After a fabulous summer for TV & FM DX, in which now fewer than 113 TV & 106 FM stations were received between 5/1-10/31, come November it's time to start taking AM seriously again, hi. Added five new stations in October, although DX most of the time was mediocre. In the period 9/30-10/4, CKFH-1430 for a change was off AN "to allow staff to make technical adjustments" (actually off 12:18-5am EDT). Only stations heard, however, were WIRE & WNAV, previously received back in the days when CKFH was on 2400. 10/5- WHIS-1440 coming in with about best signal ever at 5:30pm; WBDS-1570 heard a couple of times around s/off time - couldn't catch location but White's says Danville, Pa. 10/12- Not too common to hear WJBK on top of 1500 till pattern change at 5:45pm; WABQ-1540 s/off @ 5:45 about a minute after CHFI. Around 10pm, SS mixed with WLS-990 - believe was HJCE, Bogota; 4VW-1325 with fair signal.
