### THE DX TIME MACHINE

**75 years ago:** From the Jan. 6, 1937 *DX News*: Publisher R.H. Weaver of York, Pa. did not hear the special DX test from KANS-1210 Wichita, due to the strong signal from TGW Guatemala City on the same frequency; Arthur L. Robb of Topeka, Kan. pointed out that WPRO-630 Providence, R.I. has a clear channel for an hour after their 6 a.m. sign-on, as WMAL and KFRU do not sign on until 7 a.m..

**50 years ago:** From the Jan. 6, 1962 *DX News*: Tony Ward of New Zealand reported verifications back from a number of US stations, including KFRB, KCPX, KGIW (250 watts), KXL, WLW, KRAK, WKY, and WNBC.

**25 years ago:** From the Jan. 5, 1987 *DX News*: The FCC has placed a freeze on applications for new daytime-only stations, and this freeze is likely to become permanent; the *Washington Post* profiled "Radio LaRouche" (WTRI-1520), affiliated with the controversial Lyndon LaRouche.

**10 years ago:** From the Jan. 7, 2002 *DX News*: The 21-page report on the November 2001 Newfoundland DXpedition highlighted a 72-page issue, including loggings from Bolivia, India, and Lesotho.

## CONSTRUCTION PERMITS ON THE AIR

- 1060 WQOM MA Natick – CP for U4 5000/2500 is on the air. Formerly a two-site operation, this action, in addition to increasing the day power, consolidates the day and night transmitter locations to the former night site at 42-14-50/ 71-25-31. The new day pattern has been adjusted from heading to the northeast to directly eastward.
- 1230 WGUY ME Veazie – Is now on the air with U1 1000/640, after moving from 1240 kHz.
- 1440 WKPR MI Kalamazoo – Is now on the air with U1 2700/24, after moving from 1420 kHz.
- 1570 WECU NC Winterville – CP for U1 8000/200 is now on.

- 1170 WFDL WI **Waupun** – 12/13 1735 – Faded up just long enough to catch local news and multiple mentions of Fond du Lac. (RR-IL)
- 1180 WHAM NY **Rochester** – 12/13 1846 – Out of telephone interview; “We’ll be right back with the trivia question. This is Eleven-Eighty WHAM in Rochester New York” Into commercial for News Radio WHAM. (JDS-MN)
- 1190 KQQZ MO **Desoto** – 12/13 1753 – Poor; KQQZ jingle; in/out with KPHN & ???. No WOWO. Old C&W music. (JJR-WI)
- 1190 KPHN MO **Kansas City** – 12/13 1756 – Poor but steady with Radio Disney. Sat thru 4 minutes of promos, etc. and got local ID. (JJR-WI) All good things come to he who waits. (JDT-WA)
- 1210 WPHT PA **Philadelphia** – 12/14 2003 – Out of CBS news, into weather forecast ending with: “I’m meteorologist Kate Bilo on News Talk radio Twelve-Ten WPHT;” followed by commercials including The Jewelry Exchange in Norristown. (JDS-MN)
- 1230 KFJB IA **Marshalltown** – 12/15 0552 – Poor, though heard clear call letters. Used to be more common. ESPN sports. (JJR-WI)
- 1240 KPOD CA **Crescent City** – 12/7 0932 – Program note for Sports Wrap weekdays;” around 2:15;” two or three call letter ID’s before fading at 0933. A new one here and my all-time furthest graveyard frequency logging at 1059 miles! (JW-CO)
- 1240 KJCR MT **Billings** – 12/7 0830 – Catholic Mass to 0853, then short features and program notes from EWTN. Up and down signal; parallel to and about 1/2 second behind semi-local KPIO-1570. A new one here, Montana #31. Noted next day around the same time; ID’s as “KJCR Billings Catholic Radio”. (JW-CO)

- 940.2 unID NOV 30 2330 – Suspected Latin American carrier on high side of channel (not to be confused with Mexico on low side). [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 950 **CUBA** *R.Reloj*, two sites NOV 30 2330 – Reloj program in jumble with CKNB, WIBX, WROL, and WPEN mash-up. DEC 1 0302 – Reloj ticking and talking; with WPEN, others. [Connelly\*Y-MA] DEC 11 0145 – Fair in mess. Time ticks, beep, and "RR" in code heard. [Knight-CO]
- 960 **CUBA** *R.Reloj*, Guantánamo DEC 1 0000 – Reloj newstalk; mixed with unID Spanish-language music and WELI, WEAV, WHYL, WTGM mess. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 980 **CUBA** *R.Reloj*, Moa DEC 1 0250 – *R.Reloj* program; mixed with second Spanish-language station (usual WCAP/WOFX nulled to oblivion). [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 990 **MEXICO** XEID *R.Alamo*, Alamo, Ver. DEC 11 1207 – Tune-in to kiddie choral Veracruz state anthem (presumably having followed the Mexican anthem), male at 1209, clearly mentioning "megahertz" (an FM simulcast or affiliate I presume, though none listed on Fred Cantú's site) and mention of Veracruz. - 1050 **MEXICO** XED *Radiatora Siglo 21*, Mexicali, BC DEC 23 1400 – XE anthem; full ID at 1402, then ranchera-type music, with a canned slogan after each selection; tuned out at 1411. Generally fair, mixing with KTBL New Mexico. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1060 **CUBA** *Radio 26*, Jovellanos DEC 1 0300 – Woman in Spanish mentioned events in Cuban cities and a local musician, man gave *R.Vientiseis* ID and mentioned Matanzas; over KYW. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1060 **MEXICO** XEEP *R.Educación*, México DF DEC 21 0600 – Under KYW; choral national anthem. [Conti-NH]
- 1070 **COLOMBIA** HJCG *R.Santa Fe*, Bogotá DEC 1 0202 – *R.Santa Fe* jingle, man in Spanish mentioned Bogotá; over mess. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1070 unID DEC 11 0409-0417 – Cubano music; not parallel 5025 *R.Rebelde*. On top of mess at times; LSB helps with IBOC interference. [Frodge-MI]
- 1090 **MEXICO** XEMCA *Radio 1090*, Pánuco, Ver. DEC 13 1202 – Kiddie version of the Veracruz state anthem in progress (seems to be the most popular rendition), male ID. [Krueger-FL]

- 1180 **CUBA** *R.Rebelde* synchros DEC 1 0000 – Political speech, bad synchro-echo (multiple delays to 2 sec.); loud / dominant. [Connelly\*Y-MA] DEC 11 – Spanish. Good signal, fútbol game parallel 5025 kHz shortwave. [Knight-CO]
- 1210.41 **UNITED STATES** WDGR Dahlonga GA DEC 21 0040 – Het on south antenna against 1210 WPHT, measured 1210.409 kHz. [Conti-NH] WDGR has been off frequency for several months and I've ID'ed it along with a couple of others. A distorted Korean gal says "WDGR Dahlonga." [Kazaross-IL]
- 1220 **BRAZIL** ZYJ458 *R.Globo*, Rio de Janeiro DEC 1 0159 – Reverberated Portuguese talk by two men; over WHKW. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1280 **BERMUDA** VSB2 Hamilton DEC 1 0159 – Hymn; over WFAU, others. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1290 **VENEZUELA** YVLF *R.Puerto Cabello*, Puerto Cabello DEC 1 0159 – Venezuela adverts in Spanish talk; over WRNI. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1370 **MEXICO** XEHG *R.Romántica 1370*, Mexicali, BC DEC 18 1401 – National anthem, followed at 1403 by ID, slogan, time check for "6:03" and then XE music. Fair/poor with a noisy band today. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1500 **VENEZUELA** YVRZ *R.Dos Mil*, Cumana DEC 1 0202 – Venezuela items in Spanish newstalk; over WFED. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1610 **ANGUILLA** *Caribbean Beacon*, The Valley DEC 1 0003 – Male preacher quoting Leviticus 17:11; alone on channel over low-pitched het. [Connelly\*Y-MA]
- 1620 **CUBA** *R.Progreso*, unknown site DEC 1 0003 – *R.Progreso* ID, music; mixed evenly with Rebelde talkers. [Connelly\*Y-MA]

## NOAA Space Weather Outlook

Issued December 20 – For the period December 21, 2011-January 16, 2012

Solar activity is expected to be at low levels during the period.

No proton events are expected at geosynchronous orbit.

The greater than 2 MeV electron flux at geosynchronous orbit is expected to be at normal to moderate levels during the period.

Geomagnetic field activity is expected to be at quiet levels during December 21-27. Activity is expected to increase to quiet to unsettled levels during December 28-29 and January 5-6 due to recurrent coronal hole high-speed streams. Quiet levels will prevail December 30-January 4 and January 7-16.
