
NOTES

Dynamic type loud speakers are used in all the console models with the exception of certain models made by the Acme Electric and Mfg. Company, Buckingham Radio Corporation, Federal Radio Co., Freed Eiseman Radio Corp., Chas. Freshman Co., and the United Reproducers Corp.

D.C. light socket operated and battery operated models are being made by Atwater Kent Mfg. Co., Day-Fan Electric Co., Freed Eiseman Radio Corp., Kolster Radio Corp., Sparks-Withington Co., Stewart Warner Corp., Radio-Victor Corp. of America, and the Crosley Radio Corp.







HOUSTON VINTAGE RADIO ASSOCIATION


