WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Effective with the close of business Thursday, April 5, the FCC has implemented a freeze on acceptance of applications for new AM stations or changed AM station facilities. After April 5 only minor facility changes, applications accepted by April 5, and mutually exclusive applications against license renewals will be processed. No indication was given by the FCC as to how long the AM freeze will be in place; it is expected to be a holding action until the FCC releases a series of new rulemakings on AM station applications, including procedures for expansion of the AM band to 1705 KHz.

After recently rescinding its new station grant, the FCC this week re-granted a CP to Carroll, Carroll & Rowland for a new FM in Calhoun TN. Competing applicant Glory FM, LP lost the appeal of its initial dismissal, which came when Glory's then-attorney, Thomas Root, advised Glory not to respond to a discovery request from the presiding FCC judge. Meanwhile, Root is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, Apr. 3, and says he'll plead not guilty to the 33 counts of fraud and misrepresentation in filing applications for new FM stations.

Douglas Webbink has been named Chief of the Policy and Rules Division of the Mass Media Bureau. He previously was Assistant Chief for Economics in that division.

Another pirate radio station has been shut down by the FCC. James Keul of Anaheim CA was fined \$1,000 for operation of "Zodiac" radio on 7416 KHz.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has granted a request for reconsideration by WVXU-91.7 Cincinnati and reversed a previous letter of admonition issued to the station. The Commission had previously ruled that WVXU's underwriting announcements were "inappropriate for broadcast on a non-commercial station"; no reason was given by the FCC for the reversal. The FCC also upheld a previous decision affirming the grant of a new FM station at Blackfoot, Idaho, to Bott Broadcasting.

**ELSEWHERE**

Arbitron has announced that it will be adding three new markets to its set of rated markets for the Spring 1990 ratings period. They are: Champaign-Urbana IL; Myrtle Beach SC; and Harrisonburg VA.

The National Association of Broadcasters and Radio Advertising Bureau have released a study of 1988-89 revenue sources for 93 markets. Regional sales figures for the two years show the following growth trends:

The NAB has also filed a petition this week in opposition to the proposed move of WHMA-FM Anniston AL to suburban Atlanta, 90 miles away. NAB's petition, claiming a grant for the move would undermine the ideals of local broadcasting and equitable distribution of broadcast outlets, suggests that "...the Commission must close the gates before local service is swept away."

Emmis Broadcasting has agreed in principal to purchase 15% interest in Maxximum, an FM radio station in Paris. They plan to use the dance/CHR outlet as a base for a national French radio network. Business Radio Network has also ventured overseas, signing a new FM affiliate in the English-language resort of Cancun, Mexico.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In two separate announcements, the FCC has released initial details of its plan to improve the quality of AM broadcast service. Included were indications that the FCC will not initially allow new station applications for the newly created 1605-1705 KHz section of the AM band, reserving that space for the migration of existing stations subject to heavy co-channel interference. Also notable is a proposal to reimpose the AM-FM non-duplication rule.

The first set of AM improvement announcements is a series of proposals released under "a three-pronged initiative designed to completely transform and revitalize the AM broadcast service by the year 2000." The three prongs are to:

1) Encourage AM stations "causing the most interference in the existing band" to move to the expanded 1605-1705 KHz band, which will become available for use shortly. As a result, the FCC suggests that the newly opened portion of the band would not initially be open to new station applications, but that they would be considered as normal AM new station filings once existing stations were given the opportunity to file to move.

2) Give broadcasters the ability and incentive to "use their own initiative to improve AM service to the public." Proposals under this heading include the newly authorized ability (see below) of stations to privately negotiate arrangements to reduce mutual interference, which would be buttressed by Commission-issued tax certificates to any stations that either reduce their service area or surrender their license. Another proposal would allow a "limited relaxation" of multiple ownership rules to permit co-ownership of AM stations with overlapping principal city contours if either station signs an interference reduction agreement. The Commission also proposed reimposition of restrictions on AM/FM station simulcasts.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

3) Revise AM technical standards with the overall goal of reducing interference. No proposals specifically addressing this area were released.

The FCC has also amended several sets of existing rules and procedures, but is deferring implementation of the changes until other related AM improvement matters are resolved. The changes already adopted include: 1) eliminating the policy of "grandfathering" radio frequency rights for a period of one year for parties wishing to file an application to replace a deleted facility; 2) accepting contingency applications from two or more stations seeking simultaneous, contingent changes in their facilities to reduce interference to each other, without opening the proceedings to competing applications; and 3) set forth guidelines for a minimal AM "service floor" to an area in considering facility changes or deletions. In general, the guidelines would insure a minimum continued availability of two or more primary AM services (not necessarily licensed to the same city) before allowing a change that would move or delete an existing station. The Commission also replaced the existing AM broadcast skywave and groundwave propagation curves with new propagation models. The new changes are geared toward encouraging AM stations to reach mutual agreements to reduce co-channel or adjacent channel interference, thus improving signal quality.

As part of the overhaul of AM, most types of applications for new stations or amended facilities were frozen effective April 5. The FCC is expected to issue a complete set of new AM guidelines in the next few weeks, including application procedures for 1605-1705 KHz, new signal protection criteria, enhancement of night signals for daytime stations, and revision of the station classification system. Comments are being requested by the FCC on the proposals released this week.

The FCC has upheld two Mass Media Bureau decisions returning applications for new FM stations in South Padre Island TX and in Beeville TX. Both applications had specified heights above the maximum for Class A stations within 199 miles of the Mexican border, and claimed that the FCC had failed to provide adequate notice of the Mexican border restrictions. In upholding the appeals, the FCC placed the burden upon applicants to know the status of broadcast agreements with foreign countries such as Mexico and Canada. The FCC also upheld a Review Board decision denying WRBQ-FM Tampa FL's request to waive FM short-spacing rules for its facility upgrade application; upheld an Inspector-General decision denying parts of a Freedom of Information Act request by parties challenging Kaye-Smith Enterprises as former licensees of KJRB-790 Spokane and KISW-99.9 Seattle WA; and reinstated its decision granting Claudia Bratton a new FM station in Montecito CA.

Crusade Broadcasting Corp., owner of WIMG-1300 Ewing NJ, has been fined \$10,000 by the FCC for operating WIMG without a valid station license. Crusade was notified officially on two occasions in 1989 that its operating authority had expired, but continued to broadcast until Feb. 5, 1990. WIMG had previously received FCC fines in 1986 and 1988, and has a long list of violations dating to 1983.

ELSEWHERE

Arbitron has announced that it has added a second, fall ratings period in three smaller markets. Stations in Dothan AL, Redding CA and Lincoln NE will now be measured twice annually by Arbitron, beginning with fall 1990 measurements. Arbitron now measures 166 markets in Fall and 262 markets overall.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Waivers have been granted by the FCC for its one-to-a-market rule in Fairbanks AK, where now-silent KINQ(FM) has been purchased by the owners of KCBF(AM) and KTVF(TV); and in Glendive MT, where KXGN AM and TV were jointly sold. The waivers were granted in Fairbanks due to the insolvency of KINQ, and in Glendive due to the small market size, shared resources and long-standing common ownership and staff of the AM and TV stations. The Commission has also upheld previous decisions granting a new FM station in Tucson AZ, and a facility upgrade for WKLG-102.1 Rock Harbor FL; and denied three requests for reconsideration of last week's order adopting new rules to improve AM service and adjacent channel interference.

The FCC also has moved to codify a previously established policy that allowed applicants to add major amendments to existing applications without opening ongoing proceedings to new applications or challenges. The FCC has allowed such amendments since the late 1970's without formally changing the existing rules.

As part of a large-scale return of FM translator applications, the FCC has returned KGMI Bellingham WA's application for a new FM translator. The return was due to an FCC freeze on all new FM translator applications; the FCC did not consider the appropriateness of an FM translator relaying an AM signal.

Another pirate station has been shut down by the FCC. John S. Kostrub of North Brunswick, NJ was arrested and charged with violating state law by interfering with police radio operations.

ELSEWHERE

Inside Radio reports that Z-Rock's Fresno affiliate, owned by Liggett Broadcasting, has finally settled on the call letters KZZF. The station changed late last year from KCLQ-FM to KZRZ, and was promptly served recently with a federal restraining order from KRZR-103.7, which claimed market confusion and trademark infringement over the call similarity. To avoid the legal problems, KZRZ decided to change to KFRZ - which immediately drew a similar protest from KFRE AM/FM. To avoid a similar restraining order, KFRE suggested the KZZF calls, which KFRZ is subsequently adopting. Since the FCC's deregulation of call letter changes several years ago, fewer than a half dozen new call choices have been taken to court by competing stations.

Once again the FCC is drawing the wrath of a broadcaster for a random change in a decision. Alan Henry, CEO of AnchorMedia Corp., has written to several dozen members of Congress asking them to investigate the FCC's decision-making process after the FCC released two decisions on his proposed purchase of WAXA-TV in Anderson SC - the first one permitting the sale, the second one disallowing it. AnchorMedia also owns WLOS-TV Asheville NC, and the FCC reversed itself after deciding the two stations had too great a coverage overlap in the Greenville-Spartanburg market. Says Henry, "It's not human error that decision was written. This matter has been treated in a very high-handed manner." Once again, the question: when IS an FCC decision final?

VERY ELSEWHERE

SMN has released ratings for its American music show "Lunchtime in America," aired daily on Radio Shanghai in the People's Republic of China. The one-hour program, runs from noon to 1 PM and is repeated at 5 PM. It ranks first among 46 rated radio programs. The noon program draws an 11.5 rating, representing about 1.5 million of the 35 million listeners in China's largest city. Radio ratings are conducted by the city government as part of larger rural and urban statistics surveys that are distributed by hand and retrieved several days later.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

FCC commissioner Andrew Barrett has been renominated to a full term at the Commission. Barrett joined the FCC last September, filling out the term of a vacated seat through June 30, 1990. If approved, Barrett will now serve as commissioner through June, 1995.

The FCC has affirmed a 1982 decision allowing KAPS-1470 Mount Vernon WA to move to 660 KHz, rejecting a competing application for a new station in Portland OR. The KAPS move is conditional upon successful testing of a new type of current antenna system, PARAN, successfully used in Europe and by the U.S. military. The PARAN system consists of four towers arranged in a square, and is used in situations where there are insufficient ground areas for a transmitter site.

In other actions, the FCC: granted a waiver to one-to-a-market rules to permit the sale of WEEL-590 Boston MA and of a UHF TV station to the same new owner, Boston Celtics Broadcasting, LP...affirmed a dismissal of The Lefebvre Group's application for a new FM in Center Moriches NY...and denied requests by Maquoketa Broadcasting Company for reconsideration of a series of FM allocation changes in Illinois and Iowa, and by Maxagrid, Inc. for reconsideration of two allocation changes in Central Texas.

ELSEWHERE

Drake-Chenault/Jones has announced two additional satellite-delivered formats. The Albuquerque-based company is adding full time oldies and easy listening services, bringing to five the number of formats offered. Drake's oldies format, based on the original Drake Top 40 format of the 60's, is scheduled to begin September 15; the easy listening format will debut August 1.
