WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has proposed a FY 1991 budget of \$117,998,000 and 1,778 full-time positions, an increase of about \$10 million and 28 positions over its FY 1990 budget.

In separate actions, the FCC has upheld its grant of Juanina, Inc., for a new station at 96.5 MHz in Fort Walton Beach FL, denying the requests for reconsideration by three competing applicants; and granted Holston Valley Broadcasting a waiver of one-station-to-a-market regulations to permit its purchase of WKTP, Jonesborough TN.

Evergreen Media Corp., owner of WLUP Chicago, has announced its intention to mount a legal challenge to the FCC's recent fine of WLUP for violation of indecency guidelines. Evergreen argued in a response filed this week to the FCC's notice of apparent liability that the guidelines are "arbitrary, capricious and contrary to law," and that the FCC "has not developed and applied a consistent indecency standard."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Ervin S. Duggan has been confirmed by the Senate as the newest FCC Commissioner.

The U.S. Justice Dept. has asked the Supreme Court to overturn the FCC's practice of assigning preferences to minorities and women in comparative hearings. A recent Appeals Court ruling reaffirmed the FCC's minority preference policies.

A U.S. Court of Appeals has, in a Shreveport LA case, overturned the criteria published by the FCC in 1983 for consideration of allocation counterproposals. The court ruled that the FCC had not properly published its procedures or made them available for public comment before their implementation, and thus found no basis for the FCC's refusal to consider the original or subsequent counterproposals of James A. Reeder to amend the table of allocations at Shreveport. The ruling also effectively overturns several subsequent allocation decisions in the region surrounding Shreveport, based on the FCC's Reeder decision; and potentially opening for reconsideration over 700 other subsequent allocations since 1983 based on the criteria used in the Reeder case.

In response to the court decision, the FCC has decided not to reimplement the overturned policies; and to "initiate remedial actions in those instances in which a party was prejudiced by these policies and in which that party acted to ensure that the contested proceeding remained subject to review by filing administrative and/or judicial appeals." Procedural rules normally applied in allotment proceedings will be applied to the FCC's remedial actions.

Immediate actions which the FCC has begun include: amendment of the FM Table at Shreveport LA to permit KMJJ-FM to move from channel 100.1A to 99.7 C1, with show cause orders issued to KTOC-FM Jonesboro LA (104.9A) and KGRI-FM Henderson TX (100.1A) to show why they should not be moved to 95.5A and 99.9A respectively; the rescinding of subsequent channel substitutions, based upon the original Reeder decision, at El Dorado AR, Bastrop LA, and Atlanta TX; consideration of a petition for rulemaking for a channel allotment at Wilmore KY; and consideration of a petition for rulemaking at Jacksonville NC that requires rescinding of a previous channel substitution at Havelock NC and consolidation with a number of other mutually exclusive proposals.

The FCC has announced several policy changes in its processing of commercial FM construction permit applications for new facilities. Effective immediately, in an effort to speed the processing of the approximately 2200 pending new FM station applications, the FCC will issue the required "Notice of Acceptance for Filing" prior to the staff's engineering study of the application; and waive "hard look" rules to permit one opportunity to correct tenderability defects and one opportunity to correct acceptability defects, in situations where only one applicant has applied during a filing window, or where one applicant has proposed to buy out all other applicants in a mutually exclusive group.

A settlement agreement in proceedings for a new FM on 92.7 in Marco, FL, has been overturned by the Commission. The agreement, which the FCC previously approved, allowed a competing applicant to sell its application to Rowland Gulf Radio, Inc., which then paid the other six applicants to have all competing applications dismissed. The decision was reversed because approving the Marco settlement would encourage "sham applications" in the future by applicants primarily interested in being paid off rather than in operating a station. As part of the decision, the Marco proceeding is returned to active hearing status.

The FCC has renewed the licenses of twelve South Carolina radio stations, denying the objections of the South Carolina State Conference Branches of the NAACP, various local NAACP branches, and the National Black Media Coalition. Four

licenses were renewed unconditionally, two subject to reporting conditions, two with reporting and forfeiture conditions, and four with short-term renewals, reporting and forfeiture conditions.

The stations are: WESC AM-FM, Greenville, and WEAC/WAGI, Gaffney, renewed unconditionally; WODE/WNOK, Columbia, renewed subject to reporting conditions; WSPA AM-FM, Spartanburg, renewed with reporting conditions and notice of apparent liability (NAL) for \$5,000; and WKZQ AM-FM, Myrtle Beach, and WGSN/WNMB, North Myrtle Beach, renewed short term, with reporting conditions and NALs for \$10,000.

In other actions, the FCC denied appeals of previous decisions which renewed the license of KQED-FM San Francisco and denied renewal to WBBY Westerville OH. KQED-FM's license was renewed despite denial of license renewal for co-owned KQEC-TV. The FCC also upheld a previous decision denying extension of the construction permit for WBPX-106.3, Flemingsburg KY, and has canceled the station's CP and calls. The station was subsequently built and now faces being removed from the air.

KIQI-1010 San Francisco has been ordered to forfeit \$8,000 for repeated failure to light the station's broadcast towers. KIQI unsuccessfully appealed the fine on grounds that the towers were shielded by other, lit towers, and that KIQI had been unfairly singled out by the FCC as a "warning" to other stations that tower lighting regulations would be strictly enforced.

The FCC's Field Operations Bureau shut down an unlicensed West Virginia pirate station on January 30. Mark R. Leavitt of Beech Bottom, WV was fined \$1,000 for operating an unlicensed station on 3820 KHz.

Two recent station proceedings mark significant departures for the FCC. Approval of the sale of KLAY-1480 Lakewood Center WA to two separate share-time stations - KTKN, a for-profit religious station operating Monday through Saturday, and KDFL, a non-profit station using the frequency on Sundays - marks only the second time since the 1920's that the FCC has authorized a new AM share-time agreement. (The other, WXOL/WCEV-1450 in Cicero IL in the early 1980's, settled a dispute over the new licensee after WFMT-FM gave up interim operation of the facility.) Also of interest this week is KGMI's application for a new translator in Blaine, WA. If approved, this would be the first modern translator to relay an AM station.

Lastly(!), the FCC has upheld several previous actions on various amendments to the FM table of amendments. These include: allocation of 96.3A to Churubusco IN, 101.1A to South Whitley IN, 105.1A to Roanoke IN, and substituting 102.9A for 103.1A for WOWO-FM, Huntington IN; substitution of 96.9C2 for 96.7A for WCOZ-FM, Paris KY; substitution of 106.3C2 for 106.3A for WQBZ Fort Valley GA; and allocation of 106.7A to Semora NC and 106.7A to South Boston VA. The text of the Semora NC decision included the intriguing note that Semora is considered a community for allotment purposes, since "while the amount of commercial activity in Semora may be limited, the Commission has never established that [a] minimum amount of commercial activity is necessary to qualify a locality as a community...also, the lack of municipal services and a local government does not foreclose community status..."

ELSEWHERE

The NFL's Houston Oilers have announced a unique new broadcast agreement, where play-by-play of the team's games will be simulcast on news-talk flagship KTRH-740 and album rocker KLOL-101.1. Several FM rock stations had broken new ground by broadcasting play-by-play of the Super Bowl in January.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In a tabulation released this week, the FCC reported receiving a record 1,240 Emergency Broadcast System reports in 1989. EBS was most frequently triggered by stations in Texas and in Western Pennsylvania, with KGNC Amarillo and KDKA Pittsburgh using the system most often.

ELSEWHERE

A jury in Pittsburgh has awarded former WBZZ-FM News Director Liz Randolph nearly \$700,000 in damages for on-air verbal abuse she received from B-94 morning DJs Jim Quinn and Donald Jefferson. The air personalities and station were found liable for intentional infliction of emotional distress, defamation, invasion of privacy, and medical bills Randolph incurred due to the incidents. WBZZ management was found to have repeatedly ignored Randolph's complaints about her on-air treatment.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

"Due to lack of interest," the FCC has terminated a proceeding it began to reclassify Class A allotments for 149 communities to Class C3.

In other actions this week, the FCC dismissed an application for review and affirmed the grant to Tri-State Community Development & Communications Corp. of a new station on 107.5 A in Evansville IN; and announced the shutdown of three unlicensed pirate stations. In Virginia "Pirate Jim" on 6850 KHz and "Hillbilly Radio" on 7425 KHz and in Pennsylvania "WKND" on 1620 KHz. All three stations were fined \$1000.

ELSEWHERE

The Unistar Radio Network has announced a new country formatted oldies program to air on Saturday nights. "Country Gold Saturday Night" will begin the weekend of April 7th.

March BFM Calendar Notes

Renewal applications are due April 1 for radio stations in Texas and FM translator stations in Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Arkansas, Missouri, Kentucky, Tennessee, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Annual ownership reports are due April 1 for radio stations in Indiana, Kentucky, Tennessee, Texas, Delaware and Pennsylvania.

The National Association of Broadcasters' annual TV/Radio convention will be held in Atlanta March 31-April 3. State meetings next month include West Virginia, March 11-13.
