

Broadcasting studios at Calgary, Edmonton and Red Deer. Broadcasting station at Red Deer.





An interior view of the Alberta Pacific Radio Station CKIC, at Red Deer, showing the line amplifier microphone control panel at the left, and in front of the desk the 2,000 watt transmitter panel, on which can be identified behind the small window, the two 50 watt power amplifier tubes, and on the front of the panel the four 1,000 watt tubes. In an adjoining room is located the motor generator equipment, batteries, work shop and test rooms. The location of this plant is the highest spot in the vicinity of Red Deer, Alberta, and the huge 200-foot steel towers supporting the antennae may be seen for miles in all directions.
