600 WBWL FL Jacksonville – CP for U2 5000/1800 is now on the air.

550 KMVI HI Wailuku – Coordinate correction to 20-53-25/156-29-20.

610 CHNC QC New Carlisle – Is off the air as their simulcast period with their new FM on 107.1 MHz has expired.

1150 CHGM QC Gaspé – Is off the air as their simulcast period with their new FM on 99.3 MHz has expired.

1550 WNZF FL Bunnell – CP granted for U2 11000/250 CH 9500, increasing the day power and adding the CH parameters.

1550 CBEW ON Windsor – On 7 December 2010 the new FM at 97.5 intended to replace CBE has signed on, meaning the AM has 90 days of life.

1370 WHYP PA Corry – License reinstatement and license renewal application accepted.

- 620 **MEXICO** XEBU Chihuahua, Chih NOV 24 0112 – Fading up with rancheras and frequent "La Norteñita" slogans. [Vance-TX]
- 830 **MEXICO** unID NOV 26 1158 - Vocal anthem, clobbered by power increase from very local 820 WWBA. NOV 28 1138 - Soft vocals and some rock vocals in Spanish – not the typical ranchera fare for a Mexican female announcer, vocal anthem at 1157 but again wiped out by WWBA power increase. This one will elude me unless the anthem starts a little earlier, it appears. [Krueger-FL]
- 840 **MEXICO** unID NOV 26 1200 – Vocal anthem, but too poor to ID. [Krueger-FL]
- 890 **CUBA** *R.Progreso/R.Surco/R.Chambas* (FM relay), unknown site, Ciego de Ávila DEC 1 2324-0105 – Per tip from Paul V. Zecchino that the *R.Progreso* outlet here just flipped to *R.Surco*. (I had *Surco* as late as the morning of November 28). Tune in to not *Surco*, but *R.Chambas* IDs. This station is low power FM only (90.7 MHz) in Ciego de Ávila province. Indeed, per [www.radiocubana.cu](http://www.radiocubana.cu) directorio de radio emisoras cubanas under Ciego de Ávila, Chambas is listed as being rebroadcast via *R.Surco* for 5.5 hours per day (no times listed). Programming was mostly Cuban dance, techno and rock. After 0000, canned feature on children's care, 0016 song with first few bars of "Jingle Bells" appended. Apparent end of relay at 0100 with *R.Surco* ID and programming. Signal was huge. DEC 2 1220 – *Surco* programming still here with ID. At 2248 check, very poor and hard to tell if *Chambas* or *Surco* audio in interference from a Vietnamese talker (presumably KTXV Mabank, Texas) and WLS. *Chambas* was an interesting discovery, a first for me. Still not certain if the *Surco/Chambas* transmitter is the former *Progreso* listed in Ciego de Ávila, or new. DEC 4 0121 – Strong, but no longer *R.Surco* feed. Back to *R.Progreso* parallel 640 kHz. So I presume that means FM *R.Chambas* reception is lost as quickly as it appeared. [Krueger-FL]
- 939.89 **MEXICO** XEQ Iztapalapa, México (19°19'N 99°05'W) NOV 26 1138 – Ranchera vocals, presumed the one based on Dave Yocis off-frequency log in IDXD 78-8. [Krueger-FL]
- 980 **CUBA** COCO Sapo, Ciudad de la Habana NOV 26 1131 – Fast-paced male newscaster, "El Periodico del Aire" slogan. Good. [Krueger-FL]
- 1030 **MEXICO** XEQR *R.Centro*, México DF (19°24'N 99°06'W) NOV 26 1128 – Vocal anthem at odd tune-in time, clear "Radio Centro" by man at 1129. [Krueger-FL]

### International News

**GREENLAND:** On February 11 at 8:00 a.m. local time all MW stations carrying *KNR* will be switched off for good and the transmitters will be dismantled. Relays of *KNR* newscasts twice daily via Tasiilaq 3815 kHz will also cease. The decision has been taken by the Ministry of Housing, Infrastructure and Transport. *KNR* will only be available via low power FM in inhabited areas of Greenland. Weather forecasts will be available for fishermen and others via VHF coastal radio. Thus no coverage of the waste country outside the towns and villages – and *KNR* will no longer be available for the fishermen at sea nor the Inuit population in Canada. The decision was made because the transmitters were getting old and too costly to maintain. Besides, very few people are using the MW transmissions. It was considered replacing MW with new SW transmitters near Nuuk, estimated cost 4 million DKK (535.000 euro), but it was felt that few listeners would invest in a SW receiver and the quality would be 'doubtful' – suffering from 'atmospheric phenomena.' I was doing some research on Ultralights and came across an article that was written by Kevin Schanilec of Bainbridge Island, WA who is “one of the original leaders of the Ultralight DX movement, and was actually the originator of the ‘Ultralight Radio’ moniker,” according to NRC'er Gary DeBock. For the edification of all I obtained Kevin's permission to run the article here.

What is an Ultralight Radio? By Kevin Schanilec

The Definitions Committee is guided by the following attributes which characterize an Ultralight MW DX radio:

1. It is a simple shirt pocket-sized radio of not more than approximately 20 cubic inches.
2. It is an entertainment-grade radio, as opposed to enthusiast's radio. As such, it will usually not have AM synchronous detection, SSB clarification or other specialized features.
3. It is readily available to the hobby in new or used markets at the time of its approval.
4. It costs no more than \$100 retail at the time of approval.
5. It is primarily a radio. While it may have other features as well (MP3 recorder, etc.), the design and function should have radio reception as its focus.
6. It is not a "novelty radio" such as Coca Cola Can radio, Mr. Potato Head, etc.

While one may of course use any radio they wish for DXing, for purposes of contest participation and records submission an Ultralight Radio must be officially approved by the Ultralight Definitions Committee. If an Ultralight enthusiast wishes to have a particular radio considered for inclusion in the list, he/she should submit a proposal to the Committee that states, specifically, how the radio in question meets the six criteria above. The proposal should also contain or have a link to the specifications for the radio, and preferably at least one photograph.

Each radio must be approved by a committee on a case-by-case basis. The criteria are more of a guide than a set of rigid restrictions, and occasional exceptions may be made to any of the criteria. However, the committee requests that discretion be exercised before seeking approval for radios clearly outside of the definition. The approval process is thoroughly vetted by many individuals before a decision is made. The individuals are scattered all over North America and the vetting process can be time-consuming with unanticipated delays because of work schedules or other commitments.

There is plenty of information on Ultralight radios at <http://www.dxr.ca/ulr/75-introduction-to-ulr>. Many of the articles on Ultralight radios have been featured in the pages of DX News. Hopefully the definition of Ultralight radios and the challenge that they present might encourage more participation in this year's NRC Contest in the Ultralight category.

GEORGE A. SANTULLI, LOVETTSVILLE, VA

I just read the wonderful Karl D. Forth article in the October, 2010 issue of PopComm. The article about "Silent Nights and Distant Signals: AM Clear Channels, Then and Now." It brought back such wonderful memories of the "golden days" of AM DXing. Karl's article hit the nail on the head and brought back vivid memories of those "Sunday nights/Monday mornings," when the possibility of coast to coast DXing was possible as stations signed off like a set of dominoes falling starting with the east coasters leaving the air at midnight, followed by the central zone, mountain zone and then finally at 2am EST, opening the door to the west coast. Many of the big guns of the West stayed on till dawn in the eastern zone. KFI, KSL, KOMO, KING, and even KORL-650 Honolulu was possible. I can remember checking the western opening early on Sunday evening to see if I could hear WLS or WHO easily. From Central Jersey, that usually was an indication that it would be a good Monday morning. I can still remember as I was watching Bonanza on Sunday night, which was set in Nevada, hoping that within hours, I, too, would be lucky to finally hear KENO-1460 in Las Vegas, which was widely reported in the east. One frosty January morning in 1964, I did hear KENO in my NJ home. I also remember KTFI in Twin Falls, Idaho, KOWB in Sheridan, Wyoming, KBOI, when they were on 950 from Boise, KWIZ in Santa Ana, KEEN in San Jose. MM's or Monday mornings were magical and full of possibility. How tiny KRDS-1190 from Tolleson, AZ made it into NJ with nary 250 watts was a mystery, but they did make it. A DX test from KYMN in Oregon City, OR also was heard, even with KOMA on from Oklahoma City. Nothing was impossible, every station in the west still on the air was fair game. Somewhere hidden away in the basement are audio tapes of some of those sessions. How many times did I have to rewind the old RCA 1/4 track audio recorder to hear the faint ID from KFBK Sacramento on 1530 with a silent WCKY paving the way for a shot at the California capital.
