## Executive Summary

## General statistics

- APRs are at $15.43 \%$, down $2 \%$ from 1998's $15.78 \%$ and $12 \%$ lower in the last 10 years-page 2.
- National FM Share is now 78.91\%, up from last year's 78.45\%—page 3.
- The average market's Time Spent Listening is now 20.50 hours, down from 1998 's 21 hours—page 4.
- $13.1 \%$ of listening in the average market is to "below-the-line" (not home to the market) stations, slightly lower than last year's $13.2 \%$-page 5 .
- Unlisted Listening in the average market is 13.5\%, slightly higher than 1998's 13.1\%—page 5.
- Diary return rates are down again. Spring 1999's $51.0 \%$ is a disturbing decrease from last year—page 27.


## New research into America's Most Listened-To Stations

- Collectively, 39 groups own 541 of America's 600 most-listened-to radio stations (based on 12+ TSA AQH for Spring 1999). Duncan's examined ownership and ratings information (for TSA AQH 12+) to rank America's 600 Most Listened-To Stations-page 6.
- Together, Clear Channel and AMFM own more of those stations than any other radio group-208. Separately, Clear Channel owns 98 of these 600 stations and AMFM holds 110.
- Only CBS/Infinity comes close, owning 102.
- In third place is Entercom, with 32.


## Stations and Formats

- America's Most Listened-To Station is Emmis's Urban-formatted "Hot 97," WQHT-FM New York, garnering 143,400 persons $12+$ in the TSA in an average quarter hour-page 7.
- AOR/Classic Rock/New Rock is the most-popular format category nationally, attracting $14.88 \%$ of all identified radio listening. Black/Urban is second, at $11.65 \%$. CHR is third (11.07\%) and posted a substantial $11 \%$ increasepage 18.
- AOR/Classic Rock/New Rock is the most-popular format category for the Most Listened-To Stations; 102 of these 600 stations are in the format. Next in popularity is Country, with 78 of the stations-page 6.
- WHTZ-FM New York is the \#1 station in 12+ TSA Cume, with 2,536,000 listeners—page 13.
- WFGY-FM Altoona is the \#1 station in $12+$ Metro Share, with a 22.7 -page 15.
- WTHI-FM Terre Haute is the \#1 station in 12+ Metro Cume Rating, with a 38.6—page 17.


## Industry consolidation: Clustering breaks 70\%, but revenue share dips

Radio industry consolidation now encompasses over $70 \%$ of all listed stations in the 168 markets we studied. Last year, the figure was $67 \%$. Consolidated revenue has actually dropped a bit, from 1998's $83.8 \%$ to this year's $76.9 \%$. (For an explanation of the drop, see page 28.) Consolidated entities control only slightly more of the $12+$ and 25-54 audiences this year. In an average market, $61.4 \%$ of all $12+$ shares are attributable to consolidated stations, up from 1998's comparable 60.6\%. As for the $25-54$ demo, $63.3 \%$ of those shares are now going to consolidated stations, up from 1998's 62.2\%-page 28.

## Notes and Comments: APRs down 12\% over 10 years

APR is down again for the sixth straight year, from $15.78 \%$ to $15.43 \%$. This most-recent loss is the largest decline to date: a $2.2 \%$ erosion. Over the last decade, there has been a $12 \%$ drop in listenership, from $17.53 \%$ to $15.43 \%$. For obvious reasons, these consecutive decreases in overall usage continue to disturb us. As
was the case last year, the decreases are widespread. For instance, one of the best markets for APR, Miami, has had an APR decline from $18.9 \%$ in 1997, to $18.3 \%$ in 1998 to this year's $17.6 \%$. Last year's weakest APR market, Lafayette, IN (at 13.0\%) maintains that title, but at an even-lower APR of $12.1 \%$.

## Highest and Lowest Time Spent Listening

(Number of quarter-hours the average person spends listening during a specified time)
(Market average $=20.50$ )

TSL results generally mirror those of Average Persons Ratings. APR is a function of how many different people listen to radio and for how long; the latter is TSL. The highest TSL (this year, 24.50 hours in Sioux Falls) is even with last year's 24.50 hours registered in Wilkes Barre-Scranton. However, that number is below

1997's highest ( 25.00 hours in Lafayette, LA and Miami). The lowest ( 16.50 hours in Lafayette, $\mathbb{I N}$ ) is a full hour lower than 1998's lowest, 17.50 hours in Ann Arbor. Lafayette's 16.50 is also lower than the 17.25 hours posted in that market in Spring 1997. The average market's TSL to radio is 20.50 hours per week.

## Highest and Lowest Percentages of FM Listening

Listed FM stations' share of total listed listening, Metro average $1 / 4-h r$. persons $12+$, Mon-Sun, 6 AM-12 Midnight.

FM's share of listed-station listening continues to grow, this time up $0.6 \%$ to $78.911 \%$. That growth rate was a bit slower than 1998's $1.05 \%$ rate or the $1.19 \%$ gain of 1997 , but is right in line with the $0.57 \%$ gain of 1996 . This year's $78.911 \%$ continues a six-year streak of rate increases. FM's share generally is creeping up across
all markets, from those with the highest rate ( $95.99 \%$ this year: $95.98 \%$ last) to those with the lowest.

This year's single-market low was $65.47 \%$. Last year's lowest was $63.39 \%$. Both are well above the $61.01 \%$ low in Spring 1997.

## Notes and Comments

"Below the Line" Listening<br>(Listening to stations not home to the market)

As in the past, the markets with the highest levels of "below-theline" listening (listening to stations not home to the market) are not surprising: all are proximate to significantly larger markets. Changes are mixed. Ann Arbor's percentage of listening to outside stations decreased again this year, from 69.3\% in 1997 to $66.2 \%$ in 1998 to this year's $65.3 \%$. Out-of-market listening in Melbourne-Titusville rose again, from $51.2 \%$ in 1997 to $54.9 \%$ in 1998 to this year's $56.1 \%$. An average of $13.1 \%$ of all listening in a market is to outside stations.

## Unlisted Listening

(Either non-commercial station listening or listening to stations that don't meet Arbitron's Minimum Reporting Standards)
The average amount of listening to unlisted stations is up again, from $12.9 \%$ in 1997, to $13.1 \%$ last year, to $13.5 \%$ this year. Gainers and losers were evenly split four-to-four this year among the eight markets that reappeared on the list from 1998. In two casesAsheville and Lansing-this year's decreases follow on gains set the previous year, in 1998. Both markets, however, wind up with higher percentages of unlisted listening this year than they had back in 1997: The biggest increases in 1999 occurred in Ann Arbor ( $21.5 \%$ to $24.9 \%$ ) and Lancaster ( $18.5 \%$ to $20.0 \%$ ), followed by Tallahassee ( $21.3 \%$ to $22.0 \%$ ) and Austin ( $18.6 \%$ to $19.0 \%$ ). The biggest decreases were in Asheville ( $26.6 \%$ to $22.6 \%$ ) and Eugene-Springfield (23.6\% to 21.8\%), followed by Lansing (20.6\% to $19.5 \%$ ) and Raleigh-Durham ( $19.8 \%$ to $18.8 \%$ ). In 1998, the biggest increases occurred in Asheville (20.5\% to 26.6\%), Fort Pierce ( $18.9 \%$ to $21.9 \%$ ) and Lansing ( $18.4 \%$ to $20.6 \%$ ).

## America's Most Listened-to Radio Stations 1999 (12+ TSA AQH)

## An ownership profile and format breakdown for the top-600 stations

Collectively, 39 groups own 541 of America's 600 most-listened-to radio stations (based on 12+ TSA AQH for Spring 1999). The remaining 59 stations are owned individually or by other groups.

AOR/Classic Rock/New Rock is the most popular format group for these 600 stations, followed closely by Country, CHR and Black/Urban (see chart below).

## Changes in Format Percentages

CHR has reinvented itself yet again, posting a $10.7 \%$ gain in format share this year after 1998's 10\% gain. Religious/Gospel stations staged an impressive 16\% gain this year, after dropping a bit more than $4 \%$ in 1998. The growth in Sports has halted for the moment, down $0.5 \%$ for the year. The format category was up $11.4 \%$ in 1998, the best gain that year.

Country, Oldies and Classical recorded another year of declines. Last year, the shift in pairing of Easy Listening stations from Soft AC to Standards caused some decrease for Soft AC and a gain for Standards, but did not significantly affect the formats' results. This year is a different story: Standards/Easy Listening is down $10.5 \%$ in total quarter hours.

## Radio Consolidation 1999: Station clusters break 70\%, but revenue share dips

The most interesting part of this year's consolidation report found a dip in the average share of revenues accountable to consolidated operations-from just under $84 \%$ in Spring 1998 to about $77 \%$ this year.

Part of the reason can be seen in the mega-mergers that require spinning off entire clusters of stations. In Cleveland, for example, where the merger of Clear Channel and Jacor required the spinoff of stations previously owned by each group individually; divesting WENZ-FM, WERE-AM and WNCX-FM represented $12.5 \%$ of Cleveland $\$ 88$ Million in ad revenues. That type of dropoff may happen again in the market, since Clear Channel's acquisition of AMFM will require the shedding of more consolidated stations.

There's a different story in Augusta, GA, where four consolidated operators, which had divided $100 \%$ of the market's ad revenue, saw their combined share drop to $88.8 \%$. Part of the reason for the drop here is that Duncan's
has added several more independently-owned stations to our tally of the market's highest billing stations.

Radio industry consolidation now encompasses 70.9\% of all rated-market stations, or 2,413 of the 3,396 stations covered in our Spring 1999 Ratings Report. In our previous Spring Report, 2,255 of a surveyed 3,365 stations, or $67.0 \%$, were owned or operated as part of a consolidated market entity.

This year's consolidation report tracked revenue figures for 152 markets for which Duncan's had data available, two markets more than last year. There were 77 markets where consolidated revenue shares went down, 70 where revenue shares went up, two markets with no change (Binghamton at $92.5 \%$ and Birmingham at $93.8 \%$ ) and three with either no revenue figures available or with no previous duopoly consolidation (Erie, Lafayette, Ind. and Worcester; all three are now heavily consolidated).

This is a new table, offered as a means of tracking the incidence of station/owner concentration. Its data are based on the "Consolidation Report" found within each market (except Bridgeport and Worcester) in American Radio. Audience and numbers of stations data are based on 167 markets (excluding the embedded Nassau-Suffolk and San Jose markets and Bridgeport); revenue, on the 152 of those 167 markets for which revenue data are available.

The "Avg. \#, Entities" is the average number of multiopoly operations (minimum: two stations in a single band; single AM/single FM combinations do not count). "Avg. \#, Consolidated Stations" is the average number of stations contained within the multiopolies. "Avg. \# Total Stations" is the average number of listed stations home to the typical market. Adjustments have been made for stations within consolidated entities that do not qualify for listing in the Arbitron. "Consol. Stns. \% of Total" is the consolidated stations' per-
centage of that average number of total market stations.
This table is meant only to provide a snapshot of consolidation's effect on the typical market. Audience percentages are not adjusted to remove the impact of "below-the-line" or "non-listed station" listening, while by its very nature, the percentage of revenue is predominantly a "home-to-the-market" figure. However, we found the data interesting and important enough to include in this study.

In the average market, consolidated entities attracted $61.4 \%$ of 12+ AQH (average quarter-hour) audience and $63.3 \%$ of adults 25-54 AQH. Both figures are up from a year ago.

However these entities that once controlled $83.8 \%$ of the market's revenue, now control somewhat less, $76.9 \%$. For an explanation, see the article on this page, directly above the consolidation table. The typical market has three consolidated entities, which control 14 (of 20) market stations.
