750 KSEO OK Durant – CP granted for D1 220/0 [antenna designator corrected from last issue]

1240 WGUY ME Ellsworth – Licensed for 1000/650, WGUY has an application to move to Veazie, Maine (a distance of about 18 miles) on 1230 kHz with U1 1000/640. They now have submitted a **Silent STA** application stating: “The applicant has determined that it has become economically infeasible to operate the station at its authorized location. The applicant has taken the station off the air while it makes plans for the relocation of the station.”

1310 KMKY CA Oakland – CP granted for U4 5000/5000, changing the antenna code from U3. Yet, the two patterns are identical.

1340 NEW AR Bethel Heights – CP granted for U1 1000/1000 at 36-12-43/94-07-38. Bethel Heights is on I-540 about 10 miles north of Fayetteville.

1490 WAZZ NC Fayetteville – Coordinate correction to 35-04-06/78-54-09.

- * Returning to the airwaves: KALY-1240 Los Ranchos de Albuquerque, New Mexico with ‘Kids’ programming: *Jenny Radio*.
- * Reported as Silent: KXOR-660 Junction City, Oregon; WHNY-1250 McComb, Mississippi [license cancelled; call deleted]; KSTN-1420 Stockton, California [taken down by the owner - maybe for good]
- * On-again-off-again: WAMD-970 Aberdeen, Maryland was back on the air during the week of 3 January 2010 running audio from WAVA-780, likely to keep the license active. It is now again silent.

- ✿ **News Item:** Sony will soon close its Pitman, New Jersey, CD factory, according to an Associated Press report carried by NJ.com and other news outlets. The scheduled closure is March 31. The plant, built in 1960, was a major presser of vinyl LPs for CBS Records/Columbia, their subsidiary labels and clients. When Sony acquired the music arm of CBS in 1988 it acquired the plant. It ceased vinyl pressing in the mid-1980s and has concentrated on Sony's digital discs. DVD pressing was removed last year according to the story. The closing of the plant is attributed to the shift in music purchasing habits to direct computer/digital music player downloading rather than physical media such as CDs.
- ✿ **News Item:** NASHVILLE, Tennessee – The WSM radio tower, a landmark on Concord Road in Brentwood, will be considered for addition to the National Register of Historic Places, state officials said. The tower was created in 1925 with help from then-WSM engineer Jack DeWitt. After World War II, DeWitt became the president of WSM and led the company to the creation of its first television station, WSMV Channel 4. The tower first broadcast "The Grand Ole Opry" in the 1932, according to state officials. A state review board will examine the tower and at least half a dozen other nominations at 9 a.m. Jan. 19 at the Tennessee Historical Commission offices, 2941 Lebanon Road.
- ✿ **Fines:** A fine of \$6000 has been assessed to **KFSD-1450 Escondido, California** for failing to ensure the operational readiness of their Emergency Alert System equipment. In other words, they didn't have one . . .

- 670 KBOI ID **Boise** – 1/6 1920 – Talk show with "downtown Boise" popping thru dead air during Bears talk on WSCR. Chicago dominant and no attempt to null with need to point loop at Idaho. Appeared under WSCR at 1919 and continued to be heard except during loud commercials on WSCR. Reception time about 11 minutes but no further local references could be understood. Clearly heard night pattern switch at 1930 and 13 seconds of number one most wanted western. (SC-IN)
- 690 WELD WV **Fisher** – 1/14 1750 – Fighting off CFTR-680 slop with station promo "all oldies...great oldies on WELD" by male DJ, "WELD" jingle into "You're the One" by the Vogues. (MKB-ON)
- 750 KHWG NV **Fallon** – 1/8 0731 – Faded up with solid signal more than a half hour with mix of classic and new C&W. Man with singing ID, "Listen to K-HOG, you and your old dog", and spoken ID "Listen to K-HOG and be informed K-H-W-G Fallon Nevada." (SC-IN)

- 780 WCKB NC **Dunn** – 12/28 1659* – Noted over intermittent WBBM with North Carolina News Network local news from 1645 until sign-off. WAVA previously signed off. (DJ-PA)
- 790 KFGO ND **Fargo** – 1/13 0915 – Bleeding through under strong local WSGW with morning chit-chat and many ads. Not new but rare. (HF-MI)

- 970 WNEO NY **Buffalo** – 12/31 1757 – Fair with local WBBG off, fading up with end of "All Things Considered", financial news, local weather, BBC World Service news, ID as "this is WNEO AM information radio the Western New York and Southern Ontario." (JM-PA)
- 1030 KCWJ MO **Blue Springs** – 1/9 0056 – Series of REL songs, ending with a rousing rendition of "How Great Thou Art," into legal ID, mention of kcwj.org, into news. Good on peaks in phase null of WBZ. (DY-WV)
- 1040 WYSL NY **Avon** – 1/5 0720 – Station ad promoting itself to potential advertisers, ESPN's Mike & Mike in the morning. Signal faded from excellent to nothing. (DJ-PA)

- WYHY KY **Cannonsburg** – 1/3 1729 – Fair, in briefly with oldies, slogan "Oldies 1080 WYHY", then gone. (JM-PA)

- 1100 WHLI NY **Hempstead** – 1/5 1545 – Call letter ID noted, very weak but readable over WGPA and one other station. (DJ-PA)
- WTWN VT **Wells River** – 1/5 1558 – ID by woman into religious programming followed by Vermont charity announcements and local weather forecast. (DJ-PA)
- 1110 KFAB NE **Omaha** – 1/4 1754 – Fair in WBT null with talk and "KFAB Time Saver Traffic" local traffic report. (JM-PA)

- WGNZ OH **Fairborn** – 12/20 1714* – Good in WBT null and WTAM-1100 IBOC slop with full sign-off announcement giving mailing address in Dayton, OH and asking listeners to hear them 24 hours at wgnz.com. **(JM-PA)**
- 1120 WUST DC **Washington** – 1/6 1645 – Religious program in SS, with numerous "Alleluia"s, with annoying flute-like sounds (if by them) in the background. ID at 1701: "WUST Washington...AM Radio Nuevo Mundo." New, DC #3. **(DP-QC)**
- 1160 WQRT KY **Florence** – 12/21 1745 – Fair-good with Simon Kent High School basketball (power outage during the game!), local ads, ID with guitar in background: "...you're listening to Real Talk AM 1160 WQRT Florence y'all!" **(JM-PA)**
- WABY NY **Mechanicville** – 1/9 0801 – "When you need to know the weather fast, call the weather..., 453-1212. The weather call is a service of AM 1160 WABY, Moon Radio." **(DP-QC)**

Heard again on 1/14, this time with an ID: weather forecast "...I'm meteorologist Michael (Carol?) on AM 1170 WFDL. Right now, 18." (I wonder if it's the same guy I heard on KOWZ?). - 1240 WULA AL **Eufaula** – 1/2 0656 – Sports talk, then ID by male, "You're listening to ESPN... on WULA..." into unidentified network news, leading with tornados in Cincinnati and Arkansas. Faded down and gone in the multiple co-channels. Listed as 600 watts Class C. If so, a pretty good graveyard catch from here. **(TLK-FL)**
- WFSX FL **Fort Myers** – 1/8 0714 – Poor with enzyme pill quack doctor brokered show. Also noted 1/9 0724 with ads for local BBQ joint and a store on US 41 in Bonita Springs. //WNOG-1270 Naples, which was in marginally better here. **(TLK-FL)**
- 1280 WTMY FL **Sarasota** – 1/9 0716 – Fair with Phil Hendrie show, commercial break, promo for sales inquiries to "564-WTMY, Sarasota-Bradenton-Venice." **(TLK-FL)**
- 1310 WIBA WI **Madison** – 1/8 0104 – Good with SRN news, ad for Bluetip cigarettes. (*I thought all tobacco advertising had been purged from radio circa 1971. Mike*) **(POB-IN)**
- 1380 WKJV NC **Asheville** – 1/11 1718 – Religious songs in mix with other talk and SS stations, "Presenting the wonderful grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. This is Asheville North Carolina's... Gospel. AM 13-80 WKJV." **(KK-VA)**
- 1390 WMER MS **Meridian** – 1/11 0001 – Poor with religious music, local news and weather. **(POB-IN)**
- 1410 WLVV AL **Mobile** – 1/11 0102 – Poor until fade-out with news, local weather, ad for Home Depot, announced "your religious station of the Mobile area." **(POB-IN)**
- WDOE NY **Dunkirk** – 1/13 1737 – In KQV/WPOP mix with oldies from the 1970's and 80's. Jingle "14-10 WDOE" and "WDOE" ID by male DJ. **(KK-VA)**
- 1430 WXNT IN **Indianapolis** – 1/7 2017 – Local news, ID as "Fox News-Talk 14-30 WXNT." One in the DX parade. **(HF-MI)**

- 830 WCRN MA **Worcester** – 1/12 2011 – Poor in WCCO null. MA sports boosters, phone numbers, "WCRN" into play by play. No bumper mx. NEW! **(JJR-WI)**

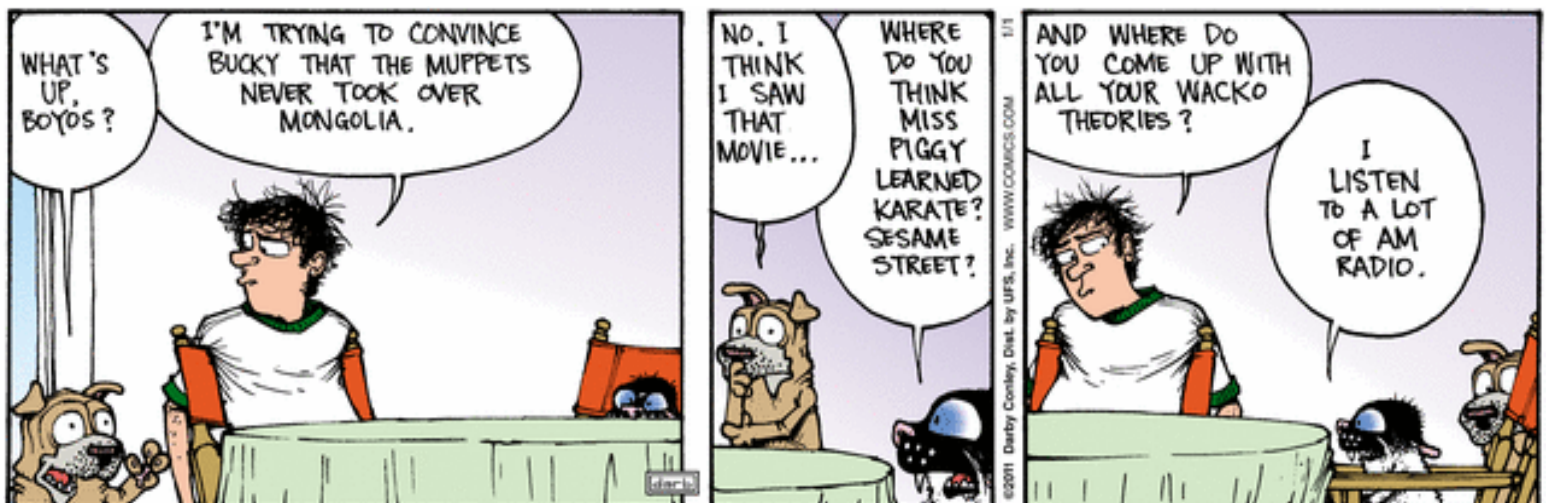

Alert 1680 AM – Sunnyvale's Emergency Radio Station

"Sunnyvale Quarterly Report," Winter 2011, page 3 (via Bob Karchevski)

There is a new radio station on the AM dial here in Sunnyvale, but you won't be able to hear your favorite song on this station. Instead, you will hear important safety information during local, regional or national emergencies. Alert 1680 is now in operation at 1680 AM on your radio. This radio station is the brainchild of the Sunnyvale Department of Public Safety's Office of Emergency Services and the Sunnyvale Amateur Radio Emergency Service. Funding for the system was made possible through a grant provided by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

Alert 1680 will broadcast weather information provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration 24 hours a day. If important information needs to be broadcast to the residents in the community, Public Safety staff can quickly access the radio system and either broadcast live or schedule pre-recorded information segments.

You will soon see signs around the community designed to heighten awareness to Alert 1680 AM. "We encourage everyone to tune to 1680 AM in emergencies, and set one of your car radio's buttons to 1680 AM," urges Public Safety Chief Don Johnson. "Alert 1680 is part of the City's overall public notification system during emergencies, which includes Alert 1680, the news media, the City's website, cable television and the county's SCCAlert notification system." Johnson added that along with emergency supplies such as potable water and non-perishable food supplies, each home should have a battery powered AM radio ready for use during times of an emergency, such as an earthquake or flood.

NOAA Space Weather Outlook

Issued January 11 – For the period January 12-February 7, 2011

Solar activity is expected to be at very low levels with a slight chance for low levels during 12–13 January, as Region 1040 (N34, L=189, class/area Hsx/210 on 04 January) rotates off the west limb. Activity is expected to decrease to very low levels for the remainder of the period.

No proton events are expected at geosynchronous orbit.

The greater than 2 MeV electron flux at geosynchronous orbit is expected to be at moderate to high levels on 12 January. Flux levels are expected to decrease to normal to moderate levels during 13 January-03 February. High levels are expected from 04–07 February.

Geomagnetic field activity is expected to be at mostly quiet levels from 12 - 13 January. Quiet to unsettled levels are expected during 14 - 15 January as a CH HSS moves into a geoeffective position. Mostly quiet levels are expected during 16 - 19 January. Activity is expected to increase to quiet to unsettled levels during 20 - 21 January, due to another CH HSS. Activity is expected to decrease to quiet levels during 22 January - 02 February. Quiet to unsettled levels are expected from 03 - 05 February as another CH HSS moves into geoeffective position. Quiet conditions are expected to prevail for the remainder of the forecast period.
