Don't miss this DX for once again there are prizes being awarded anonomously by a member of the National Radio Club. Remember it is a Years membership in the NRC, or if won by a NRC member it will be a years renewal. This for the report that Mr. Glidden, chief engineer of WAGM regards as the most helpful to himself, regardless of the distance from which it came. The 2nd award is \$1.00 in cash and goes to the person reporting correctly from the greatest distance. To be eligible for these awards, it goes without saying that Return Postgae Must Be Enclosed and that reports shall be postmarked not later than 24 hours after reception. Mr. Gliddel will be sole judge. He was disappointed at the few reports he received on his last DX and the weather really had a lot to do with it, so lets show him that we really can report under better conditions.

A phone call from Phil Nichols says that WWDC will be off the air for the above DX from Station WAGM, so lets all be listening Jan 14th 1945.

The silent period of KNX is SUN AM from about 3-9AM EWT. Listening last night at about 1:45. The last program is Midnight Merry Go round conducted by announcer Tom Hanlon. Just last FRI a boatload of injured soldiers arrived from Leyte Island. They were unexpected and when Hanlon heard about it he turned over his entire program to getting his listeners to bring presents for these some 850 men for Christmas. Having arrived un expectedly they were doomed to have a very dull Christmas. So Tom with the aid of Larry Chatterton, another CBS announcer who usually does the s/off news and a Captain whose name he could not divulge because he had just arrived with the boat having been wounded himself, were kept busy for about an hour and half answering the phones from people calling in and pledging that they would bring gifts to the Columbia Square Studios in Hollywood where they would be picked up by Army trucks and taken to Birmingham Hospital in the San Fernando Valley where the boys were taken. To get off the air, in order that the KNX Xmtr could be worked on they had to take the phones off the hook. The people just kept calling in. That is really swell when a big station like KNX with 50 KW will keep on the air after its reg s/off to get folks to bring presents for the boys., paying all the bills themselves and it takes quite a bit of money to keep a 50 Kw station on the air. A few s/off times are KFOX at 2AM; KUJ at 2AM; KMO at 3 AM along with KVOE-KERN and at 5AM KVJJ.
