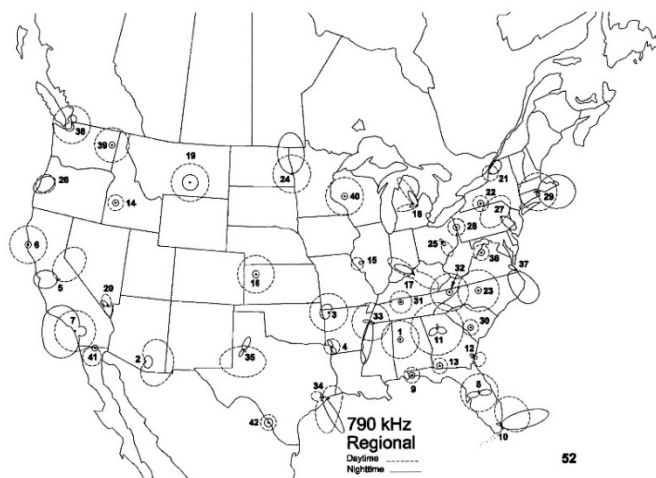

DEC 11 0627 – Mainly Europeans, but the first one I check is 846 which at this hour I expect to be from *R.Kiribati*. [Hauser-OK]

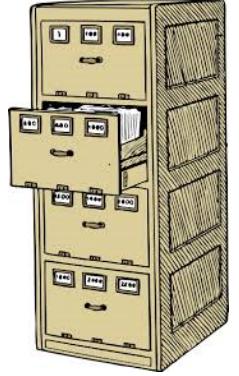

10 Years Ago – From the October 2, 2008 issue of *DX News*: 1540 WSIV NY East Syracuse - Licensed for U1 1000/57, WSIV applies to move to the #2 tower of WOLF-1490's 2-tower array as U1 1000/57 CH 1000, adding the CH designation. WOLF has a pending application to go U1, using tower #1 only. That would leave tower #2 'vacant' and available for WSIV's use. Tower #1 is also being proposed as the daytime tower for the new WVOA-720 Dewitt, New York, di-plexed with WOLF. (The current WSIV web page, proclaims "This Gospel Radio Station is the Inspirational Voice of Syracuse.....WSIV AM 1540.")

25 Years Ago – In the October 11, 1993 issue of *DX News*, from Bill Hale's Domestic DX Digest Special: "Every year about this time, Jerry Coatsworth from Merlin, Ontario sends in his results from the past DX season's DX Tests, set up by the NRC or JRCA CPCs. At least we hear from him once a year, hi. Jerry's rig is a JRC NRD-525 sometimes correctly hooked to a Realistic CTR-69 tape machine + a 30 foot wire lying on his roof, except the one test heard in the car. Compare Jerry's test loggings with those in your log." (The Japan Radio Company NRD-525 came after two other models the NRD-505 and NRD-515.)

50 Years Ago – In the October 5, 1968 issue of *DX News*, we find: "NEXT ISSUE OCTOBER 19. Then, weekly once again. Deadline in Brooklyn for Musings is Tuesday, 10/15. [Front page cut in Boston this time only 'cause ERC couldn't find a single store in NYC selling stencils on Yom Kippur – send info on specials, etc. directly-to ERC from now on. Admiral Nelson]."

75 Years Ago – In the September 18, 1943 issue of *DX News*, World War II was raging and DXing Europe from the USA was interesting: 11670.... Radio National Belge testing at 6:30PM with a program for North America in English, strength was phenomenal. They requested listeners to send reports of reception to Belgian National Radio Service-247 Park Ave-New York City. (Coryell-Jones and Roy Christoph).

Solar activity is expected to be very low throughout the outlook period.

No proton events are expected at geosynchronous orbit.

The greater than 2 MeV electron flux at geosynchronous orbit is expected to reach moderate levels on 10-16 Dec and 03-05 Jan with normal flux levels expected for the remainder of the outlook period.

Geomagnetic field activity is expected to reach active levels on 10 Dec and 29 Dec due to coronal hole/high speed stream effects. Quiet or quiet to unsettled conditions are expected throughout the remainder of the outlook period.
