Reception has been a little spotty the past couple of weeks, not to mention a lack of incoming veries. Perhaps I should consider this a breather. I am now beginning to wonder about the timing of some of my reports. For example, I just recently sent my first reports (for this season) out to Canada, an action promptly followed by an upheaval in the Canadian government. For another example, I also recently sent a report to Baghdad, & of course every one knows what happened in Iraq this past week. I really don't know what the moral of the story is. Well, on to some recent DX. 1/27- MM, very fine TA DX, including a good log on Sottens-764, which is a new one for me, heard easily 1-2:15am. I have been trying for Switzerland for several years, but no success until that weekend. Also that MM an excellent signal from EAJ29-953 between 2:40 & 2:50am. 1/29 was a good TA evening, but since then the LAs have been stronger, & the only good TAs were from Portugal & Rome in the early evenings. MM 2/4- No sign of KDBM-800 & CHRC-1490 must have been buried under a flock of others, because I couldn't pick out their program. However, both CKAR & CKAR1 were easily logged between 3-3:30 with their parallel DX program, both over S-9. At 4:00 on 870 I heard the LA s/on others have reported, beginning with "Buenos Dias, Paraguay," & I believe mentioning Radio Nacional, followed up by a program to Paraguay, with mx. I go along with the others who say this is LRA-870, Buenos Aires, probably beaming to neighboring Paraguay. Any other ideas? Before closing I do want to thank Dave Bennett for the nice card re mka 1/31 FF-680 being CHFA. And veries, well as I said, slow. Only WKFE-1550 for their s/on after the DX show didn't show) & CJET-630 for a logging made 1/30, between 5:15 & 5:30 on my car radio, while driving home from work.

I have been trying to insure a clear frequency for the CB73 DX. This has consisted of a letter, composed by Marv Robbins to the GM & CE of HJCU for a possible standby. This they might do because it is for another SA station. The director of CB73 has also written to HJCU. I also notice there is an unk OD on 730 which seems to be CKDM, which has stopped AN programming. If any of you know for sure whose it is, please write to them. This DX could be considered sort of a "foreign exchange". TAs have been fair, new ones being BBC-1295-647, Hilversum-746 CSB2-1034 EAJ29-Madrid-953, Paris I-863. Signal on 1300, not sure who, 638, San Sebastian, CB114 for a report. Have also been hearing the Hindu mx on 643, possibly Surinam & maybe PZX7 if they are no longer on 820. The dominant Brazilian on 640 is PRF9 in Porto Alegre. They are an excellent verifier. TPs have not been up to snuff here. Hope the next few weeks will change all that. Gentlemen:

"May someone from the other side of the fence "blow off a little steam" in a friendly way? As one of my duties as CE of this station and WYFI-FM Norfolk and Portsmouth Ba. I have just finished sending out over 100 verification of reception reports, of necessity a job that has to be done ID and when time is available. So may I put forth a couple of suggestions that will help the broadcast station speed up replies to you, and reduce the work load of verifying the reports?

"In the first place, Very Very few, if indeed any, stations today keep music logs except for the one month a year required for BMI licensing costs, and as a working DJ for nearly 20 years, don't ask me to tell you what record I played at 9:15 this morning because I can't do it. I estimate I have played over a million sides on the air during my career. Think of the hours of labor to keep records on that list - impossible!

"I am happy to report that of National Radio Club members, I have been able to verify about 95% of their reports as compared to about 20-25% of non club members, and 99% of those, I have been able to verify in ONE way... because the person reporting had included the name of a LOCAL sponsor. Without the trouble and time consuming process of digging back in logs, which is the most direct reason most stations do not verify... because it costs too much money in time to do so. It takes approximately 1 minute to verify a report where LOCAL sponsors are identified. It has taken up to a half hour to verify where this was not done.

"One other point - please ask your members NOT to send repeated reports. I found FOUR from one listener in 2 month's time for the same occasion, and it was not complete enough to verify!

"So if your members, and if they would encourage all to do so, would list mainly local sponsors, and air personalities' names insofar as possible!

"In the past I have tried to confirm, or deny, but answer every report as conscientiously as possible, but I find I have to let them accumulate and do them when possible, usually on my own time, but I am finding that I am going to have to stop answering unverifiable reports or face up to a management 'request' to forget about them completely simply because it costs money to do it.

"Now don't get me wrong, I am all in favor of your hobby, I did it myself when I was younger. How long ago that was I won't admit but my first commercially manufactured receiver I owned I earned the money for and bought - a 1921 Westinghouse one tuber using a WD-11 tube, which I still have, still works, with the original tube, used a couple of years ago on a Westinghouse dealer promotion.

"Hope you see fit to pass along the 'Gripes' of mine to help the industry help you. Good DXing and best 73s." (signed) Jack Garrison, W4HIP, CE, WBOF-1550 & WYFI-FM.
