
### NEW NRC LOG SELLING OUT QUICKLY!

Guarachita-690, HIJB-830 & Ia Voz de las Fuerzas Armadas-1600 (their Moca relay on 1330 parallel). These stations had either cl mx or religious services. Through Ondas del Caribe-1150, Punta Figo (Thursday) I heard about about an order given by the Venezuelan government to stations to close for the celebration of the Holy Week, so they were closing @ 9:55pm. R. Rumbos-57-&670, R. Caracas-750 & R. Margarita-1020, Porlamar, were the only Venezuelans heard on Good Friday. No one heard on the 60 meter band. Even the ever-present NSP-910 R. Aeropuerto was off. In Colombia R. Sutatenza presented religious programs with all their frequencies in //, the best ones heard were 590 700 & 960, very strong, 810 could not be heard as HIJB-830 was on the air. Todelar presented pop mx on several frequencies, R. Horizonte-540 on w/pop rx, also R. Tequendama-770 pop mx. Only Haitian heard was 4VEH-1035 w/cl mx. Cuban frequencies best heard were 640 & 1270, only politial talks, also 690 after R. Huarachita s/off @ 9pm. Some U.S. stations were heard: WGBS-710 WHN-1050 WBT-1110 VCA-1180 WJJD-1160 WTOP-1500 WIAC-1510 & WBSC-1550, & Hahamas-1540. Heard for the first time R. 



It's not they wouldn't like to, but they have to stick to company doctrine. Anyhow, the PAF form covers all sorts of specialized stuff that won't be on the fire or homeowner's policies. Matter of fact, just about anything can be written on a PAF. So if any of you are interested, there's how you do it. 73s.
