLABN and not HJAN. They comment on the excellence of my report and in addition ask me if I will do long distance observing for them in the USA. Now the question is this. Shall I believe the card which I have in the files and which is definitely a card from HJLABN or shall I believe the comments and reports in the VAC & UkDXC which take issue with this and give the reported call as HJAN??? Personally I regard a verification as a verification irrespective of what call. is used, and if the station issues a veric using the call HJLAEN rather continued on BCB Page 4

DR KIRK cont than the more normally received call of HJAN, to me that verification is one received from HJIABN. I would appreciate the opinion of you fellow NRC members. (In my opinion as long as the call HJIABN was also written on back of card along with comments I would say HJIABN-Ray)

to BROOKLYN (where have we heard that before?) But Lefty Cooper was backing his Dodgers so I didnt see him, however I seen his DX den-receiver, thanks to his Mother. Plan on seeing Lefty some week end in near future. I'm out for these eastern stations, after logging many of the west coast ones. Thus far I have logged 26 new ones for the log, some of which include WLIB-WBNX-WNAB-WPRO-WPAT-WTTM-WBBR-WBNX-VWRL-WCAM-WINS-WILM-WBAB-WTNJ-WSPR-WFPG-WORK-WORC-WICC-WNBC-WSNJ-WBRY-WAAB. Many of these are big ones but wait I'll get the 100 watters too. The most recent veries in are KIEV KFMB-WOV-WBBR-WCAP-WPRO-WTTM-WILM-WTNJ-WSNJ-WDEL the first 2 were logged in Calif. Incidentally Fort Monmouth is located near Asbury Park and thus got to visit WCAP studios, serving New Jersey's North Shore. It might be interesting to some of the members regarding the 3 N J stations sharing the 1310 spot. WCAP has it from 11:30AM-2PM and again from 8-11PM. WCAM from 2-5PM and then WTNJ 5-8PM.

NEWT McLEOD-WEST PERU ME. WAGM DX almost solid here in spite of haywire antenna and a thunder shower. Waorst thing was fading. I think if sufficient interest is shown in this DX that you can count on another next winter. Anyway they dont have the awful hum they had some years ago. Nothing very sensational here. CJLS in deytime under WLNH and VONH at times. Think a new Frog is on 1.450 kc in daytime, might be CHLN. Also station on 1230 which I think is CHGB but this blamed high school French is NG. WGAR hrd on 1220 kcs first time on June 4th. First time hrd I should say. WOCB can be hrd under WCOU and CHLT in daytime and at night it occasionally gets on top of the mess on 1240. Had the bright idea of calibrating the SW bands by harmonics from my phone oscillator but the blank thing wont generate more than 6 harmonics. Muts. To I guess I'll stay off SW until I get a set that is within at least one half meg of being right.
