WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has released details of its new lock box arrangement for filing station applications requiring processing fees. Effective May 21, all filings requiring a fee must be filed with Mellon Bank of Pittsburgh PA. In addition, a new Fee Processing Form (FCC Form 155) is required. The only filings exempt from the new procedures are FCC Forms 404, 506, 574, 753, and 755.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

Form 155 may be obtained from the FCC's Operations Support Division, Service and Supply Branch (202-632-7272); Consumer Assistance and Small Business Division (202-632-7000); and all FCC field offices. Failure to properly fill out or submit the Fee Processing Form will result in the dismissal of the filing or application.

The FCC has affirmed its recent, self-initiated reversal of a grant for a new FM station in Marco, FL. In denying the requests for reconsideration by Rowland Gulf Radio and United Church of Christ, the Commission reiterated its policy decision to not allow settlement agreements in new station proceedings which allow new parties to be awarded construction permits. Rowland had argued that the FCC's reversal was arbitrary and capricious in that it made no findings that issues prompting the reversal were relevant to any of the Marco applicants; and that the FCC violated its own procedures and precedents by acting on its own initiative thirteen months after the initial decision.

In other FCC decisions, Long Island Music Broadcasting Corp. has been denied reconsideration of the dismissal of its application for a new FM station at Bay Shore, NY...extraordinary relief was granted to enable a transfer of license to proceed for KOZN, Imperial CA, from Stereo 99, Ltd. (whose license was threatened with revocation) to New World Communications, Inc...and an appeal was dismissed of a previous decision allowing P-N-P Broadcasting to build its CPs for a new UHF television and a new FM radio station in Pullman WA.

Several of the AM facilities applications filed just before imposition of last month's AM applications freeze are apparently anticipating major AM regulatory changes. Notably this week, WMCA-570 and WADO-1280, 5 kw regional channel stations in New York, have applied for 50,000 watts; WLIB-1190 New York, becomes the second station (after WNZK in suburban Detroit) to apply for a split day/night operation, moving to 1200 KHz at night; and KBRW-680, Barrow AK, becomes the latest AM station to apply for operation of an FM translator to relay programming.

Two more pirate radio operators have been shut down by the FCC. John L. Rosengarten of Chicago and Eric B. Hultgren of Rockford, IL were fined \$1,000 each for operating stations on 7.415 MHz and 88.1 MHz, respectfully. Hultgren's station was being used to rebroadcast the signal of Chicago station WBBM-FM.

ELSEWHERE

WWWE-1100 has announced it will not appeal its recent indecency fine of \$8,000 assessed for Gary Dee's talk program. Station executives denied that the programs cited violate FCC decency standards, but felt appeal costs were not justifiable.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC this week adopted and issued a number of proposals designed to deter abuses of its processes. They include: 1) rules limiting the amount of payment that can be made in exchange for withdrawing petitions to deny in new licensing, modification, transfer, assignment proceedings and allocation counterproposals to the expenses of the petitioner; 2) soliciting comments for a similar proposal to limit payment for withdrawal or dismissal of competing new station applications to a percentage of expenses; 3) refusing to enforce program-related agreements made by private parties to settle licensing or license renewal challenges; 4) declining to reexamine decisions made to end abuses of the comparative renewal process; 5) terminating proposals for random selection of new AM, FM and TV licensees by lottery; and 6) broadening the range of misconduct to be considered in determining character qualifications for current or potential licensees, so that all felony convictions (rather than ones affecting the party's relationship with the FCC) may be considered, as may misdemeanors in some cases.

The FCC has also issued further details of its new fee-processing relationship with Mellon Bank of Pittsburgh. All time critical, feeable applications will be accepted as timely if they are stamped in by the lockbox bank before 12 midnight of the next business day after the official FCC deadline or cut-off date.

Finally, the FCC issued a reminder this week that AM stations must be in compliance with new NRSC emission standards by June 30, 1990. Stations not in compliance face fines of up to \$25,000 per willful or repeated violation.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Bonneville International Corp. has been denied a waiver by the FCC of one-to-a-market rules to allow its purchase of KRPN-107.9 in Salt Lake City. Bonneville had argued that KRPN was failing, was unable to find another buyer, and that Salt Lake is a large enough market to support cross-ownership. In denying the request, the FCC noted that Bonneville, owned by the Mormon church, is already directly or indirectly affiliated with the ownership of KSL AM and TV, Salt Lake City; KBYU-FM and TV, non-commercial stations operated by Brigham Young University in Provo; and The Deseret News, the major daily newspaper in the market.

WKSP-1090 Kingstree SC has been ordered to show cause why its license should not be revoked for failing to disclose the felony drug conviction of its principal owner. The issue came to light during a comparative hearing for a new FM in Kingstree; that proceeding has been consolidated with the challenge to WKSP.

In other actions, the FCC has: conditionally renewed the license of FM outlet WAVW Vero Beach FL, and fined WAVW \$10,000 for failure to comply with EEO guidelines; reversed a prior decision and granted the license renewal of WWKB Buffalo NY; and upheld a grant to Cutter Broadcasting, Inc. for a new FM in Northampton MA. Finally, the FCC - their words - "denied request by Breland Broadcasting for reconsideration of a Review Board decision rejecting its claim that the presiding ALJ had erred in denying its petition seeking dismissal of the application of Johnnie F. Knight..." in Montgomery AL. M Street interprets: "no."

Stuart B. Bedell has been appointed an Assistant Division Chief of the Audio Services Division, Mass Media Bureau. He will also serve as interim Chief of the Division's AM Branch, pending the appointment of a permanent Branch Chief.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has issued another waiver to its one-to-a-market rule, to allow purchase of WHRC-TV in suburban Boston by Rogue Television Corp. The main stockholder in Rogue, Steven Mindich, is also the major stockholder in WFNX-101.7 in Lynn MA.

In other actions this week, the FCC: upheld a Review Board decision granting a new FM to Comstock Broadcasters in Sparks, NV; denied reconsideration of an earlier decision denying allocation changes in Corinth, Hadley and Queensbury NY; and affirmed a previous FM new station grant to Ronald Sorenson in Des Moines.

ELSEWHERE

Effective July 1st, the CRTC is reimposing a requirement of 65% French language music for radio stations in the province of Quebec. The 65% level had been lowered in 1986 "to enhance the financial performance" of Quebec stations; since that objective has been achieved, the CRTC announced, the requirement is now back.

Chuck Harder's FOR THE PEOPLE program on the SUN network can now be heard internationally on shortwave over WWCR Nashville, TN. The program is carried on a delayed broadcast from 8 to 10pm EDT. FOR THE PEOPLE is produced by the non-profit Peoples Network and deals in advice and common sense solutions to problems. WWCR can be heard on 15690 & 7520 KHz.
