Here is the verification of your reception of WAYR on Dec. 20 - 1960. Sorry to have been so late, but did not have one to write the answer.

The programming you heard was 100% correct. This station is owned and operated by Mr. Dan Richardson, a Minister of the Gospel. It is 1,000 watts power at present, hoping to increase to 5,000 soon. It is located near the town of Orange Park, which is about 15 miles south of Jacksonville, Florida. The transmitter is a Collins 5KW. The antenna is a vertical non directional tower, 308' in height. The coverage is very good considering the power. On preliminary tests before regular broadcast went on the air, we heard from as far as Iowa, Canada, Pennsylvania, and other distance places. As you gathered the programming is mainly Christian, and Religious Music and Messages. We have a good music section in early afternoon, but for the most part it is Religious programs.

Orange Park is the home of the Retired members of the "Moose" called "MooseHaven".

Total population is about 4,000.
