This is a brand new radio station, as you probably know. They are going to be running a special equipment test on Monday morning, November 14th, from 3:00 to 3:30 a.m. on what is hoped will be a clear channel, as the regular all-nighters are not on the air on Monday mornings on 1510. That is, all but the 40 watt CBC LPRT, CBEL, of course. WJIC is non-directional, and runs 250 watts. They are a daytime only station, which of course means that this is probably one of the few times you will be able to hear this fine new station in Southwest New Jersey. We do not know what the program will be, but it will be a TEST, and so we look for tones, etc. Our thanks to Mr. Thomas Cahill for letting us in on this important tip. D. The final ten minutes of their RS on Saturday 10/29 was heard 6:20-6:30pm, when they s/off the air, and surprising enough, they topped the 50kw. KFAB in Omaha, also assigned this frequency. Each word of the ten minutes of listening to the new WKRA was easily copied for a report. - 1045 PANAMA. The carrier here never seems to have any modulation in late evenings. Have they quit AN and simply leave the carrier on or isn't the modulation making it? (Freeman, Calif.)
- 1050 NETH. ANTILLES. New Curacao station here, very strong. 1800-1900 daily, then usually sirks uder the mess. Usually used Papamento, with rr or continental music, though sometimes with Latin music. Don't know if this \*\*\* is PJC7 from 1010, but this one is a good bit stronger than PJC7 was. I suspect about 10 kW being used here. (Miller, Fla.) Silvera ID's it as FJL3, R. Caribe, Willemstad. Ex-1230. (Ed.)
- 1060 CUBA. CMFG, R. Enciclopedia Popular, Habana. Is station with US standards (!) noted around 0340, fair to good. Can't work up much enthusiasm for reporting to Cubans. (Callarman, Texas)
- 1070 COLOMBIA. HJCG, R. Santa Fe, Bogota. Logged 0305-0332 with music, different nationalities, time checks, complete ID's (minus call letters) for ECB and SW each 15 minutes. But they couldn't have a blander format unless they segued selections! (Callarman, Texas)
- PUERTO RICO. WMLA, Arecibo. S/off nightly is 2110, using SSF. (Miller, Fla.)
- 1110 MEXICO. XERCN, Mexico, D.F. Fantastic signal 0721 10/31. (Northam, Oregon)
- 1140 PUERTO RICO. WIPA, San Juan. Now operating with 10,000 watts, U-3 per announcements. (Miller, Fla.)
- +1169 INFL. WATERS (Isle of Man). R. Caroline North testing here 10/30 after 1930. During daytime, still is using 1520 kHz. (Rolf Blüdnorn, 6301 ALLENDORF, Postfach 26, W. Germany)
- 1180 MEXICO. XEPR, R. Felicidades, Mexico, D.F. Didn't realize they were on this late. Logged 0335 on 11/7. (Callarman, Texas)
- 1190 MEXICO. XEWK, LV de America Latina, Guadalajara. Heard for first time under HJCT at 6605 10/31. Must be directional away. (Michael A. Silvera, 5 Grosvenor Heights, Kingston 8, Jamaica)
- \*1055 NICARAGUA. YNLL, R. Masaya, Matagalpa. Heard 2000 11/7; not the Guatemalan this time. Another carrier detected here, however. (Walt Fair, 12022 Palmway, Houston, Texas 77034)
- 1200 NICARAGUA. YNC, R. Capital, Managua. Apparently AN. Heard 10/31 all night with typical LA format and frequent ID's. No sign of the Cuban here (Yippeee!!) S4-S6 signals. I'm going to send a report to this one if I can get him next week. Only listed 500 watts. (Conrad, Ky.)
- +1214 ALBANIA. Tirana. New transmitter heard testing, very strong signal. Mid-October, I heard it relaying the Albanian homeservice, parallel 1358. Now it is carrying Radio Tirana's Foreign Service, e.g. 10/29 2230-2400 (2230 Arabic, 2300 French, 2330 Greek). And carried the German program 10/30 1700-1730. Dominant here in Central Europe over the BEC most of the time. Sometimes uses 1394 instead of 1214. (Blüdnorn, W. Germany.)
- + UNID. Biggest surprise of the season was to find signal here, looping Northern Europe and carrying typical Soviet format with UNID language. Assumed it must be Estonian listed as 20 kW, but after inquiry sent, EBU list comes and says only 5 kW. Could it be something else? Heard with audio 2350-2402 on 10/29, then it faded out. Very weak, but WCAU down and could use big antenna with full gain -- about the only spot on the dial this is possible. (Freeman, Calif.) Well, Clarence? Are you as convinced as I am? By the way, I'll take WITH powers for Soviets over the EBU listed powers. (Ed.)
- 1230 PUERTO RICO. WNIK, Arecibo. This is the AN SS here. All LA music, many ads for mortuary service, as well as 24-hour ambulance service. Many public service annots., and sometimes fades in quite strong. (Miller, Fla.)
- 1235 BERMUDA. ZIM-1, R. Bermuda, Hamilton, good at 0330 10/28 with rock-n-roll usic. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1240 BAHAMAS. ZNS2, Nassau. Now usues 1000 watts daytime, and possibly night as well. I don't know complete sked for this, but TT comes on for awhile at 1720 weekdays. Programming starts 1730. Signal here is strong, way over all domestics and Cuban. Seems to be right on 1240. (Miller, Fla.)
- UNID. SS6 Looped WROV here, and got a strong Spanish-speaker on 10/31 on AN program. LA music and lots of talk. Who? Mexico, Cuba, Colombia, or U.S. Spanish speaker. I can make a tope on him to send to anyone who'll help ID him for me. This one is usually here PM's with 10DB signals. (Conrad, Ky.) I'll listen. (Ed.)
- 1275 EL SALVADOR. YSQL, Radiodifusora YSQL, San Miguel, fading in and out under TIRE at 0613 11/2 with ranchero music. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1280 AFGHANISTAN. Kabul signs on around 2055. Koran-readings at 2100. Fadeout soon after 2100. (Blüdnorn, W.Ger.)
- 1290 CUBA. CMKA, Guantanamo. Carries English R. Habana programs during the evening. Sometimes relays or carries programs from CMCA. Much propaganda and anti-Viet war material. (Miller, Fla.)
