WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission has granted the application of P-N-P Broadcasting, Inc. for channel 24 at Pullman, WA. P-N-P already holds a CP for a new FM at Pullman and will be granted a waiver of the multiple ownership rules to permit common ownership of A TV and FM station in the same community. The FCC felt that common ownership would activate an unused UHF allocation and provide first commercial service to a "very small community".

The FCC has upheld the Mass Media Bureau action dismissing the application of Walter P. Faber, Jr. to short space WQMB (FM) at Midvale, UT, with KTLE-FM at Toole, UT. Faber's application was dismissed as 1) he could not use a directional antenna to avoid an intermediate frequency separation requirement; 2) that because the existing site was sufficient to cover the market, improved coverage did not justify a waiver; and 3) that operating convenience and economic advantage did not warrant waiver of the minimum distance separation requirements.

Effective June 26th, 1989 the OMB has approved the necessary changes to FCC forms 301 and 340 reflecting the collection of additional information. Applicants filing applications after this date, but before the revised forms are available must supplement their applications to provide the new information.

The policies and amended rules set out in BC Docket #81-742 (Formulation of Policies and Rules Relating to Broadcast Renewal Applications, Competing Applications, and other Participants to the Comparative Renewal Process and the Prevention of Abuses of the Renewal Process), were to become effective June 28th, 1989, subject to OMB approval. The FCC is still waiting for the approval and hopes to receive it by August 1st.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC was closed Tuesday July 4th to observe Independence Day.

Capital Cities/ABC has been granted a permanent waiver of the one to a market rule. The waiver will allow Cap/ABC to keep its TV and radio station combinations in New York, Chicago, Los Angeles, and San Francisco.

Emission De radio Balmaseda, Inc. has been granted partial reconsideration of its request to the extent of substituting 106.5 A for 93.3 A at Ponte Vedra Beach.

The FCC has dismissed the settlement agreements filed in the Rockledge, FL, proceeding for a new FM at 102.7 MHz. The Commission has directed the applicants to file a modified settlement agreement.

The Commission denied the request of Huntington Broadcasting Corp. for reconsideration of the Report & Order which allocated 96.3A to Churubusco, IN, moved WIOE-FM to 103.1 at Huntington, IN, allocated 101.1 A to South Whitley, IN, and 105.1A to Roanoke, IN.

Anthony R. Martin-Trigona has been denied review of a Mass Media Bureau decision granting the transfer of WNHC(AM) at New Haven, CT, from Wardoco Broadcasting, Inc. to Edith Acabo Willis and Larry Wardlaw.

The Commission has denied Amherst Broadcasting, Inc., reconsideration of its decision granting the application of Hampshire County Broadcasting Co., Inc., for a new FM station at Amherst, MA.

The Commission has upheld a Review Board decision granting the application of Cutter Broadcasting, Inc., for a new FM station at Northampton, MA and the denial of a competing application of Northampton Media Associates.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The FCC has announced that a updated edition of the Communications Act of 1934 and related statutes is available from the Superintendent of Documents. The publication is entitled Compilation of the Communications act of 1934 and Related Provisions of Law. It runs 397 pages and contains major communications related legislation enacted into law in the 100th Congress. It can be ordered for \$12 from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C., 20402, or by credit card at (202)275-3030. the publication stock number is 052-070-06578-8.

The NAB reports that stations on the FCC's list of proposed upgrades from A to C3 should file comments by August 7th. Stations should submit an original and four copies of the pleading, including the relevant docket number. Address correspondence to Donna Searcy, Secretary, FCC, 1919 M Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., 20554.

Construction has begun on the NAB's experimental AM antenna project. Completion is expected in about five weeks. The new antenna is designed to increase a stations groundwave and reduce its skywave. The NAB will also testa new antenna grounding system that may allow AM broadcasters to save thousands of dollars on ground system installation cost.

ELSEWHERE

The Satellite Music Network has announced that it will enter into an agreement with International Communications, Inc. to market SMN's formats to Japan. SMN is already heard in the Caribbean, Shanghai and the Peoples Republic of China.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has increased the maximum effective radiated power for class A FM stations from 3,000 to 6,000 watts. Along with the power increase the Commission will increase the distance class A stations must be separated by. Stations meeting the new distance requirements will be allowed to increase power as soon as December of this year, stations not meeting the new distance separations will be required to file for any changes made. Existing stations that do not meet the new distance requirements will be "grandfathered" allowing modifications and relocations of these stations under the previous power limit and separation requirements. The FCC expects approximately 500 stations to be able to increase power on December 1st. A list will be made available by the FCC of the stations that will qualify in the near future. Stations that appear on the list will be allowed to increase power through simple technical means provided the increase does not cause exposure of workers of the general public to levels of RF above the American National Standard Safety Levels. Stations raising power must file a form 302 within ten days. All other stations will need to file a form 301 and obtain FCC approval before raising power.

When the FCC created class C3 as a new FM station class in Zone II existing class C2 facilities with 25,000 watts ERP or less and an antenna HAAT such that the distance to the 1 mV/m contour is less than 39 km became subject to reclassification to the new class C3. Class C facilities with a distance to the 1 mV/m contour of 72 km or less are subject to reclassification to class C1 or C2 as appropriate. Stations that do not meet the minimum requirements of their present class have until June 3rd, 1991 to apply for at least minimum facilities. Noncommercial/educational facilities will also be reclassified. For more information or questions regarding the rules creating class C3 contact Jay Jackson at the FCC (202) 632-9660. The FCC has released a listing of the facilities subject to reclassification, complete copies of the list are available from M Street at PO Box 3568, Alexandria, VA 22302 for \$3.00 or to check if your station is on the list give us a call at (703) 684-3622.

In its continuing crackdown on EEO violations the FCC has conditionally renewed the licence of WDAR and WMWG, Darlington, SC. The Commission fined the stations \$12,000, granted a three year short-term licence renewal and imposed reporting conditions. The FCC took this action on its own, there were no complaints or petitions deny filed.

WGKR in Perry, FL, has returned its licence to the FCC. WGKR was a daytime station on 1310 KHz with 1,000 watts. The licensee now operates WPRY in Perry.

The FCC's new versions of form 301 and 340 are now available. Old versions of the applications will still be accepted until August 31st, but must be supplemented by all required additional information. The new forms may be obtained from the FCC's Operations Support Division, Services and Supply Branch, Room B-10, 1919 M Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20554. You can call them at (202) 632-7272.

ELSEWHERE

It was not a good day for KXBR in Greenfield, MO as a disgruntled landlord bulldozed junk cars and dead cattle around the stations tower. The station had obtained a one year lease option on the land but when it went to pay the lease the owner ordered the station off her land. The station has gotten a restraining order to keep the landlord away and has posted a guard at the site. KXBR was off the air for about 25 hours.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has approved the settlement agreement for WOR, New York. The Commission will allow RKO General, Inc. to sell WOR to Buckley-WOR Broadcasting Corp. for \$25,500,000. As approved RKO will receive 65% of the proceeds with the remainder going to the other competing applicants.

Check your tower lighting! KIQI, San Francisco, CA, has been fined \$7,000 for not lighting their 206 foot towers. KIQI was fined an additional \$1000 (a total of \$8,000) for logging that the lights were in working order. An FCC inspection revealed that there was no beacon on one tower and that the others had been inoperative for some time.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The assignment of WHDH, Boston from Channel Broadcasting, Inc. to WHDH-AM, Inc., has been approved. The assignment required the granting of a waiver of the "one-to-a-market" rule as WHDH-AM, Inc. is owned by New England Television Corp. licensee of WNEV-TV also in Boston. The approval of the sale continues the FCC's recently adopted policy to "look with favor" upon waiver requests when doing so would not adversely effect diversity of ownership in a given market.

The Commission reinstated five applications from four separate proceedings that has been returned as unacceptable for proposing facilities that were short-spaced to the buffer-zone protection afforded to nearby substandard Class C stations. The FCC found that the petitioners reasonably assumed that the buffer-zone requirement did not apply to them because the Docket 80-90 proceedings addressed allotments only and did not specify whether assignments for the new allotments must also protect the buffer-zone. The buffer-zone was in effect from March 1, 1984 to March 1, 1987. Applications involved are Special Markets Media, Inc., Raleigh, NC; Southern Twin Cities Area Radio, Inc., Lakeville, MN; Pruitt and Owen, Corydon, IN; La-Saun Communications and Dot Broadcasting, LP, Charleston, SC. The Commission did not reinstate the application of Lopez Radio, Inc. at Corydon, IN, as the proposed facilities exceeded the maximum for a Class B station. In those proceedings that have already been terminated (Corydon and Charleston), the FCC authorized the respective ALJ's to reopen the record.

Denied Walter P. Faber reconsideration of the dismissal of his application to modify the CP of KQMB(FM) at Midvale, UT.

Denied Robert P. Duff's petition to set aside the grant for a new FM at Madera, CA, to Madera FM, Inc.

Denied Amherst Broadcasting, Inc. reconsideration of a decision granting the application of Hampshire County Broadcasting Company, Inc. for a new FM at Amherst, MA.

Affirmed the grant of a FM translator (K228CP) at Garfield, CO, to High Country Communications, Inc., over the objection of William J. Murphy.

ELSEWHERE

WGN radio in Chicago is looking to take advantage of the relaxed FCC rules pertaining to cross-ownership and joint agreements with other co-located stations. WGN has assigned Sales Director Robert Sparr and Program Director Lorna Gladstone to look into the feasibility of finding a FM station in the Chicago area to simulcast WGN's talk and sports programming. WGN is already involved with Amusement Park Radio, WNVR in suburban Chicago on a consulting and programming assistance basis.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has conditionally renewed the licenses of WOOJ AM & FM in Lehigh Acres, FL. Although both the National Black Media Coalition and the Florida State NAACP withdrew their petition to deny the renewal, the Commission, thoroughly reviewed the stations' EEO programs and performances, and concluded the renewals should be granted subject to reporting conditions. The FCC also fined the stations \$15,000 for repeated failures to comply with the FCC's EEO provisions. The FCC did approve the sale of WOOJ-FM from Robert A. Dwyer to Sandab Communications of Ft. Myers, LP. The reporting conditions will apply to Sandab after the sale is completed.

Broadcast Capital Fund, Inc., the Interracial Council for Business Opportunity, and the FCC will conduct a seminar on minority ownership opportunities in the broadcast industry of Friday, August 11th, 1989, from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm at the Washington Hilton Hotel. the seminar is designed to provide information on finding and evaluating broadcast ventures, obtaining financing, and FCC policies relating to minority ownership. The FCC has dismissed Jedco Broadcasting Corporation's request for reconsideration of an action allotting 105.7 B1 to Queensbury, NY, and denying a competing proposal to substitute 105.7 B1 for 93.5 A at Corinth, NY.

The Commission has affirmed an action denying Alpha Group's request to substitute 106.5 C2 for 106.3 A at Arizona City, AZ.

The NAB is asking the FCC for clarification of the new rules pertaining to stations changing their community of license. The NAB in a filing with the FCC has expressed concern that some licenses might "abandon their local communities" to migrate to well-served areas.

(M Street has got to ask if this is so very different than today's "rim-shooters", here in D.C. we have far suburbs serving near suburbs and near by suburbs serving the central city. Many stations have no presence at all in their city of licence.)

ELSEWHERE

Make sure what you want is available before you give your money to the FCC. The Commission has dismissed a request by H. James Sharp for a refund of his filing fee for a new TV station at Panama City, FL. Sharp submitted the required \$2,250 fee along with his application for channel 62, the application was subsequently returned as channel 62 was not allotted to Panama City. Sharp claims his fee should be returned as an untimely "window" filing, but the FCC denying review said that Sharp's application was not returned because it was untimely, but rather for its failure to specify an available channel.

M STREET FAX

Thanks to those who participated in the fax test of the June 26 issue of M Street. Preliminary results indicate that computer set type is much more legible than scanning typewritten copy however fewer columns are available which would require reformatting M Street and rewriting our computer programs. Fax did speed up delivery of M Street, but most fax paper is so flimsy binding for reference is difficult. The typical M street took 6 minutes to fax. The telephone bill is not in yet so we don't know the costs yet. Thanks again, we will let you know when we are ready to start the Fax Edition of M Street.
