Noting the lack of support the v/s list has received, perhaps it would be more useful if a change were made. Print only signers for stations that required f/ups or ones that wrote on the DXers' reports. Thus by going to the proper person, a favorable impression might be made, resulting hopefully in a quicker, better quality verie. Then too, those who need a v/s for a f/up could, in their Musing, request a v/s which could be sent to Ernie for the list to help all members experiencing difficulty with the station. 73s.
