Except when I get swamped with work, as happened last weekend – sorry about that. Both of these used to be distributed on the e-DXN.com bulletin board, which is no longer operational. You can opt for an electronic-only membership, a print-version membership, or both.

FCC License Renewals: All AM and FM stations have license renewals due between this year and 2022. The application is due four months before the license expires. Stations in DC, MD, VA, and WV had applications due June 3 (for licenses expiring October 1), and we already saw two licenses cancelled for failure to submit a renewal application. Next up: NC/SC (were due Aug. 1); FL, PR, and USVI (were due Oct. 1); and AL/GA (due Dec. 2). Will more stations be going dark soon? Stay tuned!

Promo for a Bill O'Reilly appearance at Mesa Arts Center contained a KFYI mention. Another unID ad had a 'Camelback Road' mention. KUZZ mixing in at times. **(SB-CA)**
- **550 KFYR** ND Bismarck 10/8 0716 Poor, with 'Phil Parker Show'. "Rush Limbaugh at 11 on K-Fire". Through WSAU. (JJR-MI)
- **560 KLZ CO Denver 10/8 0714 –** Poor, with '. . . how to advertise on KLZ'. Promo for a show 3-7 on KLZ 560. With others. (JJR-MI)
- **580 KSAZ AZ Marana 10/16 0214-0220 –** Very good, with mix of Spanish-language Christian music. 'Radio Casa' and 'Arizona' mentions between songs. No sign of KMJ, listed at 390 watts nights, but suspect they were running 5 kW day power. **(SB-CA)**
- **580 KIDO ID Nampa 10/9 0721 –** Fair. Solid, steady and clear! "KIDO -107.5 FM and 580 AM", PSA for 'MercyShips.org'. (JJR-MI) . . . again the next day . . .

- **580 KIDO ID Nampa 10/10 0700 –** Poor, with 'Jim Bohannon' from WW1. Fade (of course), LID, Dave Anthony on Fox News. (JJR-MI)
- **580 KJMJ LA Alexandria 10/12 0712** Woman wailing "Holy Mary, Mother of God . . ." briefly in co-channel. Presume KJMJ, a Radio Maria (Catholic) net affiliate. **(TK-FL)**
- 620 CKRM SK Regina 10/9 0757 Poor, though solid, with C&W and calls, in WTMJ null. (JJR-MI)
- 630 KVMA AR Magnolia 10/17 0631 Stampeders, Mamas & the Papas, Jackson Browne, Berlin, Phil Collins across the hour and lost at 0708 to KYFI. Unidentified until October 19, good signal at times with male canned liners after almost every song, such as "You love Classic Hits, KVMA". One short break at 0714 with 'GEICO' and a life insurance company spots. Mentions an FM on some of the liners, presumably 107.1 K296FC. Holding up until about 0750 daily, but some KYFI co-channel after 0700. The Wiki entry wrongly appends their C&W sister station KVMZ (as) "Magnolia's Country 99.1" streaming link. Surely running 1000 Watts overnight and not the 30 Watts they're supposed to be at. Magnolia is just across the Louisiana border. (TK-FL)
- 630 KYFI MO St. Louis 10/17 0708 Jack Handey-like man with inspirational thoughts, slow traditional Christian vocals and piano instrumental, same man back with a "forgiveness" lament. Into Moody Church block programming at 0730. Parallel Bible Broadcasting Network via station website stream. (TK-FL)
- **630 CHED AB Edmonton 10/9 0717 –** Poor, with "630 Ched.com jet away getaway" contest. WREY nulled, and not a factor. (JJR-MI)
- **640 KFI CA Los Angeles 10/18 0824 –** Poor; woman with news story, 'I Heart Key Word for \$1000. Not WOI, hi. (JJR-MI)
- **640 KWPN OK Moore 10/9 0717 –** Poor, with ad for 'Bob Howard dealership', 'My Blue', 'Visit Oklahoma City'. "ESPN 640" over WOI for a bit. (JJR-MI)
- **660 KCRO** NE Omaha 10/11 0729 Poor, in/out, with WMIC-MI. Calls, icluding 106.7 mention after REL show. (JJR-MI)

- 770 WLWL NC Rockingham 10/9 0706 'Double Bogey Blues' by Mickey Jones, male DJ, into 'We're Gonna Boogie' by Barbara Carr. Apparently a 'bogey/boogie' set. Then spots for the upcoming 'Carolina Beach Music Awards' at the Alabama Theatre, North Myrtle Beach, followed by 'Monroe's Small Engine Repair' and "The Big Wave Radio" slogan. (TK-FL)
- 770 KTTH WA Seattle 10/9 0746 Poor, with ads, 'Rush Morning Update', 'LifeLock' ad. Lost. Have written station. Third person wrote back, and it <u>was</u> KTTH! Nice to the west – again (KATL, CHQR yesterday)! NEW! (JJR-MI)
- **770 CHQR AB Calgary 10/8 0705 –** Poor no WABC. Canadian elections, n ews by woman; Global News. Rare! (JJR-MI)

Jim speaks: Last November in Newfoundland resulted in a lifetime's worth of Perseus files to review. This is added to the files still being reviewed as far back as 2011. On the home front I am learning that the invasive ash borer is killing my ash trees. That helps replenish the wood pile, but those ash trees are what hold up my Kaz antenna, nicely directional to Europe. My tree expert predicts that the ash trees can remain in place for a few years after they die, but eventually they will have to come down. Stephen speaks: Transatlantic conditions OCT 14 0300+ seemed very good. Many signals blasting in at levels comparable to local stations. 855 Spain, 693 and 1215 UK were at outstanding strength. A new country for me was Turkey on 954 kHz. Sylvain Naud in Quebec had the same signal at the same time per Facebook post.

- MEXICO unID OCT 16 0604 Colchón (mattress) ad in Spanish, keeps going past 0609, an 1090 infomercial and mentions being a TV offer. Roughly south with KAAY nulled at first during its dead air. Anyhow, no sign of KEXS 10 kW daytimer which had been all-nightly for quite a while. The Spanish is most likely XEAU Monterrey, or maybe XEWL Nuevo Laredo, Tamps., but neither is supposed to be on now per sked in IRCA Mexican Log: XEAU until 0600, XEWL until 0200; even allowing for DST, Mex skeds are notoriously unreliable. OCT 17 0603 - That mattress infomercial in Spanish again plugging how wonderful it is for your spine, etc., maybe runs every night at this time for those who can't sleep; from the south, so likely XEAU Monterrey; bothered by 1089 transatlantic het, but 1090 KAAY pretty much nulled. I really need to tune in a bit earlier for an ID. OCT 19 0502 - Tonight I'm tuning an hour earlier to get a head start before the mattress TV infomercial I've been hearing after 0600 - but it's already running now! And I've missed another top of the hour ID, if any. Maybe all-mattress all the time? Or late for those who can't sleep well on their awful mattresses. La Voz del Colchón, or Radio Colchón Internacional? I continue to think it's XEAU Monterrey. KAAY off the side must be nulled, and hope there be no KEXS or anything else closer to the axis. But there is still that transatlantic carrier pest on 1089, or really the seven UK TalkSport synchros adding up to 722 kW - not including the 0 kW from the one in the Chunnel. [Hauser-OK]
- 1130 **MEXICO** unID OCT 14 0555 Tropical music from southwest/northeast, as KWKH Shreveport is unusually weak and easily nulled. Spanish on this frequency unusual; 0557 UTC time check for 12:57, so in UTC-5 CDT zone same as here, but no ID copied as KWKH resurges by 0600. Closest Mexi direction would be XEHN Nogales, Sonora but UTC-7. IRCA Mexican Log has two other iffies in Guanajuato, Michoacán, leaving the most likely, although really more south/southwest from here, but in correct time zone: XECHAP *R.Chapingo* CP

(2017) for 1610 XEUACH to move here replacing XETOL which moved to FM. Station web site 8/19 said transmissions will start on 1130 kHz (daytime only 1300-0100) on 10/4/2019. OCT 16 0556 - Spanish past 0600, nulling KWKH favors southwest, but now peaking this signal at south/southwest, further pointing to the new XECHAP. OCT 19 0601 - Not much can be extracted with KWKH nulled as much as possible, but think I hear "Radio Activa" which may or may not be an ID slogan. Trying to nail down a definite XECHAP, new station supposed to have just started. [Hauser-OK]

- 1140 **MEXICO** unID OCT 7 0358-0402 Poor signal. Choral Mexican national anthem under WRVA. Likely XEMR. [Knight-PA]
- 1350 **MEXICO** XELBL San Luis Rio Colorado, Son. OCT 14 1300 Música romántica to 1303, then partially readable ID mentioning call letters, slogan ("Radio Centro") and other info including address, which sounded the same as always, i.e. at the corner of Av. Kino and Calle 5, where they've been for decades. Prayer usually follows the anthem. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1420 **MEXICO** XEXX Tijuana, BC OCT 11 1258 Programming notes from TuDN (the reincarnation of ESPN Deportes), followed by a short version of national anthem right at 1300; signal faded before the anthem was over so missed the ID, if there was one. Also heard on other occasions with similar programming around the same time but always rough reception here. On NOV 12 the anthem was not played until 1310 UTC. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1510 **MEXICO** XEQI *Opus 1510*, Monterrey, NL OCT 10 1038 Continuous classical string and woodwind until quick female ID at 1100, but they refused to honor their nation at the 1100 mark with the anthem, instead back to classical music. WLAC mostly nulled. [Krueger-FL]
- 1620 **CUBA** *R.Rebelde*, La Habana-El Sapo//Amancio//El Coco//Guantánamo-Antiguo OCT 6 0046 - Music I figure is *R.Rebelde*, immediately confirmed by parallel 5025 but latter is distorted, so better on 1620 despite some co-channel interference and fading. Something's always wrong at RadioCuba. [Hauser-OK]

TRANS-PACIFIC DX

Transpacific carrier search: OCT 11 1158 - Before LSR of 1235 UTC; first check at 1158 on 774 finds a good one from the northwest. At 1204-1223, bandscan on the DX-398, so I can DF whether northwest from East Asia or west/southwest from Australia/New Zealand+. Some without an angle were too weak to tell, or more likely an even mix of both. In some cases a beat could be heard between stations a few Hz apart (2). From northwest 594, 612, 693, 747, 756, 774, 828, 864, 873, 945, 972, 1044, 1053, 1116, 1134, 1197, 1287, 1314, 1332, 1557, 1566 kHz. From west/southwest 792(2), 1035, 1098 (west), and 1422 kHz. There could have been even more, obscured by splash from North Americans 1 or 2 kHz away. Too weak to tell or mix 603, 657, 702(2), 837, 882(2), 1125(2), 1143 kHz. At 1232 I switch to the R75 with east-west long wire, so no DF'ing but a bit more gain: 774 has trace of Japanese audio. Then sweep at 1234-1240, JBA carriers on 891, 882, 873, 864, 846, 837, 828, 774, 756, 747, 738, 729, 702(2), 693, 666, 657, 612, 594, 567, 558; this spanned LSR 1235, until 1238 UTC. Also after sunrise 1125, 1134, 1143, 1566 kHz at 1240 UTC. OCT 16 1215 - On the DX-398 for DF'ing, and wow, are there lots of them. 747 and 774 are strong enough to detect some talk by woman voice, but will not assume Japanese, since could be during NHK language lesson. 558, 567(2), 585, 594, 603, 612, 621, 657(2), 666, 675, 693, 702(2), 711, 729, 738, 747, 756, 765(2), 774 kHz. Now from 1226 UTC, upward from 774 kHz; 792, 828, 837, 846, 864, 873, 882, 891, 918, 972, 981, 1017, 1035, 1044, 1053, 1098, 1134, 1143, 1197, 1206, 1287, 1296, 1331, 1413, 1422, 1476, 1503, 1548, 1566 kHz, until 1241 UTC. 1206 was noticeably offfrequency-minus. MWoffsets suggests 1205.96 China, Yanbian RGD Korean News General. OCT 18 1244 - I'm on 1566 from the northwest to observe a signal drop when HLAZ used to change beams from thisaway to thataway, but it seems about the same with a little fading. Oh, I must have misremembered, as WRTH shows the switch from Japanese to Chinese is at 1345, not 1245. For that we'll have to wait for later sunrise here, close to 1345 around Epiphany. [Hauser-OK]





75 Years Ago – From the October 28, 1944 issue of *DX News*: Some stations reported by Henry Wilinson in Baltimore, Md., were TGW-640 Guatemala and 1YA-650 New Zealand, for the first time since the 1938-39 season. Fourteen stations are scheduled to run DX tests in November, including the first 50 kW station in several years, KWBU-1010 Corpus Christi TX.

50 Years Ago – From the October 25, 1969 issue of *DX* News: Richard Wood compared reception at two different points on Oahu Island, with very different stations audible on the western and eastern shores of the island. Russ Edmunds gave some pointers for constructing the FET altazimuth loop that members have recently been discussing. Dick Truax reported 36 new stations, mostly from the huge aurora that began on September 29, to bring his total to 859 stations heard.



25 Years Ago – From the October 31, 1994 issue of *DX News*: M Street Journal reports that there are 88 outstanding CPs for new AM radio stations and 277 licensed AM stations that are silent – the corresponding numbers today are 10 and 87, respectively. Ken MacHarg launched the first "Confirmed DXer" column, today edited by Phil Bytheway. The Albanian state broadcaster complained about a new planned Dutch all-news station on 1395 kHz, which would interfere with its lucrative relays of TWR, VOA, and BBC on that channel.

10 Years Ago – From the October 26, 2009 issue of *DX News*: Two longtime NRC members, Relfe Luton and Joe Kureth, recently passed away. Gary DeBock reviewed the Tecsun PL-310 AM-FM-SW-LW receiver. WVMC-1360 Mount Carmel IL was reported as silent – see this issue's AM Switch for more! Neil Kazaross reported his first Japanese stations in Illinois, NHK on 693 and 747.


NRC Antenna Pattern Book 8th Edition
