THE DX TIME MACHINE

75 years ago: From the Mar. 3, 1937 *DX News*: Carleton Lord, DX Editor of Radex, defended the controversial policy of charging ten cents for entries in Radex's Mystery DX contest; KFUD-550 St. Louis, one of the few church-owned stations still in existence, wants DX reports to bolster its legal fight against KSD to stay on 550.

50 years ago: From the Mar. 3, 1962 *DX News*: Carl Dabelstein of Omaha, Neb. was among 9 new NRC members this week; press reports indicated that the Mexican government was cancelling the license of XERF-1570.

25 years ago: From the Mar. 2, 1987 *DX News*: The FCC proposed new call letter rules that would abolish the K/W west/east distinction and allow unrelated AM, FM, and TV stations to use the same 4-letter call signs.

10 years ago: From the Mar. 4, 2002 *DX News*: The plans of KRKO-1380 Everett WA to increase power and build an 8-tower array were causing local controversy; Ben Dangerfield reported that the most consistent TAs these days were Slovakia-1098 and Croatia-1134, plus of course Saudi Arabia-1521.

CPs ON THE AIR

1080 KFXX OR Portland – Is now on the air with U4 50000/9000.

ACTIONS

570 CFWH YT Whitehorse – The CRTC has extended the time limit to move to 94.5 MHz to 27 October 2012.

590 WLVA VA Lynchburg – Licensed for U4 5000/1000 on 580 kHz, WLVA has a CP to move to 590 with U1 250/14 and have been silent since July 2011. This action requests a continuance while they prepare for Program Test Authority.

680 WPTF NC Raleigh – Is back to U2 50000/50000 operation after temporarily being U1 50000/10000 (incorrectly reported as 50000 nights in a previous issue as the application did not specify). They were installing di-plexing equipment in order to accommodate WFNL-570 Raleigh.

900 KALI CA West Covina – Licensed for U4 500/79, KALI had a CP for U4 5000/79, then applied for U4 5000/150, which has been approved. The station is being relocated to the transmitter site of KAHZ-1600 at 34-01-48/117-43-35.

900 CKMO BC Victoria – Will go silent on March 4, 2012 and move its activities entirely onto its “digital distribution platform” (streaming on the Internet).

1060 KFOY NV Sparks – This new station, not yet on the air, had a CP for U2 15000/370. They amended the application to U2 10000/250, which has been granted.

1350 CP QC Gatineau – The CRTC has extended the time limit to commence operations of the new transmitter here, to rebroadcast CIRA-FM Montréal to September 23, 2012. The new station will be U1 1000/180.

1550 WZRK WI Lake Geneva – Has filed for a Special Temporary Authorization to remain silent as thieves have allegedly stolen copper ground radials. The application requests silence for ‘several months’. WZRK continues to have a CP to move to Northbrook, Illinois with D1 1500/0.

CUBA: Dec. 9, 2010, *TV Yumurí* (Matanzas provincial TV station) informed that RadioCuba has improved the reception quality of *R.Rebelde* and *R.Reloj* thanks to the reopening of the Bolondrón transmitter site. This site was damaged in 2001 by hurricane Michell. There is a video

showing this "new" CTOM but unfortunately there is no info about the frequencies in use from this reopened installation. In old listings the Bolondrón site is on 910 for *R.Relej*. CUBA: Jan. 17, 2011, Radio Cubana reports a new *R.Progreso* transmitter will be shortly on the air from the La Palma CTOM (Centro Transmisor de Onda Media). The whole installation has been rebuilt and a new 70-m tower has been erected to serve 710 *R.Guamá*, 1180 *R.Rebelde* (already in operation at time of writing) and now *R.Progreso*. No frequency is mentioned but perhaps the new unID *R.Progreso* reported on 1230 from early 2011? INDIA: All India Radio (AIR) digitalization program was discussed at the 18th Annual Broadcast Engineering Society of India conference in New Delhi. According to AIR Additional Director General Mr. Yogendra Pal, two 1000 kW MW transmitters at Rajkot and Kolkata are likely to be operational by March 2012, and the rest of the 72 DRM transmitters would be commissioned between June 2012 to March 2013. The ongoing roll-out by AIR spurred the interest of receiver manufacturers who were present at the event with their products. DRM member companies Nautel, RFmondial, Digidia, Fraunhofer, Harris and Thomson attended the BES conference. [www.drm.org]

PAKISTAN: Regarding an inquiry to *R.Pakistan* about the new 100 kW Turbat transmitter reported last week, Mubasher Majoka, Spokesman PBC, replied, "Thank you for message showing interest in Radio Pakistan. The newly inaugurated transmitter at Turbat broadcasts programmes at frequency **981 kHz** from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily. It will be fully operational soon after some technical adjustments." [Conti]

UKRAINE: The National Radio Company of Ukraine (NRCU) plans to continue broadcasting on medium wave with the help of DRM transmitters. Two channels of Ukrainian radio will go on medium wave with new DRM digital radio transmitters; this was stated by the Chairman of the State committee for television and radio broadcasting Alexander Kurdinovich in an interview to Telekritika. "Taking into account that the National radio company does not have a systematic network for FM-broadcasting and will not have it due to the lack of frequency resources, and the insane competition with commercial broadcasters, it was decided to transfer a minimum of two programs of the NRCU to broadcasts on medium wave," he explained. "It is a question of purchasing 15-16 modern digital radio transmitters DRM-format, which can work in both digital and analogue radio broadcasting. By placing them on the whole territory of Ukraine, we will be able to provide access to the National radio of at least 85-90% of the population," noted Mr. Kurdinovich. Documentation for the DRM upgrade is submitted to government officials and awaits funding. [www.drm.org, www.telekritika.ua]

No proton events are expected at geosynchronous orbit.

The greater than 2 MeV electron flux at geosynchronous orbit is expected to be at low to moderate levels.

Geomagnetic field activity is expected to be at mostly quiet levels throughout the period, with the exception of any currently unanticipated future coronal mass ejection events. Increased field activity due to recurrent disturbances is expected on February 18-19, February 23, March 2-3, and March 7.
