WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC was closed last Monday in observance of Memorial Day. The FCC closed again today (June 5th) due to a major fire in a downtown electrical vault. The lack of power gave most all FCC staff people the day off.

With all the talk lately of FCC backups and the lack of staff, four day work weeks will only add to the backlog of applications. Recent reports in the press have shed doubt on any FCC budget increases coming to the rescue, the money will be spent in other areas than relieving the application logjam.

For the second week in a row the Commission has fined a broadcast station and imposed reporting conditions for failing to live up to EEO plans and commitments. This time WROV in Roanoke, VA, has been fined \$5000 for not being able to prove any active effort to recruit minority and/or female employees. Out of 65 positions filled in the last seven years only seven positions used affirmative recruitment sources. If you have a EEO plan it might be a good idea to look it over and make sure you are complying with your commitments.

Knoxville Channel 8, LP and South Central Communications Corp. have been granted a waiver to allow them time for SSCC (one of the partners in Knoxville Channel 8, LP) to divest itself of WEZK(FM) at Knoxville, TN. The temporary waiver of the cross-ownership rules was granted for 18 months.

The FCC's grant of 870 KHz at Berlin, VT, to Harvest Broadcasting has been rescinded.

The Commission has approved the settle agreement between Anthony E. Trimbale (whose application was reinstated to allow him to participate in the settlement agreement), Peter Achilles Broikou, and Webster-Fuller Communications for a new FM at Webster, NY. Under the settlement agreement Trimbale and Broikou were both dismissed. The proceeding is now remanded to the ALJ for consideration of unresolved financial certification and qualification issues against Webster-Fuller.

A pirate broadcaster has been shut down in the Miami, FL, area. "La Voz de Alpha 66" had been operating on 6666.6 KHz, a frequency set aside for aeronautical enroute usage. The transmitter was located in a car and regularly changed positions.

The FCC also made the following decisions this past week:

**Affirmed** - The denial of Michael J. Benne's motion for disqualification of the presiding officer in the proceeding for a new FM at East Ridge, TN.

**Denied** - Kerr County Broadcasting and G&C Minority Communications review of its decision upholding a Mass Media Bureau action returning their applications as unacceptable for filling.

**Upheld** - The dismissing of Benjamin Macwan's application for a new FM at Rayne, LA, and returning as unacceptable for filing the application of Life FM Partnership for the same facility.

Denied - Review of a decision by the Review Board affirming ALJ Stitmer's dismissal of the application of Silver Springs Broadcasting, Inc. for a new FM at Silver Spring, FL.

Denied - RAM Communications, Inc.'s request for review of the Mass Media Bureau's action granting Appalachian Educational Communication Corp.'s application for a license to cover the CP for WHCB(FM) at Bristol, TN.

Upheld - The returning of R.A.D. Broadcasting Corporation's application for a new FM at Sturtevant, WI.

Denied - The request of Mount Wilson FM Broadcasters, Inc.'s for a stay of the proceeding on the applications for 104.9 MHz at San Clemente, CA, pending resolution of its court appeal.

In format news Transtar is now distributing CNN, Headline News to radio stations on a full time basis. Transtar had been offering portions of CNN as a news network. The new service will allow stations to use as much or as little of the programming as they wish. As we have reported here in M Street several stations have already switched to a full time news format based around Headline News.

A new news and sports network has been announced for Pennsylvania. Pennsylvania Radio, Inc. will launch its new service later this month with approximately 60 affiliates. The principals in Pennsylvania Radio, Inc. had made a unsuccessful offer for the now silent Pennsylvania network which went off the air last March with 68 affiliates.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Do to the power outage last Monday (June 5) the FCC was closed. Items that were dated or to be released Monday were released on Tuesday (June 6).

The Commission has again placed restrictions on a license for failure to live up to the FCC's EEO provisions. Beasley Broadcasting of South Carolina, Inc. was issued a notice of Apparent Liability for \$3000 and will be required to make periodic reports on EEO matters to the Commission.

The FCC has granted the request by Northern Sound Public Radio for a waiver to construct a new noncommercial FM station on 91.7 MHz at Bellingham, WA. Due to allocation problems with Canada 91.7 was found to have the least amount of possible interference. Northern Sound and the FCC agree that despite problems with any frequency in Bellingham 91.7 would be the best choice.

The Commission has denied the National Black Media Coalition and it's New York affiliate, National Black Coalition, reconsideration of it's Report and Order deleting the non-technical AM applications acceptance criteria from its rules. The deleted provisions required that proposals for new AM stations or major changes in existing stations could only be accepted if the proposal was designed to serve underserved areas or communities.

The Commission released a public notice this week advising stations to comply with FCC rules pertaining to tower marking and lighting. It is a good idea to check if your station is in compliance with the rules. If your tower lights should go out notify the local FAA flight service station within 30 minutes.

A settlement agreement has been approved for St. Simons Island, GA (92.7 A). Under the terms of the agreement, James U. Steele will dismiss his application with prejudice and withdraw his court appeal, thereby allowing the Commission's 1984 decision granting the application of Dale Bell to become final. As part of the settlement Steele will receive \$300,000.

The FCC affirmed the staff action granting Tri-Valley Broadcasting Company's station WYRY-FM, Hinsdale, NH, a waiver of the short-spacing rule, over the objection of WXLO-FM, Fitchburg, MA.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

In information submitted to the Office of Management and Budget Review they estimate the time required for the revised form 314 and 315 to be an average of 80 hours. The next time you trade a station you might want to time yourself.

The current FCC count of licensed Radio Broadcast Stations shows 4,953 on AM, 5,593 on FM and 1,728 translators.

In the better late than never department the FCC released this item dated "Action of September 21, 1984", WVRD was granted a CP for a new FM on 107.1 MHz. The report goes on to say the CP is forfeited and canceled. The station has been on the air since 1985, leaving the meaning of this untimely notice in question.

ELSEWHERE

The Williams Broadcast Group has succeeded in its effort to have the FCC shut down two operating CP's of The Caprock Educational Broadcasting Foundation. Williams showed that KLMN, Amarillo and KAMY, Lubbock, both in Texas were not built as specified on the construction permit. According to Williams it took a lot of its time and money to have the FCC see that Caprock built its CP's as specified.

The NAB has come out against the awarding of new stations by lottery. The NAB would like to see the FCC reform its comparative licensing process.

Also from the NAB this week came news that they have asked the city of Seattle not to adopt a proposed RF radiation ordinance. Stating that the ordinance is not supported by scientific data, is inordinately restrictive and would not benefit the public more than existing FCC regulations. Keep an eye on this issue as it will probably spread from the Northwest to other communities and could force stations to move transmitter sites or reduce power.

PROGRAMMING

Radio has a new format this week as WNVR-1030, in Vernon Hills, Illinois becomes "Great American Radio". WNVR will lease its station to Public Interest Affiliates from 9 am to sunset from now until labor day. WGN radio will produce the programming to originate from 6 Flags, Great American amusement park. The format will target park patrons aged 18 to 49 with news about the park, waiting times on rides, parking, special shows and attractions and a mix of music including adult contemporary, oldies and selections from the shows at the park. Public Interest Affiliates will sell the commercial time and provide promotion for the station. WNVR will continue to air the Business Radio Network from 6am to 9am each morning.

WFMT, Chicago in an effort to bring its expenses in line with its revenue has made several changes in its programming and will reduce staff. For the first time announcers will work the same shift each day and WFMT will make use of its own Beethoven Network for overnights. WFMT is also running a fund raiser similar to the pledge drives of noncommercial stations in order to make up its budget deficit. All this comes at a time when its fine arts competitor WNIB is ahead for the first time in the ratings.

The Criswell Center for Biblical Studies has been granted a licence to cover for KCBI, Dallas, TX.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Attorney Sherrie Marshall of Wiley, Rein & Fielding and Andrew Bartlett of the Illinois Commerce Commission have been nominated to fill the two vacant seats on the Federal Communications Commission. Al Sikes, the head of the National Telecommunications & Information administration, is expected to be nominated to replace Dennis Patrick as Chairman of the FCC.

The FCC has upheld A Mass Media Bureau action denying C.R. Crisler's request that higher 95.5 C2 be substituted for 95.5 A at Lafayette, LA.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Review Board has reversed the decision of ALJ Thomas Fitzpatrick and has selected South Jersey Radio, Inc., an applicant for a new AM at Richmond, CA, for comparison with RKO for the license renewal of KFRC(AM), San Francisco. The Review Board found that South Jersey Radio was the best qualified challenger to the renewal of RKO General's licence. The Board denied the applications of Gold Mountain Broadcasting Co. for a new AM station on KFRC's frequency, as well as Cozzin Communications Corp.'s application for the same frequency at Richmond, CA. ALJ Thomas had selected Paul J. Growald as the best qualified challenger. The Board found that the public interest would best be served by bringing the first local service to Richmond, a city of 75,000 people, 16 miles NE of San Francisco. The Board said that San Francisco would simply have to cope with its 24 other radio stations and 8 TV stations, should RKO forfeit its AM station license.

The FCC has denied the NAB's request that the Commission stay the effect of its new rules amending part 73 to permit short-spaced FM station assignments using directional antennas.

The Commission has stayed the hearing, scheduled to begin today (June 19th) in the Bay shore, NY, FM proceeding, and asked the parties for more information on the site availability question.

The FCC dismissed the request for reconsideration and motion for stay filed by Patsy Nance Marsh and Rickey E. Nance in the matter of amending the FM table at Ariton, AL.

The FCC denied the request of John Brown University, licensee of KLRC(FM) at Silom Springs, AR, for reconsideration of the decision substituting 101.1 A for 90.3 A and modified KLRC's licence accordingly.

The NAB is urging the FCC to use a "Waiver" policy rather than a rule change to assist in reducing AM interference. The NAB is opposed to the "negotiation of interference rights" by broadcasters and would like the FCC to look at cases on an individual basis and to conduct a full public interest evaluation, assessing the amount of interference to be reduced as well as the effects on levels of broadcast localism.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In response to problems with the FCC's Call Letter department, John Wong of the Video Services department has begun the computerization of all call letters. For months the FCC has been releasing flawed, incomplete and untimely records of broadcast call letter changes. Since many organizations, including several areas of the FCC are tied to call letters for record keeping the flawed data spreads out from the FCC and is recirculated through other sources. Wong would not give a time table for the completion for the project but did admit that the job was a very large one and would take some time. This weeks Call Letter Notice 114 contained only four stations and left out what cities they were located in, so it may be a tough transition. M Street will do its best to report on actual but non-released call letter changes and will continue to verify released changes.

The Technical Subgroup of the Radio Advisory Board has set July 13th for its next meeting. The next session will continue consideration of interference standards for AM stations and engineering standards for FM. The meeting will be held at the Wasilewski Room of the NAB at 10am and is open to the public. For more information call Wallace Johnson at (703)824-5660.
